Two No-Pass decisions regarding the graphic design portfolio review means the student is not eligible for the graphic design major. A student may only participate in two graphic design portfolio reviews.

The following will need to be submitted on Thursday, February 2 (8am-4pm):

- **Resume:** a one page resume of relevant design and art experiences; it should include name, address, and email address. Experience should include the year, place and experience description. Sample resumes are available for viewing at SCSUs career services website.
- **Statement of Purpose:** a one page statement describing the reasons why you are applying to the graphic design major. Also include experiences and goals.
- **Student's Degree Audit Report:** can be obtained on the web through e-services.
- **Major Program Application:** student is to complete and sign the major application. Art office personnel will secure your adviser's signature.

**Students will sign-up for the interview on Wednesday, February 1 when submitting the above required documents. Interviews will be conducted February 6-9.**

The graphic design portfolio review process requires showcasing 12-15 pieces of artwork consistent with foundations-level artwork. Installation of artwork will begin at 8am Friday, February 3 and must be installed by 8am Monday, February 6. Please note that students are limited to approximately 5' of installation space. One pedestal per applicant will be available. Computers are not available. Students may bring a laptop or tablet device to show appropriate work in a brief presentation for the reviewers (3-5 minutes).
