Student artist must provide title cards with the following information: artist's name, title of piece, media used, and date piece was created. Student artist must also display an "artist's statement" indicating what you address in your art.

Faculty will critique the scholarship artwork **April 2-5.**

All artwork must be **picked up on Friday, April 6.** Artwork that is not picked up by 8am April 9 will be disposed of by the department (unless other arrangements have been made).

Scholarship award winners are announced at the annual student show opening, scheduled for Thursday, April 19, 2007.
