SLO #1: Students will be able to identify and explain key theories related to the role of conflict in interpersonal relationships.”

SLO #3: Students will be able to demonstrate skill in applying a variety of theories of third party intervention.

Data for SLO #2 and SLO #3 will be collected from CMST 429 (Theories of Third Party Intervention) every fall semester, beginning Fall, 2011 (no measure has been developed as of yet). First reporting date: September, 2013

SLO #4: Students will be able to perform problem-solving/collaborative communication skills in mediating conflict.

Data for SLO #4 was collected spring, 2010 and thereafter will be collected from CMST 428 (Theory and Practice of Mediation) in rotation with data collection for SLO #1 during spring semester. Next data collection, spring, 2011. First reporting date: September, 2011.
