SCSU CLAIMS THIRD PLACE AT 2008 NCC TOURNAMENT:

The St. Cloud State University baseball team placed third at the final North Central Conference tournament on May 8-10, in Omaha, Neb. This marks the end of the grand old North Central Conference, which will disband at the end of the 2007-08 academic year. SCSU gained an 8-4 win over UND in the first game of the tournament on May 8. In the second round, SCSU lost a 6-2 decision against Minnesota State. To complete the tournament, SCSU posted a 7-6 win over UMD and a 12-4 win over UND on May 9. The Huskies were eliminated on May 10, with a tough 2-1 loss to Mankato. All games were played in Omaha, Neb. Of note, UNO went on to claim the top spot at the tournament

This marked the second consecutive season that SCSU has placed third at the NCC championships.

FIRST YEAR: St. Cloud State welcomed head coach Pat Dolan in 2008. He finished his first year as head coach at SCSU with a 27-23-1 overall record and a 13-12 record in the NCC.

PAIRINGS SET FOR LAST NCC TOURNAMENT:

St. Cloud State earned the league's third seed heading into the 2008 NCC Tournament opener.

ON THE RECORD WITH RESSER: It was a record setting season for senior infielder Kyle Resser. He ended his season with a 28-game hitting streak, which dated back to March 27 vs. Bemidji State. Here is a rundown of the records he set in 2008 at SCSU:

Resser was close to setting records in other categories. He had 10 home runs, which was just two shy of the team record and his 28 extra base hits was just one shy of the current team record of 29 in a season.

PITCHING RECORDS FALL AS WELL:

A couple of pitching records fell in 2008, as Mitchell Staley broke the single season appearances record with 18 on the season. Matt Swanson also broke the old record for appearances as he had 17 in 2008 for the Huskies. Chris Koenig and Tim Scott both surpassed the games started mark with 13 apiece this season. Koenig set a team record with 71.2 innings pitched this season. Both the games started and IP records were previously held by current pitching coach Pete Pratt. One career record that looks as if it will fall, is the opponents batting average, as Staley is currently first on the all-time list, holding other teams to a .270 average over his three years at SCSU.

ALL-NCC SELECTIONS:

Kyle Resser was named to the 2008 All-NCC team. He was joined in the honors court by teammates senior first baseman Ryan Sturm (Springfield, Minn.), junior pitcher Tim Radmacher (Rosemount, Minn.) and sophomore pitcher David Deminsky (Sartell) - all who gained All-NCC Honorable Mention recognition this spring.

ALL-AMERICA NOTICE:

Kyle Resser was named to the 2008 National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association All-America Team as a honorable mention choice in 2008.

ALL-REGION NOTICE:

Kyle Resser was named to the 2008 Rawling/American Baseball Coaches Association All-Central Region First Team in 2008.

WISE GUY:

Sophomore third baseman Sam Radbil (Milwaukee, Wis./Whitefish Bay H.S.) was named to the ESPN the Magazine Academic All-District V College Division Third Team in 2008. This elite team of student-athletes recognizes those with a 3.20 GPA or above and the team consists of baseball players from the states of Minnesota, Wisconsin, Illinois and Indiana.

2008 COACHING STAFF



Coach Dolan

Coach Pat Dolan officially began his tenure with SCSU on June 15th, 2007. He brings a wealth of baseball success. In Dolan's 16 years as a head coach his teams have captured an amazing 10 conference regular season championships. During this span he has compiled a 583-324 overall record with 301 wins in 11 years at the college level and 282 wins at the American Legion level. In his collegiate career, Dolan has made stops at Dakota

State, Belmont Abbey (N.C.), St. Andrew's (N.C.), and Itasca CC



Coach Pratt

Pratt returned to the SCSU dugout in 2007-08. A former standout player for the Huskies from 1985-88, Pratt owns six team pitching records and served as a captain for two seasons at SCSU. Pratt went on to serve for three seasons as the squads pitching coach from 1989-91. The Huskies won the 1989 conference championship and the 1991 NCC tournament title. SCSU also advanced to the NCAA tournament in 1991 with Pratt on staff.



Coach Picha

Longtime Central Minnesota prep baseball skipper Ken Picha joined the St. Cloud State University baseball staff as an assistant coach in 2007-08. Picha served as the head varsity baseball coach at nearby Melrose High School for 29 years (1979-2007) and compiled an impressive 427-181 career record. He ranks eighth on the all-time win list among Minnesota high school baseball coaches, and his .702 career winning percentage ranks sixth among Minnesota

high school coaches who have a minimum of 350 wins. His Melrose teams won 11 conference titles, seven district championships and his squads advanced to four state tournaments. His 1997 and 1998 teams finished second in the state baseball tournaments.

Brueske served as a graduate assistant coach at SCSU in 2007-08. Brueske graduated from North Dakota State University with a Bachelor's of Science in business administration in 2003. While there, Brueske was a four-year standout for the Bison baseball team. In 2001, Brueske led the North Central Conference in hitting with a .526 average. Also in 2001, he was named to the All-NCC second team, was 17th in the nation with a .787 slugging percentage and ranked 27th nationally with a .436 batting average. Brueske signed a professional contract with the River City Rascals of the Frontier League and currently ranks in the

top ten in multiple NDSU career and single-season records.



THOMPSON TATTOED: One individual career record that fell this year went to Bruce Thompson (Maplewood) the junior has been hit by six pitches this season, bringing his career total to 17, a new Husky record.

NCC LEADER BOARD: The Huskies showed well in the NCC this season. SCSU ranked second in the league with a .299 batting average, while UNO led the conference at .338 (overall games played). SCSU ranked third in the loop with a 5.33 ERA, while UNO led the league at 4.90. The Huskies ranked third with a .951 fielding rate behind UNO (.961) and MSU (.953). Kyle Resser led the conference in hitting with a .416 batting average. David Deminsky's 4.07 ERA ranked seventh in the NCC this season.

NORTHWOODS LEAGUE: A trio of Huskies were listed on Northwoods League rosters in 2008. Sam Radbil was on the roster with the St. Cloud River Bats, while Tim Scott was back with the Rochester Honkers. Recruit Tyler Horning will play at Alexandria this summer. Assistant Coach Jason Brueske will serve as an assistant coach with the River Bats this summer.

AT THE REGIONAL: SCSU did not make the field for the 2008 NCAA Division II tournament, but the Huskies gained regional rankings throughout the course of the 2008 season. Here are the results from the NCAA Central Regional :

GREAT FINISH: The Huskies' 27-23-1 overall record was the most wins posted by the Huskies since the 1999 season, when SCSU went 28-19. The Huskies' 13-12 record in the NCC, also ties the team record for most NCC wins in a season. The Huskies also had 13 wins during the 1999 season.

DOUBLE YOUR PLEASURE: The Huskies tied a team record this season with 86 doubles. SCSU also had 86 doubles in 1999...on the defensive side of the field, the Huskies set a new team record for double plays turned with 45. The old mark of 37 was set in 1999.

OUCH: The Huskies posted a new team record by being hit by a pitch 49 times this season. The old record of 27 was set in 2001.

AT THE PLATE: The Huskies posted a new team record with 1,483 at bats in 2008. The old record of 1,472 at bats was set in 1999. The Huskies also set a team record for most games played in a season this year with 51 games played. The old Husky standard of 48 games played was hit in 1999.

FAST FACTS: Nate Johnson led the club with 18 stolen bases this season...Ryan Sturm led the team this year with 353 putouts in 2008...Cody Forrester was hit by a pitch nine times this season, which led the team and was one short of a team record of 10 set by Kyle Resser in 2007...Ryan Sturm set a team record with 41 strikeouts in 2008...Sturm's 353 putouts this season ranks second in team history...Tim Scott led the Huskies with 56 strikeouts this season, while David Deminsky had 55 strikeouts.
