HUSKY BASEBALL TO HOST THREE DOUBLE-HEADERS: The St. Cloud State University baseball team (1-11, 0-0 NCC) will play host to the Southwest Minnesota State Mustangs (3-8) on March 29 at Dick Putz Field for two non-conference games. On April 1-2, the Jamestown College Knights (9-1) will travel to St. Cloud for four games against the Huskies in the two-day span.

2005 SEASON RESULTS: The 2005 SCSU baseball team finished their season with a record of 20-26 overall and 4-16 in the North Central Conference under the direction of head coach Denny Lorsung. The Huskies matched a 16-year-old winning streak after stringing together 10 consecutive wins in early April. The 10-game streak was the longest winning streak since 1989 and was ended when SCSU fell to Nebraska-Omaha on April 9, 2005. During the season, the Huskies posted an 8-8 record in one run games. SCSU lost seven one-run games in NCC play in 2005.

COLORADO SPRING BREAK RESULTS: After spending a week in Colorado, the Huskies baseball team, coached by Denny Lorsung (28th season), dropped 10 games between Metropolitan State, CSU-Pueblo and Mesa State from March 4-8. On March 4, Metro State squeaked past the Huskies with a 11-10 win and completed the day with a 14-3 victory over SCSU. Luke Klitzke, a sophomore first baseman, led the Huskies in the first game with two hits and three RBIs as freshman pitcher Pat DeLaHunt posted the loss from the mound. In the second game, junior infielder Dan Skog led SCSU with two hits and two RBIs as teammate Kyle Johnson, a junior outfielder, also tallied two hits in the contest.

On March 5, SCSU's baseball team returned to Metro State for another double-header. In the first game, the Huskies dropped a tough 3-1 loss, with six different SCSU players earning one hit apiece. Gary Kiess, a junior outfielder, notched the lone RBI of the game for the Huskies as freshman pitcher Chris Koenig was given the loss after 6.0 innings pitched and three strikeouts. The Huskies fell 10-6 in the second game of the double-header, making their overall record at the time 1-5, 0-0 NCC. Noah Czech, a senior infielder, led all SCSU sluggers with three hits and one RBI. Dan Skog and Luke Klitzke paced the Husky offense with two hits apiece.

Against CSU-Pueblo, SCSU lost two games on March 6 (L, 7-4/ L, 12-6) and two games on March 7 (L, 24-6/L, 8-7). In the four games combined, freshman Dan Gaughan, sophomore Luke Klitzke and junior outfielder Kyle Johnson had 16 hits and nine RBIs. Tyler Knott, Ryan Carlson, David Carlson and Matt Means each tallied losses from the mound in the four games.

St. Cloud State wrapped up its spring break trip with a double-header against Mesa State on March 8. In the first game, SCSU's Dan Skog and Dan Gaughan each collected an RBI in the 18-2 loss. Senior Nate Swan tallied the loss from the mound. The Huskies completed their Colorado road trip with a 24-2 loss to Mesa State in the second game. Skog led all SCSU hitters with one run scored, one hit and one RBI. Freshman pitcher Ben Johnson suffered the loss from the mound.



COACH LORSUNG'S CORNER: Beginning his 28th season, SCSU's head coach Denny Lorsung (St. Cloud State) completed his 27th season in 2005. The winningest coach in SCSU history, Lorsung has posted a 532-534-3 overall won/loss record with the Huskies in 27 seasons. In addition, the 2005 season marked Lorsung's 30th year overall as a collegiate coach, in which he has accumulated a 569-558-3 career record. His career total currently places him 25th in the NCAA Division II coaching records for most victories among active coaches and in the top 50 in the all-time NCAA Division II coaching records for most career wins as of 2005.
