BUSY WEEK AHEAD FOR THE HUSKIES: The SCSU baseball team (9-21, 4-8 NCC) will be busy this week with five games scheduled for the next five days. The Huskies will travel to Collegetville on Thursday to take on the St. John's

University Johnnies (16-13, 9-5 MIAC) in a nine-inning game scheduled for 4:00 p.m. Then on Saturday the Huskies will travel to Duluth for a double header against the University of Minnesota Duluth (13-26, 3-8 NCC); games begin at 1:00 p.m. The following day, the Huskies will host UMD in a second round of doubleheaders at Dick Putz Field starting at 1:00 p.m.

SCSU VS WINONA RESCHEDULED: The April 24 game series against Winona has been rescheduled for Wednesday, May 2 in Winona. Games are set to begin at 2:00 p.m.

HUSKIES GO 1-3 AGAINST MANKATO: The St. Cloud State University Husky baseball team (9-21, 4-8 NCC) played two doubleheaders against the Mankato Mavericks (30-7, 10-1 NCC) over the past few days. The first round of games took place on Friday, April 20 in Mankato with the second on Monday, April 23 at Dick Putz Field in St. Cloud. On Friday the Huskies went 1-1 with the Mavericks as they lost game one 4-3, but came back to win game one 4-3 over the Mavs.

Mankato came out quick in game one scoring two, one-run innings off a hit from Nick Gonzalez and a fielding error from SCSU's third baseman Kyle Resser (Bonney Lake, WI). The Huskies came back at the top of the fourth with three runs. First baseman Louis Lang (Montgomery) scored first off a hit from left fielder Bruce Thompson (Maplewood), designated hitter Kirby Marquart (Hancock) followed with a single to left field from the catcher Ben Anderson (Barron, WI), and Thompson rounded to home to score the final run for the Huskies. Mankato's Eric Austvold scored in the bottom of the fourth tying the game at three. After the seventh, the game was still tied 3-3 calling for extra innings. With the Huskies held scoreless at the top of the eighth, the Mavericks scored the winning run off a right field single from Josh Simon.

The Husky batting was led by Thompson with a run, a hit, and an RBI, Lang, Marquart, and Thompson each had a hit and a run apiece, Anderson and second baseman Joe Kroc (Austin) both had a hit and an RBI, and shortstop Dan Skog (Anoka) finished with one hit. Defensively, Lang had 11 putouts and three assists, Skog came up with four putouts and two assists, and Kroc had six assists.

Winning pitcher Nick Fellman had two strikeouts in his 1.1 innings of play. Starting pitcher Jon Bjelland struck out eight batters and gave up three walks and six hits. SCSU's starting pitcher Tyler Knott (Raymond) tallied one strikeout while on the mound, as did closing pitcher Scott Sand (Sauk Rapids). Also seeing time on the mound for the Huskies was Mitchell Staley (Brooklyn, WI).

Game Final: SCSU - 3 runs, 6 hits, and 1 error; MSU - 4 runs, 7 hits, and 1 error.

The Huskies scored first in the second game with right field homerun by DH Kirby Marquart to start the second inning. Mankato charged back in the bottom of the third scoring two runs off a hit from Eric Austvold down the right field line and Adam Sudbeck scored the final run of the inning for Mankato. SCSU tied the game in the fifth inning with a two-run homer from centerfielder Nate Johnson (Austin). Leftfielder Dan Gaughan (Sartell) scored the winning run for the Huskies in the top of the seventh inning off a passed ball from Mankato pitcher Dane Secott.

N. Johnson led the Huskies at the plate with one run, one hit, and two RBIs. Marquart had a run, a hit, and an RBI, Gaughan and centerfielder Dan Kroc (Austin) each had a run and a hit, and first baseman Louis Lang (Montgomery) finished with one hit. Lang and catcher Beau Bentley (Troup, TX) both had six putouts and one assists on the game, right fielder Kyle Johnson (Prior Lake), second baseman Joe Kroc (Austin), and N. Johnson each had each had two putouts.

Mitchell Staley (Brooklyn, WI) got the win for the Huskies and Adam McGrane (Plymouth) is credited with the save. In his 5.1 innings of play, SCSU's starting pitcher Ben Johnson (Milaca) retired five batters and gave up only three walks. MSU's starting pitcher Dane Secott struck out seven batters and gave up five hits in his 6.1 innings of play.

The SCSU Huskies came out tough in the first inning scoring four. Designated hitter Kirby Marquart (Hancock) scored the first run of the game off a single from right fielder Dan Gaughan (Sartell) and left fielder Bruce Thompson (Maplewood) followed with a three-run homerun scoring Gaughan and first baseman Louis Lang (Montgomery). Mankato answered back in the top of the third with three runs of their own first off a homerun by Josh Simon and then a two-run homerun from Kyle Hoover. The Mavericks scored four more in the top of the fourth inning off a grand slam by Nick Gonzalez. The Huskies scored one more in the bottom of the inning as Gaughan scored off a ground out by second baseman Joe Kroc (Austin), but were unable to

gain the lead. Both teams were held scoreless in the next three innings as Mankato went on to win 7-5.

Thompson led the Huskies with one run, two hits, and two RBIs, Gaughan had two runs, two hits, and one RBI, third baseman Kyle Resser (Bonney Lake, WA) and catcher Beau Bentley (Troup, TX) each had one hit, Marquart and first baseman Louis Lang (Montgomery) each had a hit, and Kroc ended with one RBI. Lang led the defense with 10 putouts, Kroc had one putout and five assists, shortstop Dan Skog (Anoka) had one putout and two assists, and Bentley added three putouts for the Huskies.

Mankato's winning pitcher Danny Klous struck out two batters and gave up five hits in his five innings on the mound and closing pitcher Nick Fellman struck out two. Starting on the mound for the Huskies was Ryan Carlson (Moundsview) who retired three batters while on the mound and closing pitcher Mitchell Staley (Brooklyn, WI) gave up only one hit.

Mankato came out with an early start in the final game of the series scoring one in the first inning off a single from Travis Taran and three in the second off a single from Pat Ottum and a two-run homerun from Zach Danelson. The Huskies brought the score to 3-2 with back-to-back one run innings. In the fourth inning, designated hitter Louis Lang (Montgomery) hit his eighth homerun of the season, first baseman Kirby Marquart (Hancock) followed in the fifth with his third homerun. Mankato sealed their lead in the sixth inning with Josh Simon, Kosuke Hattori, Pat Ottum, Eric Austvold, and Nick Gonzalez all scoring for the Mavericks. Mankato scored one more in the seventh ending the game at 10-2.

Marquart and Lang led the Husky bats as they each tallied one run, one hit, one RBI, and one homerun, shortstop Dan Skog (Anoka) and second baseman Joe Kroc (Austin) had two hits apiece, and right fielder Dan Gaughan (Sartell) and catcher Ben Anderson (Barron, WI) both had one hit. Marquart also led the team defensively with 11 putouts.

Winning Maverick pitcher Patrick Criss tallied three strikeouts and gave up three walks and eight hits. Adam McGrane (Plymouth) started on the mound for the Huskies tallying four strikeouts and giving up only two walks and relief pitcher Ryan Tschida (Grey Eagle) gave up only one hit.

Game Final: SCSU - 2 runs, 9 hits, and 0 errors; MSU - 10 runs, 9 hits, and 0 errors.

SEASON RECORD: The Huskies are now at 9-21 overall and 4-8 in the North Central Conference.

IN THE NCC: Overall, Ben Johnson is seventh in pitching with a record of 2-3, a 5.09 ERA, and 36 strikeouts...Ryan Carlson is eighth with a 2-2 record, 5.36 ERA, and fifth in strikeouts with 40...Adam McGrane is ninth with an ERA



of 5.91, a 1-5 record, and 24 strikeouts and fifth in saves with three... Kyle Resser is part of a five-way tie for second in triples with three... St. Cloud is ranked second in team fielding with a .962 percentage... In the NCC Dan Skog is ranked sixth in hits with 13... Adam McGrane is third in innings pitched with 18.0.



QUICK HITS: Joe Kroc leads the team in batting with a .444 batting average, four hits, two RBIs, and four total bases... Dan Skog is second with a .374 average, 99 at bats, 19 runs, 37 hits, six RBIs, and 43 total bases... Kyle Johnson leads with a .511 slugging percentage, 14 runs, 32 hits, and 12 RBIs... Kirby Marquart leads in RBIs with 17 so far on the season, he adds 12 runs, 15 hits, and three homeruns...



IN THE DIRT: Louis Langs leads the Husky defense with 147 putouts, 10 assists, and two errors... Ben Anderson has 56 putouts, eight assists, and two errors... so far this year the Huskies have turned 25 doubleplays and have a total of 618 putouts... SCSU has a current fielding percentage of .962... Kirby Marquart, Issac Klint, Luke Klitzke, and Ryan Tschida all have a fielding percentage of 1.000.



ON THE MOUND: Mitchell Staley leads the pitching squad with a 1.69 ERA, a 1-2 record, 10 strikeouts, and eight walks... in three appearances, Jamen Hulegarrd has struck out seven batters and gave up 10 walks... Ben Johnson leads in innings pitched with 40.2, he holds a 5.09 ERA, 2-3 record, 36 strikeouts, and has completed two games... Ryan Carlson leads the team in strikeouts with 40, he has played 40.1 innings, and has given up 40 hits.

2006 RECORD: The Huskies posted an 11-32-1 overall record and finished fifth in the North Central Conference with a 5-15 record.

SCSU TO HOST NCC TOURNAMENT: St. Cloud's Dick Putz Field and Joe Faber Field will be the site of the 2007 North Central Conference Tournament, May 9-12. The Huskies will host the tournament for the third time, as SCSU was the host school in 1994 and 1988.

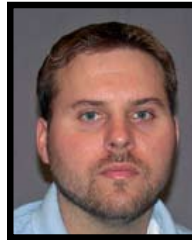

Jason Fischer (SCSU, 2000) will serve as the SCSU head coach for the remainder of the 2007 season. A former Husky pitcher/infielder, he set the SCSU single season pitching record for appearances with 17 games.

Fischer graduated with a bachelor's degree in community psychology and a double master's in physical education and sport management from SCSU. He currently resides in St. Cloud and is a full time instructor in the PESS department at SCSU.

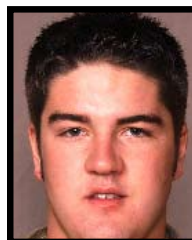


Coach Brueske

Jason Brueske joins the Husky baseball staff in 2006-07 as a graduate assistant. Brueske graduated from North Dakota State University with a bachelor's of science in business administration in 2003.

While at NDSU, Brueske was a four-year standout for the Bison baseball team. In 2001, Brueske led the North Central Conference in hitting with a .526 batting average. Also in 2001, he was named to the All-NCC second team, was 17th in the nation with a .787 slugging percentage and ranked 27th nationally with a .436 batting average. Brueske signed a professional contract with the River City Rascals of the Frontier League and currently ranks in the top ten in multiple NDSU career and single-season records.

Brueske is currently working towards a master's of science in sport management at SCSU. He and his wife Donni reside in St. Cloud with their son Ty and daughter Taylor.



Coach Nelson

Chase Nelson begins his second year as the student assistant coach for the Huskies in 2007. The former Husky will be working with the hitters. During Nelson's three-year career he amassed a 6.67 ERA with an overall record of 3-5. He made 32 appearances, pitched 87.4 innings and notched four saves.

Nelson graduated from Pequot Lakes High School in 2001, where he earned ten letters. He was a five-time letter winner in baseball, earning four gold gloves and three team MVPs. A two-time team MVP in hockey and three-time letter winner in football, Nelson graduated from Pequot Lakes with honors.

A physical education major at SCSU, Nelson is the son of Calvin and Connie Nelson of Pine River and enjoys fishing and hunting in his free time.
