**HUSKIES FINISH END 2006/07 SEASON AT #3:** The St. Cloud State University Husky baseball team finished third in the North Central Conference with an overall season record of 16-29, 10-15 in the NCC.

**SEVEN HUSKIES NAMED TO BASEBALL HONOR ROLL:** Seven members of the St. Cloud State University 2006/07 baseball team were named to the North Central Conference Commissioner's Academic Baseball Honor Roll. On May 16th, the NCC named sophomores Patrick DeLaHunt (Apple Valley) Business, Dan Gaughan (Sartell) Business, Steve Hazen (Waupaca, WI) Business/Economics, Ben Johnson (Milaca) PE/Sports Science, Nate Johnson (Austin) Communication Arts/Literature, and Isaac Kindt (Anoka) Business, and senior Adam McGrane (Plymouth) Finance to the honor roll. A total of 44 student-athletes achieved the honor. To qualify student-athletes must have a minimum 3.20 grade point average, have complete at least two semesters at their current school, and have competed against outside competition.

**HUSKIES ANNOUNCE TEAM HONORS:** Following the completion the St. Cloud State University Husky baseball team voted on individual honors for the 2007 season. Senior shortstop Dan Skog (Anoka) was named as the 2007 Most Valuable Player, senior Adam McGrane (Plymouth) was selected as the 2007 Most Valuable Pitcher, sophomore Ben Johnson (Milaca) received the 2007 Hardest Worker Award, and junior Ryan Sturm (Springfield) was awarded the 2007 Most Improved.

**SCSU INTERVIEWS THREE FOR HEAD COACH POSITION:** St. Cloud State University Director of Athletics Dr. Morris Kurtz announced the three finalists for the Husky baseball head coach position: Dakota State University (Madison, SD) Head Coach Pat Dolan, Southwest Minnesota State University Head Coach Paul Blanchard, and Jamestown College Head Coach Tom Hager.

**MCGRANE, SKOG, THOMPSON NAMED TO ALL-NCC BASEBALL TEAM:** Three members of the Husky baseball team have been named to the 2007 All-North Central Conference Baseball Team. Senior pitcher Adam McGrane (Plymouth), senior shortstop Dan Skog (Anoka), and sophomore left fielder Bruce Thompson (Maplewood) all received the honor for the first time in their career on Tuesday, May 15.

McGrane ended the season with a 4-6 record, 10-18 in his career. In 2007 he had 47 strikeouts and pitched an NCC high 65.1 innings. He ended the season with a 5.23 ERA. McGrane was also listed as honorable mention as a relief pitcher.

three walks, a triple and a home run without a strikeout. He also crossed the plate four times.

In the last week in April, Thompson helped the Huskies to a solid 3-2 record that included wins over St. John's University and Minnesota Duluth. He had three hits in the 7-3 win over SJU on April 26 and he also had three hits and a home run in the win over Minnesota Duluth on April 27.

At the end of the 2007 season, Skog was sitting at a .327 batting average with 31 runs, 51 hits, 29 RBIs, five doubles, and 58 total bases. In his career as a Husky, Skog collected 105 runs, 161 hits, 27 doubles, and ended with a batting average of .284. Defensively, Skog has tallied 54 putouts, 125 assists, and sits at a .952 fielding rate.

**JOHNSON NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK:**

On Monday, March 26, sophomore pitcher Ben Johnson was named the North Central Conference Pitcher of the Week. Johnson pitched a complete game in a 3-2 win over William Penn College on March 29 in Oskaloosa, Iowa. He allowed six hits, two unearned runs, and struck out four batters in the outing.

Johnson ended the season with a 6.00 ERA, a 2-3 record, nine appearances, eight starts, and two completions. Before injury, Johnson played 45.0 innings where he amassed 38 strikeouts.

Thompson finishes the 2007 season with a .300 batting average, 21 runs, and 39 hits. He also adds six doubles, a triple, two home runs, and 24 RBIs. In his two seasons as a Husky, Thompson sits at a .328 batting average, 50 runs, 89 hits, 52 RBIs, and has made 36 putouts.

**BRUCE THOMPSON NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** SCSU's left fielder Bruce Thompson (Maplewood) was named the NCC Player of the Week for the week ending April 29.

Thompson, a sophomore outfielder from Maplewood, Minn. and graduate of Hill-Murray High School, hit .625 (10x16) in five games last week. He amassed nine RBI,

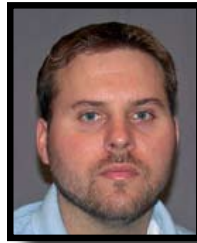

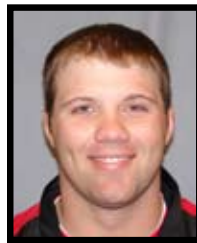
**2006/07 COACHING STAFF**



*Coach Fischer*

Jason Fischer (SCSU, 2000) served as the SCSU head coach for the remainder of the 2007 season. A former Husky pitcher/infielder, he set the SCSU single season pitching record for appearances with 17 games.

Fischer graduated with a bachelor's degree in community psychology and a double master's in physical education and sport management from SCSU. He currently resides in St. Cloud and is a full time instructor in the PESS department at SCSU.

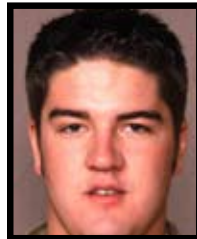


*Coach Brueske*

Jason Brueske joined the Husky baseball staff in 2006-07 as a graduate assistant and took on assistant coaching duties under the leadership of Fischer. Brueske graduated from North Dakota State University with a bachelor's of science in business administration in 2003.

While at NDSU, Brueske was a four-year standout for the Bison baseball team. In 2001, Brueske led the North Central Conference in hitting with a .526 batting average. Also in 2001, he was named to the All-NCC second team, was 17th in the nation with a .787 slugging percentage and ranked 27th nationally with a .436 batting average. Brueske signed a professional contract with the River City Rascals of the Frontier League and currently ranks in the top ten in multiple NDSU career and single-season records.

Brueske is currently working towards a master's of science in sport management at SCSU. He and his wife Donni reside in St. Cloud with their son Ty and daughter Taylor.

Chase Nelson completed his second year as the student assistant coach for the Huskies in 2007. The former Husky worked with the hitters. During Nelson's three-year career he amassed a 6.67 ERA with an overall record of 3-5. He made 32 appearances, pitched 87.4 innings and notched four saves.

Nelson graduated from Pequot Lakes High School in 2001, where he earned ten letters. He was a five-time letter winner in baseball, earning four gold gloves and three team MVPs. A two-time team MVP in hockey and three-time letter winner in football, Nelson graduated from Pequot Lakes with honors.

A physical education major at SCSU, Nelson is the son of Calvin and Connie Nelson of Pine River and enjoys fishing and hunting in his free time.

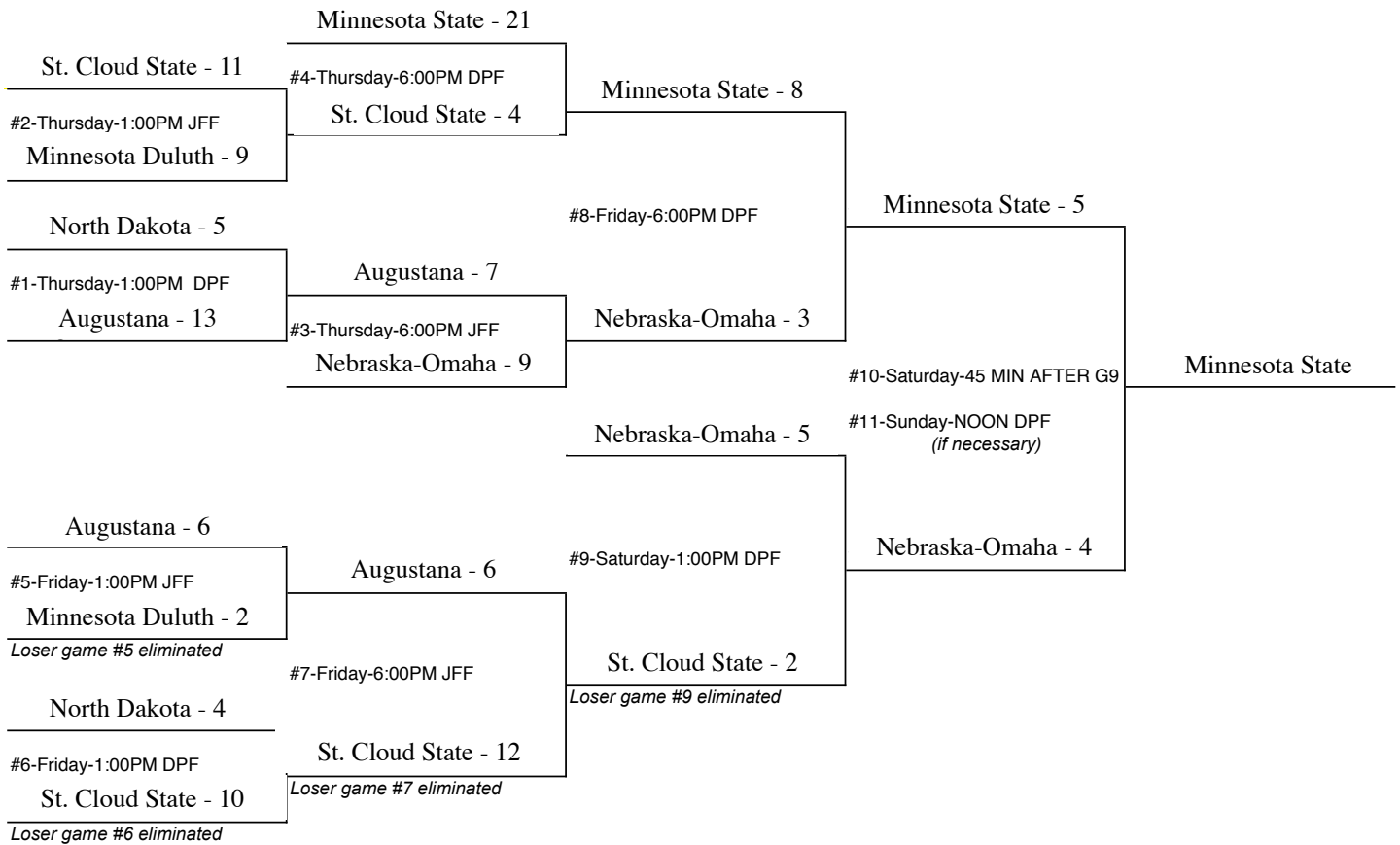
