2006 RECORD: The 2006 St. Cloud State University baseball team posted a 11-32-1 overall record and finished fifth in the North Central Conference with a 5-15 overall record.

HUSKIES COMPLETE SEASON AT NCC CHAMPIONSHIPS: The 2006 SCSU baseball team completed its season going 0-1 in the North Central Conference Baseball Tournament, which was held in Mankato. The fifth-ranked Huskies dropped the first game of the tournament to fourth-ranked Augustana, 7-8, in the bottom of the ninth inning. Due to extensive rain in the greater Mankato area, the original double-elimination NCC tournament was changed to a single elimination tournament. All teams but Minnesota State and Nebraska-Omaha were sent home on Friday, May 12, after playing no more than two games on Thursday, May 11. Minnesota State was victorious over UNO in the Championship game, 7-5, which was played on Saturday, May 13. This marked MSU's 20th NCC Crown.

This is the first year that the NCC invited all six teams to the conference tournament. In years past, only the top four NCC teams were invited to the tournament. The seatings were as follows: 1. Minnesota State (16-2), 2. Nebraska-Omaha (14-3), 3. Minnesota Duluth (8-11), 4. Augustana (7-11), 5. St. Cloud State (5-14), 6. North Dakota (4-13).



Lorsung

HEAD COACH DENNY LORSUNG: SCSU's head coach Denny Lorsung (St. Cloud State) completed his 28th season in 2006. The winningest coach in SCSU history, Lorsung has posted a 541-555-4 overall won/loss record with the Huskies in 28 seasons. In addition, the 2006 season marked Lorsung's 30th year overall as a collegiate coach, in which he has accumulated a 578-579-4 career record. His career total currently places him 25th in the NCAA Division II coaching records for most victories among active coaches and in the top 50 in the all-time NCAA Division II coaching records for most career wins as of 2005. Lorsung was assisted by second-year graduate assistant Jason Fischer and first-year student assistant Chase Nelson in 2006.

SENIORS TAKE A BOW: The Huskies had five seniors who played in their last games on May 11. The senior class included: Noah Czech (Little Falls), Mike Hoelscher (Alexandria), Matt Means (Brainerd), Nate Swan (Sauk Rapids) and Reid Weber (St. Michael).

JOHNSON AND SWAN LEADS SCSU IN NCC TOURNEY: The Huskies were led by freshman Ben Johnson (Milaca) and senior Nate Swan (Sauk Rapids) at the NCC Championships on May 11 against Augustana. Johnson tallied two hits, including his second homerun of the season in the top of the sixth inning. Swan contributed two hits, two RBIs and one run scored in his final career game.

HUSKY ACADEMIC HONOR ROLL: SCSU's Noah Czech, Gary Kiess and Adam McGrane were named to the inaugural North Central Conference Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll for baseball in 2006. Czech, a senior infielder from Little Falls, earned a 3.49 GPA in the classroom while studying towards an environmental studies major. Czech played in 77 career games for the Huskies and made 33 starts. He finished with a .236 career batting average and tallied 34 hits in three years. Junior center fielder, Gary Kiess, has posted a 3.37 GPA in finance. A native of nearby Cold Spring, Kiess has amassed a .235 batting average and 80 hits in three years of play. In 2006, Kiess tallied 26 hits, including one homerun and five doubles. In the outfield, Kiess sported a .986 fielding percentage. McGrane, a junior pitcher from Plymouth, has a 3.87 GPA in finance. In 2006, McGrane earned a 2-5 record on the mound after making 13 appearances. He was third on the team with 24 strikeouts 39.1 innings pitched. The 2006 Baseball Commissioner's Honor Roll consisted of 29 student-athletes, each of who have achieved a minimum 3.20 GPA, have completed at least two semesters at their current school and have competed against outside competition.

SKOG AND SWAN NAMED TO ALL-NCC HONORABLE MENTION TEAM: SCSU's junior short stop Dan Skog (Anoka, Minn.) and senior infielder Nate Swan (Sauk Rapids, Minn.) were named to the 2006 All-North Central Conference Honorable Mention Baseball Team for their efforts this season.

Skog finished the season batting .285 with a team second-best 29 runs scored and a team-leading 10 stolen bases. In the field, Skog led the team with 117 assisted putouts. Swan led the team with 11 home runs in 2006, which places him second in the Huskies' recordbook behind Mike McKinney ('97) and Jim Schlieman ('99), who each lead the recordbook with 12 home runs in a single season. Swan completed his career leading the Huskies with 34 runs during his senior campaign and 37 RBIs.

Nebraska-Omaha's Chad Leon was named the NCC Most Valuable Player of the season and Tyler Cloyd from Nebraska-Omaha was named the Most Valuable Pitcher in 2006. Dean Bowyer from Minnesota State was named the NCC Coach of the Year after leading the Mavericks to the conference tournament championship in 2006. Named to the All-NCC Team were 10 seniors, three juniors, three sophomores and one freshman. Honors were voted on by the NCC coaches.

2005 SEASON RESULTS: The 2005 SCSU baseball team finished their season with a record of 20-26 overall and 4-16 in the North Central Conference under the direction of head coach Denny Lorsung. The Huskies matched a 16-year-old winning streak after stringing together 10 consecutive wins in early April. The 10-game streak was the longest winning streak since 1989 and was ended when SCSU fell to Nebraska-Omaha on April 9, 2005. During the season, the Huskies posted an 8-8 record in one run games. SCSU lost seven one-run games in NCC play in 2005.

TOUCH THEM ALL NATE SWAN: Husky senior Nate Swan led SCSU with 11 homeruns on the season. From April 14-18, Swan hit a homerun in four consecutive games and was a big part of SCSU winning two-out-of-three games against Minnesota Duluth on May 2 and splitting on the road against North Dakota on May 5-6.

WINNING STREAKS: SCSU's longest winning streak was two games this season. The Huskies accomplished this three times in 2006. On April 15, SCSU snapped a three-game losing streak when they beat Augustana, 6-5. The Huskies then went on their first two-game winning streak after defeating Bemidji State 9-4 in the first game of that double-header. The two other streaks came against Minnesota Duluth on May 2 when SCSU won the first game of the rare NCC triple header, 8-2, and then won the second game 8-6. The last two-game winning streak was recorded against North Dakota on May 6, when the Huskies won 2-0 and 8-4 in Grand Forks, N.D.

HUSKY HISTORY IN THE NCC TOURNAMENT:

This season was the first time since 2001 that SCSU made the NCC tournament. The last two appearances that the Huskies made were in 2001 and 1999.

In 2001, the Huskies advanced to the NCC tournament after sporting an 18-11 regular season record and a third place finish in the NCC with a 10-9 record. In the tournament, the fourth-seeded Huskies defeated the top-seeded Minnesota State, Mankato in the first round, 5-1. SCSU then dropped their second game in the tournament to former NCC team, SDSU, 23-5. The Huskies then faced MSU again to determine who would meet SDSU in the championship game. SCSU dropped that game 4-1, going 1-2 in the tournament and finishing the season 19-13 overall.

In 1999, the Huskies posted a 28-19 overall record and finished the season fourth in the NCC with a 11-9 record. In the tournament, SCSU earned a 2-2 record, falling to Minnesota State, Mankato 3-2 in the Championship game. The Huskies lost their first game of the tournament to the top-seeded MSU Mavericks, 16-1. SCSU turned around and beat SDSU 10-1 and UNO 10-8. Those wins put the Huskies in the Championship game. After 11 innings, SCSU fell to MSU, 3-2.
