2005 ST. CLOUD STATE UNIVERSITY BASEBALL TEAM NEWS



Release Date: May 17, 2005 - FINAL RELEASE

END OF 2005 SEASON: The St. Cloud State University baseball team finished their season with a record of 20-26 overall and 4-16 in the North Central Conference under the direction of head coach Denny Lorsung.

Honorable Mention All-NCC: Three Huskies earned North Central Conference Honorable Mention honors in 2005. Junior pitcher Mike Hoelscher (Alexandria), junior catcher Travis Thompson (Rice Lake, WI) and first year first baseman Luke Klitzke (Hutchinson) were named to the Honorable Mention squad.

Academic ALL-NCC: Four SCSU baseball players have been named to the Academic All-North Central Conference Honorable Mention Baseball Team. Senior infielder Kevin Macdonald, junior infielder Noah Czech, sophomore outfielder Gary Kiess, and sophomore pitcher Adam McGrane were named Honorable Mention.

Huskies in the NCC: Several SCSU players rank among the top players in the NCC after the regular season. Freshman Luke Klitzke (Hutchinson) ranks fifth in the conference for batting average with a mark of .377. Sophomore Adam McGrane (Plymouth) stands out among NCC pitchers with an ERA of 5.44.

Head Coach: St. Cloud State University head coach Denny Lorsung (St.



Cloud State) has completed his 27th season leading the Huskies. The winningest coach in SCSU history, Lorsung has posted a 531-523-3 overall won/loss record with the Huskies in 27 seasons. In addition, the 2005 season marked Lorsung's 30th year overall as a collegiate coach, in which he has accumulated a 568-547-3 career record. His career total placed him 26th in NCAA Division II coaching records for most victories among active coaches and in the top 50 in the all-time NCAA Division II coaching records for most career wins as of 2004.

Assistant Coaching Staff: Assisting Lorsung in 2005 were two former Huskies, graduate assistant Jason Fischer and volunteer assistant Paul Buboltz. Fischer was a two-year player for the Huskies in 1998 and 1999 as a pitcher and infielder. In 1999, he posted a 4-1 record on the mound with a team best 1.61 ERA, and set the SCSU single season appearance record with 17 games. Fischer also tied for the conference lead with a 0.00 ERA and led the conference in opponents against batting average at .125. Buboltz pitched for the Huskies in 2002 and 2003. He made 23 mound appearances and was named to the 2003 Academic Honorable Mention All-NCC team.



2005 Captains: The 2005 Husky captains were senior pitcher Chase Nelson (Pequot Lakes), senior outfielder Ryan Kapsner (North Mankato), and junior infielder/outfielder/pitcher Nathan Swan (Sauk Rapids).

Team Awards: The St. Cloud State Huskies have announced their team award winners for 2005. Junior catcher Travis Thompson was voted Most Valuable Player. Thompson started 43 games for the Huskies and hit .336. He led the team in doubles with 11. Sophomore pitcher Adam McGrane was voted the Most Valuable Pitcher. McGrane made nine starts, pitched two complete games, and posted a 2-5 record with a 5.44 ERA.

2006 Team Captains: The Huskies have elected captains for the 2006 season. They are Travis Thompson, Mike Hoelscher and Nate Swan.

FAREWELL TO SENIORS

#7 RYAN KAPSNER: Outfielder Ryan Kapsner of North Mankato made 38 starts in 2005 and batted .295. He totalled 36 hits on the season and finished his career with 83 hits. Kapsner, known to be a strong baserunner, was successful on 13-of-14 stolen base attempts this season and had 29 total stolen bases as a Husky.

#22 KEVIN MACDONALD: Third baseman and designated hitter Kevin Macdonald, from London, Ontario, wrapped up his St. Cloud State career with a third-best batting average of .350. In 80 at-bats, Macdonald had 28 hits, including 4 doubles and 5 homeruns. On his career, he accumulated 68 hits and 41 rbis.

#12 NATE LARSON: Pitcher and Sauk Rapids native Nate Larson made seven appearances on the mound this season. He gained a win against Minnesota-Crookston on April 2, 2005. He struck out 29 batters in his career in 58.0 innings pitched.

#30 CHASE NELSON: Right handed pitcher Chase Nelson, from Pine River, made a team-high 12 appearances in 2005. He finished the season with a 2-4 record and a 6.56 ERA. In his career, Nelson made 35 appearances, struck out 46 batters, and pitched 101.5 innings. Nelson was named NCC Pitcher of the Week on April 4 of this season.

OTHER HUSKY NOTABLES

#16 NATE SWAN: Junior third baseman and pitcher Nate Swan of Sauk Rapids made 44 starts for SCSU this season. Swan batted .329 with 46 hits, including 6 doubles and 2 homeruns, and stole 7 bases. Swan also made 3 pitching appearances and gained wins on all three occasions. He struck out 5 batters and had a 5.65 ERA.

#18 MIKE HOELSCHER: From Alexandria, MN, junior pitcher Mike Hoelscher made 11 appearances on the mound this season. He finished with a 7.32 ERA and a 2-7 record. Hoelscher struck out 24 batters in a team-high 55.1 innings pitched.

#25 TRAVIS THOMPSON: Junior catcher Travis Thompson from Rice Lake, WI made 43 starts behind the plate in 2005. He batted .336 on the season and had the second most hits with 48. Thompson led the Huskies in doubles with 11 and struck out just 11 times.

#1 DAN SKOG: Sophomore shortstop Dan Skog led the Huskies in baserunning this season, totalling 15 stolen bases. He batted .239 with 34 hits and 7 doubles.

#14 KYLE JOHNSON: Sophomore right fielder Kyle Johnson from Prior Lake had the second best batting average in 2005 with .354. Johnson had 35 hits, including 6 doubles and 2 homeruns, in 99 at-bats. He was second on the team for rbis with 26 this season.

#5 BOBBY GREGOIRE: Second baseman Bobby Gregoire (Maple Grove) made 39 starts as a sophomore. He batted .267 with 31 hits. In the field, Gregoire had the third highest number of putouts with 75.

#8 GARY KIESS: Cold Spring native Gary Kiess, a sophomore center fielder, was the regular lead-off batter for SCSU in 2005. Kiess batted .229 on the season and had 27 hits and 7 doubles. Kiess had 63 putouts.

#23 ADAM MCGRANE: Sophomore Adam McGrane was tied for pitching appearances with 11 trips to the mound as a sophomore. He maintained a 5.44 ERA and finished 2005 with a 2-5 record. In 46.1 innings pitched, McGrane struck out 26 batters and pitched two complete games.

#24 LUKE KLITZKE: Freshman first baseman Luke Klitzke (Hutchinson) led the Huskies at the plate this season with a .377 batting average. He had 57 hits including 10 homeruns. Klitzke started and played in every game this season (46). He also led the team in put-outs with 348 and just 4 errors. He had a team leading ten home runs, just two shy of the school record 12 home runs in a season.

Team Notes: The Huskies matched a 16-year-old winning streak after stringing together 10 consecutive wins in early April. The 10-game streak was the longest winning streak since 1989 and was ended when St. Cloud State fell to Nebraska-Omaha on April 9. During the season, the Huskies posted an 8-8 record in one run games. SCSU lost seven one-run games in NCC play in 2005.

HUSKIES WRAP UP SEASON WITH NORTH DAKOTA: The Huskies finished the 2005 season with two doubleheaders against North Dakota on May 6 and 7. The Huskies lost the first game of the series in an extra inning 5-6 decision. The game featured 21 total hits, including 9 for the Huskies. Travis Thompson and Luke Klitzke both doubled to drive in two runs each, while Dan Skog singled to gain the team's fifth rbi of the game. The teams were tied at 5-5 going into the extra inning. UND drove in a run off of a double by Frenzel and the game ended after a 1, 2, 3 bottom half from SCSU. St. Cloud dropped the night game 6-1 after being outhit 5 to 12. Five Huskies had hits, including a Gary Kiess homerun. On May 7, St. Cloud gained a twin bill split with a first game loss and win that wrapped up the season. Game one ended with a 2-0 final score in favor of UND. Bobby Gregoire, Skog, and Klitzke each had a hit, but the Huskies were unable to empty the bases for runs. Adam McGrane struck out seven batters in seven innings pitched. The final game of the season resulted in a 2-1 victory for the home team. Ryan Tschida knocked out a homerun in the first inning while Ryan Kapsner hit a game-winning single in the bottom of the seventh to end the game. Nate Swan pitched a complete game, striking out four batters and giving up just one run.
