HUSKIES TRAVELING

SOUTH: The No. 20 Huskies will start the month of March playing in the Dunn Hospitality Group Classic in Evansville, Ind., which is hosted by the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship University of Southern Indiana. The Huskies will start the tournament with a noon game against Missouri-St. Louis on Sunday, March 6 before playing a pair of nine-inning games on Thursday, March 10 against Wayne State and Bellarmine at noon and 3 p.m. SCSU will then play on Saturday, March 12 against the University of Wisconsin Parkside in a double header (9inn/7inn). The Huskies end the tournament March 13 with a 2 p.m. game against UW-Parkside (9 innings) followed by a nine-inning game with the host team Southern Indiana University at 5:30 p.m.

OFF TO A GOOD START: The Huskies took two of three from Arkansas Tech on Feb. 13 & 14. SCSU won the first nine inning game 10-5, before winning the first game of a double header 8-4 on Monday. They lost the final game (9 inn.) 8-5 Monday evening.

FAST START FOR FRESHMEN: Freshmen **Eric Loxtercamp** (Cold Spring) and **Kyle Fischer** (New Ulm) performed well in their first collegiate series on Feb.12-13. Loxtercamp batted .571 in the first three games of the season. In seven at bats, Loxtercamp had five runs,

four hits, one double, one homer, two RBI and eight total bases. Fischer was the pitcher of record in the Huskies' 10-5 win over ATU on Feb. 13. In five innings of relief work, Fischer finished the game started by Logan Birr with three strikeouts to his credit. He allowed only three hits in the game. Fischer is now 1-0 on the season for the Huskies. It was Fischer's first appearance in a Husky uniform.

GOING DEEP: Senior **Kent Koch** (Loretto), sophomore **Steve Rindelaub** (St. Cloud) and Loxtercamp all had a homerun in the first series of the season. Rindelaub hit a two-run blast in the 8-5 win Monday, while Koch and Loxtercamp went deep in the 8-5 loss. Loxtercamp hit a two-run homer in the second inning and Koch led off the fifth with a solo shot.

PRE-SEASON PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Sophomore **Jordan Smith** (Willmar) has been named by Baseball America as its 2011

Division II Pre-Season Player of the Year. Smith was also named to Baseball America's Division II Pre-Season All-America team. He was also named NSIC Pre-Season Player of the Year.

2011 NSIC Preseason Player of the Year - #14 Jordan Smith 3B/OF, 6-4, 210, So. R/L-Willmar, Minn.

St. Cloud State's Jordan Smith was picked by the league coaches as the 2011 NSIC Preseason Player of the Year. Smith was a 2010 Rawlings/American Baseball Coaches Association Division II All-America Baseball Team as a third team selection. He started in all 58 games for SCSU while setting team records with a .457 batting average (9th in the nation), 96 hits (8th in the nation), 15 home runs, 78 RBIs (15th in the nation) and 174 total bases (6th in the nation). He was named the NSIC Freshman of the Year and he was also named to the All-NSIC First Team in 2010. Smith was named to the Daktronics and ABCA/Rawlings All-Region squad in 2010 as a First Team selection. He was also named to the 2010 Daktronics Division II All-America team as an honorable mention selection.

2011 NSIC Preseason Pitcher of the Year - #37 Blake Schwartz - RHP, 6-3, 200, Jr., R/R- Rosemount, Minn.

Minnesota State's Blake Schwartz was picked by the league coaches as the 2011 NSIC Preseason Pitcher of the Year. As a sophomore, Schwartz earned Rawlings/American Baseball Coaches Association Third-Team All-American honors. He became only the seventh Maverick in the history of the baseball program to earn All-American honors. Schwartz was also named NSIC Pitcher of the Year and Region Pitcher of the Year by Daktronics, Rawlings ABCA and the NCBWA last year while boasting a 10-2 record with a 3.79 earned run average to go with 64 strikeouts in 90.1 innings pitched.

HEAD COACH PAT DOLAN

Coach Dolan officially began his tenure with SCSU on June 15th, 2007, and he completed his first season with the Huskies in 2008. A tested coaching veteran with a record of success, Dolan led the Huskies to a 27-23-1 overall record in 2008 - the most wins posted by the Huskies since 1999. He also led the club to a third place finish in the always rugged NCC, and a 13-12 league record.

He continued that trend of excellence in 2009, with a then school record 36 victories (36-18). SCSU also opened play in the highly competitive Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference with a solid 15-13 record. The Dolan trend of success continued in 2010, as the Huskies set a new team record with 41 victories (41-17).

The Huskies earned a trip to the NSIC playoffs with a third place record of 23-9 in league play, and they also gained SCSU's first NCAA playoff bid since 1991. At the 2010 NCAA Division II Central Regional in Farmington, N.M., the Huskies posted a 4-2 record and advanced to the regional championship game. In Dolan's 18 years as a head baseball coach his teams have captured an amazing 10 conference regular season championships. He owns a 360-250 career record during his tenure as a coach at the four-year college level, and he also coached for two seasons at Itasca C.C. with a 54-17 record. He has won over 691 games as a head coach, which includes over 280 wins at the American Legion level.



ASSISTANT JOSH VORPAHL

St. Cloud native and former Husky athlete, Josh Vorpahl, has joined the St. Cloud State University baseball coaching staff as an assistant coach. Vorpahl will serve as the team's pitching coach.

Vorpahl has many ties to St. Cloud and the SCSU baseball family. He was a student-athlete at St. Cloud State from 1993-95 and then again in 1998. He started his college baseball career at Itasca Community College playing for current SCSU head coach Pat Dolan. In 1998 he was voted first team all-conference and the North Central Conference Pitcher of the Year, while playing for the Huskies.



ASSISTANT COACH KEN PICHA

Longtime Central Minnesota prep baseball skipper Ken Picha returns to the St. Cloud State University baseball staff as an assistant coach in 2008-09. Picha served as the head varsity baseball coach at nearby Melrose High School for 29 years (1979-2007) and compiled an impressive 427-181 career record. He ranks eighth on the all-time win list among Minnesota high school baseball coaches, and his .702 career winning percentage ranks sixth among Minnesota high school coaches who have a minimum of 350 wins.

In 29 years at Melrose, Picha never had a losing season. His teams won 11 conference titles, seven district championships and his squads advanced to four state tournaments. His 1997 and 1998 teams finished second in the state baseball tournaments. Picha was voted the MSHSL Class AA Coach of the Year in 1998, and he received the Dick Siebert award in 2004.



Mike Bell works in several capacities for the baseball program at SCSU. Bell has been a Husky Dugout Club Board member since 2007, helping in the fundraising efforts for the program. In 2009-10, Bell became a regular "on field" coach in the fall months including indoor workouts in January and February.

Bell brings with him a very strong and noteworthy playing and coaching career. Bell's family moved to Greenwald from the ROCORI District in 1983, when Bell was a freshman in high school. This is where Bell was introduced to SCSU Assistant Coach Ken Picha, who served as the Melrose Head Baseball Coach. Bell was selected as an All-State shortstop in 1987 under Picha.



GRADUATE ASSISTANT COACH CHRIS KOENIG

Coach Koenig has taken a new role with the Huskies. After three years of a key player, Koenig is now a graduate assistant with the team. He takes over Luke MacLean's position, who just recently completed his master's degree.

COACH DERICK SNELL

Coach Snell comes to SCSU with coaching experience with multiple youth programs, at the high school level and as a player/coach with the Monticello Polecats amateur baseball team. Snell now is the director of baseball operations working with everything from team travel, web site and facebook development, team camps to on the field coaching.
