2011 SCSU Baseball News

REGULAR SEASON ENDS: The No. 11 ranked Huskies will play in their final week of Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference regular season play. SCSU will first host Upper Iowa in a 4 p.m. doubleheader on Tuesday at Joe Faber Field and will then host Concordia-St. Paul in a noon doubleheader at noon on Saturday at Faber. The Huskies will play their final regular season twinbill on the road against Concordia-St. Paul at noon on Sunday in St. Paul.

DOMINATING WEEK: St. Cloud State outscored NSIC opponents 66 to 6 in the last five games. The Huskies did not allow a run to Northern State and Minnesota, Crookston in two games to record their fourth and fifth shutout of the season. SCSU has now outscored UMC 78 to 8 in six games played this season.

PAYING TRIBUTE : Tuesday's doubleheader is St. Cloud State Senior & Military Veterans Appreciation Day at Joe Faber Field. **Jeff Heuer** (Brooklyn Park), **Kent Koch** (Loretto), **Ryan Stoll** (Brooklyn Park), **Ryne Schwenke** (Sigourney Iowa) and **Jeremy Ische** (Norwood Young America) will be honored throughout the day along with all veterans of war in attendance. All five players are competing in their final season of collegiate baseball and they have all played vital rolls in the success of the Husky baseball program. Then on Saturday, the Huskies baseball squad will celebrate Alumni and Parent's Day at the park. All alumni in attendance will be announced between games.

LIESER TOSSES A NO-NO: Sophomore standout pitcher **Scott Lieser** (Browerville) was named NSIC Pitcher of the Week after throwing a no-hitter against Northern State Wednesday, April 26 in Carlos, Minn. The Huskies have now won the award for the second straight week, after Schwenke won it last Monday and Lieser is now the fourth player to receive a weekly award from the conference office. Lieser struck out 10 batters in seven innings of work in Wednesday's game to remain a perfect 6-0 on the season. He walked just one batter and only four NSU batters reached base. He now owns a 2.54 ERA to go with 33 strikeouts in 40 2/3 innings on the mound for the Huskies.

IN A LEAGUE OF HIS OWN: Sophomore **Jordan Smith** (Willmar) batted .632 in 19 at bats this week and is now batting .400 on the season. His totals this week included 12 hits, four doubles, nine RBI, 16 total bases and a .842 slugging percentage. He also tallied two walks and eight runs for the Huskies. On April 29, Smith topped his week by going 4-of-4 against UMC and he also had three hits and three RBI in a win over UMC on May 1. On the season, Smith leads all SCSU players in batting average to go with a team-high 60 hits, 16 doubles, two triples, five home runs, 43 RBI, 38 runs, 95 total bases and a .633 slugging rate.

HEAD COACH PAT DOLAN

Coach Dolan officially began his tenure with SCSU on June 15th, 2007, and he completed his first season with the Huskies in 2008. A tested coaching veteran with a record of success, Dolan led the Huskies to a 27-23-1 overall record in 2008 - the most wins posted by the Huskies since 1999. He also led the club to a third place finish in the always rugged NCC, and a 13-12 league record.

He continued that trend of excellence in 2009, with a then school record 36 victories (36-18). SCSU also opened play in the highly competitive Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference with a solid 15-13 record. The Dolan trend of success continued in 2010, as the Huskies set a new team record with 41 victories (41-17). The Huskies earned a trip to the NSIC playoffs with a third place record of 23-9 in league play, and they also gained SCSU's first NCAA playoff bid since 1991. At the 2010 NCAA Division II Central Regional in Farmington, N.M., the Huskies posted a 4-2 record and advanced to the regional championship game. In Dolan's 18 years as a head baseball coach his teams have captured an amazing 10 conference regular season championships. He owns a 360-250 career record during his tenure as a coach at the four-year college level, and he also coached for two seasons at Itasca C.C. with a 54-17 record. He has won over 691 games as a head coach, which includes over 280 wins at the American Legion level.



ASSISTANT JOSH VORPAHL

St. Cloud native and former Husky athlete, Josh Vorpahl, has joined the St. Cloud State University baseball coaching staff as an assistant coach. Vorpahl will serve as the team's pitching coach.

Vorpahl has many ties to St. Cloud and the SCSU baseball family. He was a student-athlete at St. Cloud State from 1993-95 and then again in 1998. He started his college baseball career at Itasca Community College playing for current SCSU head coach Pat Dolan. In 1998 he was voted first team all-conference and the North Central Conference Pitcher of the Year, while playing for the Huskies.



ASSISTANT COACH KEN PICHA

Longtime Central Minnesota prep baseball skipper Ken Picha returns to the St. Cloud State University baseball staff as an assistant coach in 2008-09. Picha served as the head varsity baseball coach at nearby Melrose High School for 29 years (1979-2007) and compiled an impressive 427-181 career record. He ranks eighth on the all-time win list among Minnesota high school baseball coaches, and his .702 career winning percentage ranks sixth among Minnesota high school coaches who have a minimum of 350 wins.

In 29 years at Melrose, Picha never had a losing season. His teams won 11 conference titles, seven district championships and his squads advanced to four state tournaments. His 1997 and 1998 teams finished second in the state baseball tournaments. Picha was voted the MSHSL Class AA Coach of the Year in 1998, and he received the Dick Siebert award in 2004.



ASSISTANT COACH MIKE BELL

Mike Bell works in several capacities for the baseball program at SCSU. Bell has been a Husky Dugout Club Board member since 2007, helping in the fundraising efforts for the program. In 2009-10, Bell became a regular "on field" coach in the fall months including indoor workouts in January and February. Bell brings with him a very strong and noteworthy playing and coaching career. Bell's family moved to Greenwald from the ROCORI District in 1983, when Bell was a freshman in high school. This is where Bell was introduced to SCSU Assistant Coach Ken Picha, who served as the Melrose Head Baseball Coach. Bell was selected as an All-State shortstop in 1987 under Picha.



GRADUATE ASSISTANT COACH CHRIS KOENIG

Coach Koenig has taken a new role with the Huskies. After three years of a key player, Koenig is now a graduate assistant with the team. He takes over Luke MacLean's position, who just recently completed his master's degree.

COACH DERICK SNELL

Coach Snell comes to SCSU with coaching experience with multiple youth programs, at the high school level and as a player/coach with the Monticello Polecats amateur baseball team. Snell now is the director of baseball operations working with everything from team travel, web site and facebook development, team camps to on the field coaching.
