**HUSKIES TAKE 3 OF 4 FROM AUGIE; TWO GAMES BACK OF NCC LEAD:**

The St. Cloud State Baseball Team its second consecutive series NCC series by taking three of four games from Augustana at the Metrodome and in Sioux Falls on Sunday and Tuesday. Kyle Resser (Bonney Lake, Wash.) led the way, batting .538 with eight RBI and one home run over the four games.

**Game One:**

With the series shifting to the Huskies' second home in the Metrodome, SCSU took received a near-perfect relief performance from Matt Swanson (Upsala) to take an 8-6 victory. Swanson threw five innings of one-hit ball to pick up his third victory of the season. Lauren Green (Inglewood, Calif.) hit his third home run in five games and drove in three runs to pace the offense.

**Game Two:**

David Deminsky (Sartell) and Per Nestingen hooked up in a pitcher's duel in game two, as Deminsky came away with his third win of the season. The Sartell native went five innings, striking out eight and allowing two earned runs. Tim Radmacher (Rosemount) came on for the last two innings to pick up his third save. Resser knocked in a pair of runs while Green and Cody Forrester each provided an RBI apiece.

**Game Three:**

With the series shifting to Sioux Falls, the Huskies seemed set to take their third straight, jumping out to an early four-run lead. Augustana, however, would storm back for five runs in the third and three in the fifth to take an 11-7 victory. Four Huskies had multiple hits as Mic Johnson (Fergus Falls) jacked his third home run of the year (a three-run blast) with Resser adding two more RBIs.

**Game Four:**

With Augie battling for a split, SCSU pulled out an extra inning thriller. The Huskies took a one-run lead in the fifth via a two-run, Resser bomb. Augie would rally to tie the game in their half of the seventh, but SCSU put together

a two-out rally in the eighth. With two out, Joe Kroc (Austin) stole second and scored on a Nate Johnson (Austin) single to give the Huskies the 4-3 lead. Chris Koenig (St. Cloud) came on in his first relief appearance to save Radmacher's second win of the season.

**ON THE BALL:** While Kyle Resser's third HBP in the second game Tuesday may have seemed like any other, it ended up rewriting the the Husky record book. SCSU set a new single season record for most hit batsmen in a season with 41 and counting, surpassing the old mark of 38.

**MODELS OF CONSISTENCY:** Tim Scott (Ely) and Chris Koenig are rapidly approaching the SCSU games started record. The mark currently stands at eleven, while both hurlers presently have nine. With approximately three regular season starts left for both, the two should surpass the mark of 11, set by current pitching coach Pete Pratt back, in 1988.

**ALWAYS ON CALL:** Yet another single season pitching record is looking as if it may fall. Mitchell Staley is rapidly approaching Jason Fischer's eight-year old record for appearances, which stands at 17. Staley currently has 13 after throwing in both games on Tuesday.

**HOLES IN THEIR BATS:** The Husky pitching staff has a legitimate shot at breaking the team strikeout record as well. The team is 90 short of the record of 291, and would need to average just over six per game for the last 14 regular season games to break the mark before the NCC Tournament.

**JOHNSON JETS TO TOP OF NCC:** Nate Johnson has been a menace on the basepaths, stealing 14 bases on 15 attempts. The junior currently sits in second place in the NCC, seven behind the current leader, Bryan Frew of UNO.

## 2008 COACHING STAFF



**Coach Dolan**

Coach Pat Dolan officially began his tenure with SCSU on June 15th, 2007. He brings a wealth of baseball success. In Dolan's 16 years as a head coach his teams have captured an amazing 10 conference regular season championships. During this span he has compiled a 583-324 overall record with 301 wins in 11 years at the college level and 282 wins at the American Legion level. In his collegiate career, Dolan has made stops at Dakota

State, Belmont Abbey (N.C.), St. Andrew's (N.C.), and Itasca CC



**Coach Pratt**

Pratt will return to the SCSU dugout in 2007-08. A former standout player for the Huskies from 1985-88, Pratt owns six team pitching records and served as a captain for two seasons at SCSU. Pratt went on to serve for three seasons as the squads pitching coach from 1989-91. The Huskies won the 1989 conference championship and the 1991 NCC tournament title. SCSU also advanced to the NCAA tournament in 1991 with Pratt on staff.



**Coach Picha**

Longtime Central Minnesota prep baseball skipper Ken Picha will join the St. Cloud State University baseball staff as an assistant coach in 2007-08. Picha served as the head varsity baseball coach at nearby Melrose High School for 29 years (1979-2007) and compiled an impressive 427-181 career record. He ranks eighth on the all-time win list among Minnesota high school baseball coaches, and his .702 career winning percentage ranks sixth among Minnesota

high school coaches who have a minimum of 350 wins. His Melrose teams won 11 conference titles, seven district championships and his squads advanced to four state tournaments. His 1997 and 1998 teams finished second in the state baseball tournaments.

Brueske will serve as a graduate assistant coach at SCSU in 2007-08. Brueske graduated from North Dakota State University with a Bachelor's of Science in business administration in 2003. While there, Brueske was a four-year standout for the Bison baseball team. In 2001, Brueske led the North Central Conference in hitting with a .526 average. Also in 2001, he was named to the All-NCC second team, was 17th in the nation with a .787 slugging percentage and ranked 27th nationally with a .436 batting average. Brueske signed a professional contract with the River City Rascals of the Frontier League and currently ranks in the

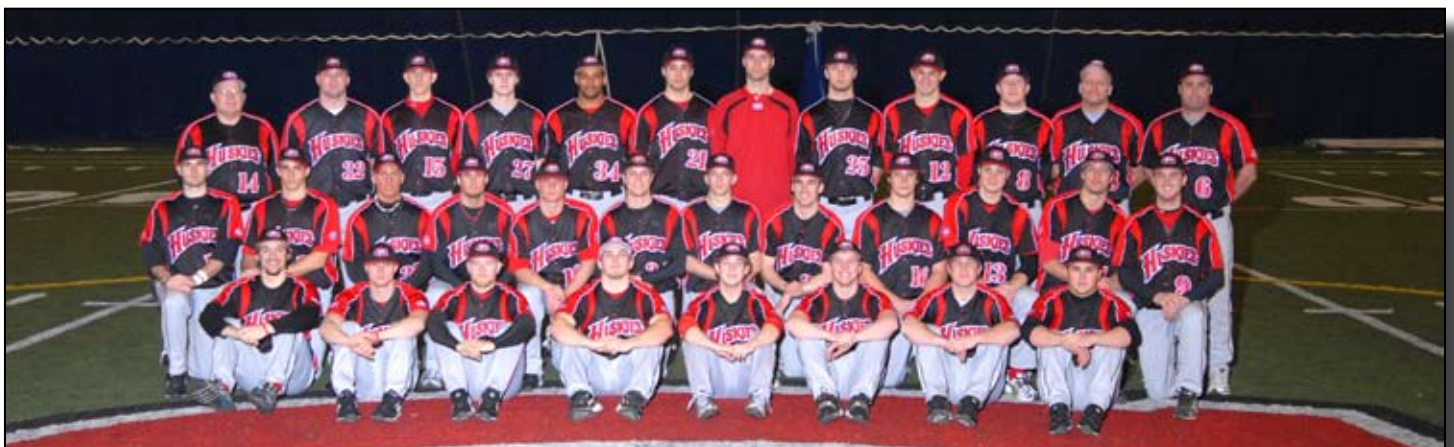
