### The North Central Conference

**Tournament:** St. Cloud State has advanced to the semifinals of the North Central Conference Tournament. The Huskies, the #3 seed will play #2 seed Minnesota State University Mankato at 1:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 3 at the DakotaDome on the University of South Dakota campus in Vermillion, SD. The winner will advance to the championship game of the NCC Tournament on Sunday afternoon at 3:00 p.m.

**The Records:** St. Cloud State enters the game with an 19-9 overall record and a 7-5 NCC mark. Minnesota State University, Mankato is 25-3 overall. The Mavericks tied for first in the NCC regular season and were seeded second in the tournament via coin flip.

**Huskies Third in the NCC:** The Huskies finished in third place in the NCC standings with a 7-5 record. The third place NCC finish marks the sixth time in the last seven years that SCSU has finished in the top three of the league standings.

**Other Semifinal:** The winner of the SCSU vs. MSU game will play the winner of #1 seed University of South Dakota (21-6) vs. the University of Minnesota Duluth (16-12). That semifinal game will be played at 3:00 p.m. Saturday. The Championship game is set for Sunday at 3:00 p.m.

**Tickets:** Tickets for the semifinal games on Saturday are \$10 for adults and \$2 for youth/students, with those tickets allowing patrons to watch both games. Sunday's championship game tickets will cost \$8 for adults and \$2 for youth/students. An adult all-session ticket can be purchased for \$15.

**In the Region:** The Huskies are ranked sixth in the Feb. 28 North Central Region poll. Minnesota State is ranked second in the region and South Dakota is fifth. Winona State is number one.

**Media Coverage:** The NCC Tournament games will air on **KNSI 1450 AM**. Tom Witschen will call the action. The pre-game show begins one-half hour prior to tip-off. **KVSC 88.1 FM** will also air the Huskies game, with a pre-game show ten minutes prior to tip-off. Charlie Cosgrove will make the call. The games will also be available via the web at <http://www.stcloudstate.edu/athletics/listen.asp> or [www.1450knsi.com](http://www.1450knsi.com) or [www.kvsc.org](http://www.kvsc.org).

**View the Game Live on the Web:** The University of South Dakota will provide free video streaming of the NCC Tournament games. **Head Coach Kevin Schlagel**

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) is in his tenth season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2006-07. **He has a current won/loss record of 198-90 as of Feb. 26.** He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 90-54 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Four times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-4 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.

## Quarterfinal Recap

**NCC Quarterfinal:** The Huskies led from start to finish in a 63-52 NCC tournament win over the University of Nebraska-Omaha on Wednesday night, but the Mavericks made several runs and pulled within three points twice in the first half and closed to within two points once in the second half. The Huskies led 33-20 at the half after out scoring UNO 10-0 in the final 4:40. In the second half, UNO senior forward Keith Price scored ten points in the first seven minutes, including a jumper at the 13:06 mark that closed SCSU's lead to 39-37. SCSU's David Dreas answered with a run of his own, scoring seven straight points to give the Huskies a 46-40 lead. Dreas scored 16 of his game high 23 points in the second half. Matt Schneck finished the night with ten points and seven rebounds. The Huskies out rebounded UNO 37-34. Nebraska-Omaha had two players score in double figures led by sophomore guard Michael Jenkins with 20 points. Price finished the game with ten points and seven rebounds. UNO's leading scorer, senior guard Zac Robinson scored one three-point basket late in the second half.

**Series Standing:** SCSU has an 88-72 advantage in the series that began in 1923-24. The Huskies are 0-2 against the Mavericks this year, as earlier this season, MSU defeated the Huskies 83-73 in St. Cloud and 96-68 in Mankato. St. Cloud State head coach Kevin Schlager is 14-7 against the Mavericks.

**Notes:** The Mavericks have won two straight regular season NCC titles and are the defending NCC Tournament Champions. MSU is ranked second in the North Central Region this week and seventh in the February 27 NABC Division II Coaches Poll. The 25 season wins is a new single season MSU record for victories. The Mavericks have won four straight games and five of their last seven. The last two MSU losses have been to Minnesota Duluth and South Dakota.

**Quarterfinal Win:** The Mavericks are coming off a 90-63 quarterfinal win over #7 seed Augustana College. Four of the MSU starters finished the game in double figure scoring led by Paris Kyles with a career high 26 points and Luke Anderson with 22 points.

**SCSU vs. the Rest of the Field:** The Huskies are 2-0 against Minnesota Duluth this season and 0-2 against USD during the regular season. SCSU faced Minnesota Duluth on the opening weekend of NCC in Duluth and defeated the Bulldogs, 86-79 on Jan. 6. On Jan. 20 the teams met in St. Cloud and the Huskies posted an 88-69 win. The Huskies are 42-29 all-time against UMD since the series began during the 1932-33 season. UMD is coming off an 85-63 quarterfinal win over North Dakota. The Bulldogs are riding a seven game win streak into the NCC semifinals. SCSU has won nine straight against the Bulldogs. USD swept the regular season with a 91-63 win in Vermillion on Feb. 10 and a 90-83 overtime win in St. Cloud on Feb. 24. The Coyotes have a 30-28 advantage in the all-time series which began during the 1955-56 season. USD has won six of its last seven games.



### Player & Team Notes

**#04 Dusty Wabiszewski:** Junior guard Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) has moved into the top 20 on the all-time assist chart, and currently has 219 career assists. He tallied six assists and five points against UNO on Wednesday. He has dished out a season high eight assists twice this season. He had a career high eight rebounds against Columbia Union on Dec. 21. He scored his career high 16 points twice this season. This week he continues to lead the NCC in overall steals and assists.

**#10 Brian Schellinger:** Sophomore guard Brian Schellinger (Sartell) has played in 11 games this season. He had a season and career high two assists against Dakota State on Dec. 12.

**#14 David Dreas:** Junior guard David Dreas (Winona) has scored in double figures a team high 23 times this season, including a 23 point outing against Nebraska-Omaha on Wednesday. He leads the team in scoring, averaging 18.6 ppg. Twice he has scored a season high 30 points. He scored his 1,000th career point in SCSU's game against Northern Michigan on Dec. 31 and currently has 1,255 career points. He currently ranks in SCSU's career top 15 in assists (299) and steals (128) and the top ten in three-point field goals made (171).

**#20 Eric Greene:** Junior guard Eric Greene (Kingston, WI) has started four games this season. He scored a season high 14 points against Wayne State last December. He has notched a career high five assists three times this season.

**#24 Adam Sullivan:** Senior guard Adam Sullivan (Green Bay, WI) is a 2007 Academic All-North Central Conference team member. He is averaging 11.5 points this season and scored his career high 30 points against UMD on Jan. 20 of this season. He is tied with David Dreas with 67 three-point baskets.

**#30 Brett Carmichael:** Sophomore forward Brett Carmichael (Elk River) has started the last three games for the Huskies. He scored a career high 18 points against USD on Feb. 24 and sent the game into overtime with his three-point basket. In the last four games he has scored 44 points including 16 points against the Coyotes in Vermillion and 18 against USD in St. Cloud.

**#32 Ben Novak:** Senior post Ben Novak (Cloverdale, CA) has played in 18 games and made two starts for the Huskies.

**#34 Bobby Morrow:** Sophomore forward Bobby Morrow (St. Paul) has played in 22 games for the Huskies this season.

**#40 Kelly Byrne:** Senior forward Kelly Byrne (Ozark, MO) has recorded his career high in rebounds with ten and assists with seven, and equaled his career high in scoring with 19 points this season. He has scored in double figures ten times this season.

**#42 Craig Coenen:** Sophomore forward Craig Coenen (Kaukauna, WI) has recorded career highs in scoring (14) and rebounds with nine this season.

**#50 Matt Schneck:** First year center Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, WI) has started 26 straight games for the Huskies. He recorded his team high fourth double double of the season against USD on Feb. 24, with 17 points and a career high 15 rebounds. He recorded a career high 22 points against Mankato on Jan. 11.

**#52 Ross VerHeul:** First year post Ross VerHeul (Viborg, SD) has played in nine games for the Huskies.

**#54 Eric Bergstrom:** Senior center Eric Bergstrom (Milaca) has started two games this season and has scored in double figures in 11 games. Bergstrom notched his first double-double as a Husky with 27 points and 11 rebounds against Concordia St. Paul on Nov. 24. Those totals were also career highs for Bergstrom.

**NCC Tournament History:** St. Cloud State has won two Wells Fargo Finals Championships (now called the NCC Championship) since the post season tournament began in 2001. SCSU won the inaugural tournament championship in 2001 (in Vermillion) and again in 2003 (in St. Cloud). In addition, SCSU has advanced to the semifinal round of the NCC tournament in five of the six tournaments played. The Huskies have a 9-4 record in NCC tournament games since 2001. This will be the second NCC Tournament meeting between the Huskies and Mavericks. The first was last season in the Championship game of the tourney held in Mankato and the Mavericks came away with a 78-69 win.

**Team Notes:** The Huskies have won 17 or more games in eight straight seasons. Junior guard David Dreas leads the team in scoring with 18.6 points per game. This is the second straight season that Dreas has been the Huskies scoring leader.
