## 2005-06 SCSU MEN'S BASKETBALL NEWS Release Date: December 5, 2005

**AMERICAN FAMILY INSURANCE HOOPSTER CLASSIC:** The St. Cloud State University men's basketball team will unveil the 2005 American Family Insurance Hoopster Classic on Friday and Saturday, December 9 and 10 at Halenbeck Hall (6,927). Four games will be played in a doubleheader format. Game times will be 6:00 and 8:00 p.m. on both nights.

### CLASSIC SCHEDULE:

Friday, 8:00 p.m. - St. Cloud State University vs. Johnson & Wales University

Saturday, 8:00 p.m. - St. Cloud State vs. St. John's



**THE RECORDS:** St. Cloud State will bring a 5-2 overall record into the Classic. Concordia-St. Paul enters the week with a 5-1 record and will play one game prior to the Classic. St. John's enters the week with a 3-1 record and will play one conference game prior to the Classic. Johnson & Wales enters the week with a 0-10 overall record and will play CSU-Pueblo before traveling to Minnesota.

**SERIES RECORDS:** St. Cloud State and Johnson & Wales will tip-off for the first meeting ever between the two schools. The Huskies and St. John's have a long standing rivalry as the first game between these two teams was played during the 1924-25 season. This will be the 101st game between the two teams and SCSU has a 57-43 advantage. The Huskies have won five straight in the series including a 73-56 win last season.

**MEDIA COVERAGE:** St. Cloud State men's basketball can be heard on WJON AM 1240 Radio during the 2005-06 season. Sports Director Jay Caldwell will call all of the games home and away. **THE KEVIN SCHLAGEL SHOW:** Listen to the Kevin Schlagel Show every Wednesday afternoon throughout the season on AM 1390 The Fan. Coach Schlagel and Jay Caldwell will talk Husky men's basketball every Wednesday afternoon at 1:30.

**2004-05 RESULTS:** The St. Cloud State University men's basketball team completed the 2004-05 season with a 21-8 overall record. The Huskies finished third in the North Central Conference with a 7-5 record. SCSU advanced to the semifinals of the Wells Fargo Finals where the Huskies season came to an end in an 80-56 loss to the University of South Dakota.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** St. Cloud State seniors Matt Siegle (Long Prairie) and Pat Weihert (Watertown, WI) will captain the 2005-06 Huskies.

**AMERICAN FAMILY INSURANCE HUSKY HOOPSTER CLASSIC:** For the first time in the Kevin Schlagel head coaching era, the Huskies will host a four team classic. SCSU will unveil the American Family Insurance Husky Hoopster Classic on December 9 & 10 at Halenbeck Hall.

## MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

**SCSU HEAD COACH KEVIN SCHLAGEL:** Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) is in his ninth season as the head coach of the Huskies. **He has a current won/loss record of 164-72 overall in his eight seasons with the Huskies.** Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4 against Trinity College. He has also compiled an 82-50 record in NCC games in eight seasons (includes 2004-05 record), two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC



Coach of the Year. Three times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-3 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.

**ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF:** Coach Matt Reimer (Central College) is in his ninth season as the top assistant to Coach Schlagel. Reimer also served for two seasons as a graduate assistant coach under Butch Raymond in 1995-96 and 1996-97, bringing his overall experience with the Huskies to ten seasons. Prior to SCSU, Reimer served as an assistant basketball coach at New London-Spicer High School for four seasons. Cory Schlagel (St. Thomas Univ.) returns for his second season as a graduate assistant coach with the Huskies. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Schlagel was an assistant baseball and girls basketball coach, and math teacher at Rush City High School. Andrew Cone will also assist the Huskies. He is a former South Dakota State player and graduate assistant coach for the Jackrabbits. Cone played on four NCAA tournament and two North Central Conference Championship teams.

**SCSU LAST WEEK:** The Huskies went 2-0 last week with wins over Bemidji State, 84-72 and Dakota State, 87-64.

SCSU started the week with a win in the Huskies home opener against Bemidji State. SCSU had to battle their way back from a 12 point deficit in the first half and a 36-30 Bemidji State half-time lead. SCSU junior forward Adam Sullivan (Green Bay, WI) nailed a three point basket to put the Huskies ahead 55-52 in the second half and the Huskies built a 13-point, 74-61 lead with 4:47 left in the game. Sullivan finished the game with a career high 23 points and equaled his career high with five three-point baskets. He also pulled down six rebounds. Sophomore guard David Dreas (Winona) dropped in 19 points, including nine-of-ten free throws, pulled down seven rebounds, and had five assists. Sophomore guard Eric Greene (Kingston, WI) had 16 points. SCSU senior center Matt Siegle (Long Prairie) led all players with eight rebounds and had nine points.

Against Dakota State, the teams played a tight first half and DSU tied the game at 31-31 with 2:36 remaining. The Huskies picked up the intensity in the final minutes of the half, however and stretched out a lead. First year forward Craig Coenen (Kaukauna, WI) sunk two shots in the paint and a three from Eric Greene gave the Huskies a 42-33 lead at the half. Leading the Huskies against Dakota State was David Dreas with his career high 28 points, six rebounds, and seven steals. Matt Siegle had 13 points in the game, followed by Craig Coenen with 10. The Huskies shot 52.2% from the field and had 38 points in the paint.
