2005-06 SCSU MEN'S BASKETBALL NEWS Release Date: November 8, 2005

EXHIBITION OPENER: The St. Cloud State University men's basketball team will host Quality Choice Mortgage in an exhibition game on Friday, November 11 at 7:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall (6,927).

2004-05 RESULTS: The St. Cloud State University men's basketball team completed the 2004-05 season with a 21-8 overall record. The Huskies finished third in the North Central Conference with a 7-5 record. SCSU advanced to the semifinals of the Wells Fargo Finals where the Huskies season came to an end in an 80-56 loss to the University of South Dakota.

SCSU HEAD COACH KEVIN SCHLAGEL: Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his ninth season as the head coach of the Huskies. He has a current won/loss record of 159-70 overall in his eight seasons with the Huskies. Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4 against Trinity College. He has also compiled an 82-50 record in NCC games in eight seasons (includes 2004-05 record), two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Three times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-3 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.



ASSISTANT COACHING STAFF: Coach Matt Reimer (Central College) is in his ninth season as the top assistant to Coach Schlagel. Reimer also served for two seasons as a graduate assistant coach under Butch Raymond in 1995-96 and 1996-97, bringing his overall experience with the Huskies to ten seasons. Prior to SCSU, Reimer served as an assistant basketball coach at New London-Spicer High School for four seasons. Cory Schlagel (St. Thomas Univ.) returns for his second season as a graduate assistant coach with the Huskies. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Schlagel was an assistant baseball and girls basketball coach, and math teacher at Rush City High School. Andrew Cone will also assist the Huskies. He is a former South Dakota State player and graduate assistant coach for the Jackrabbits. Cone played on four NCAA tournament and two North Central Conference Championship teams.

TEAM CAPTAINS: St. Cloud State seniors Matt Siegle (Long Prairie) and Pat Weihert (Watertown, WI) will captain the 2005-06 Huskies.

AMERICAN FAMILY INSURANCE HUSKY HOOPSTER CLASSIC: For the first time in the Kevin Schlagel head coaching era, the Huskies will host a four team classic. SCSU will unveil the American Family Insurance Husky Hoopster Classic on December 9 & 10 at Halenbeck Hall. St. Cloud State will be joined by St. John's University, Concordia-St. Paul, and Johnson and Wales College (CO). On Friday, Dec. 9, St. John's will play Concordia-St. Paul at 6:00 p.m. followed by the Huskies and Johnson and Wales at 8:00 p.m. Saturday, Concordia-St. Paul will tip-off against Johnson and Wales at 6:00 p.m. followed by the Huskies and Johnnies at 8:00 p.m.

QCM: The Quality Choice Mortgage team is made up of former collegiate players, including former Huskies Nate Miller and Jason Kron, along with Jon Bryant, a former Husky who transferred to Wisconsin.

SEASON OPENER: The Huskies will open the 2005-06 season at Upper Iowa on Tuesday, November 15 at 8:00 p.m. Last year, SCSU posted two wins over the Peacocks, winning 83-60 at UIU and 80-56 in St. Cloud. SCSU will play in three non-conference tournaments this season. SCSU will travel to Mankato for the Minnesota State, Mankato Classic on Nov. 18 and 19 where the Huskies will play Wayne State and Glenville State College (WV). The Huskies will go to Duluth on Nov. 25-26 for the UMD American Family Insurance Classic. SCSU will play Winona State and Michigan Tech.

MORE NEWS AND NOTES...

ABOUT THE HUSKIES: St. Cloud State will have a strong nucleus of young players in 2005-06 as the Huskies return two starters and seven letterwinners. . "We have skilled people at each position," said ninth year head coach Kevin Schlagel. "The key to our team will be to find a go to player. We are a deep team with a lot of guys who have the ability to play. Hopefully that will make us more of an up tempo team."

The returning starters include senior Matt Siegle in the front court and junior Adam Sullivan in the back court. Siegle, at center, has been a two-year starter and last season averaged 10.9 points and 4.4 rebounds. He had a streak of nine straight games of double figure scoring during the 2004-05 season. Sullivan started all 25 games he played in 2004-05 and averaged 7.1 points per game.

Other returning players with experience include senior guard Pat Weihert, junior forward Zac Campbell, junior center Eric Bergstrom, and sophomore guards David Dreas and Eric Greene.

Dreas collected the most playing time of the group and is the veteran at the point guard position. He averaged 18.3 minutes of playing time per game."David had a very good freshman year and we look for him to be a leader at guard this season," Schlagel said. Joining Dreas at the point will be newcomer Spencer Bartz. Bartz is an excellent shooter and should help the Huskies in transition.

Weihert and Green will compete behind Adam Sullivan for playing time at the two spot. According to Schlagel, they are good shooters with the ability to stretch the defense.

Campbell, along with two newcomers, Kelly Byrne a transfer from Kansas City Kansas Community College and Bobby Morrow will all compete at the three spot. Campbell sparked the Huskies off the bench last season and is the team's best defensive player. Byrne is known for his three-point shooting and Morrow is probably the best athlete on the Husky roster.

Another newcomer, Craig Coenen will add strength at the four spot behind Matt Hanson. Coenen is a strong, athletic player with good defensive skills.

Bergstrom, at seven feet is the Huskies big man. He showed flashes his sophomore year of having the type of ability that could make him a major force in the league. He played in 27 games in 2004-05 and averaged 3.6 points and 1.6 rebounds.
