St. Cloud State University 2006-07 Men's Basketball Outlook

With four returning starters and the addition of several solid post players, the St. Cloud State University coaching staff is excited about the 2006-07 season.

St. Cloud State is coming off its fifth 20-win season in the last six years. The Huskies posted a 20-11 overall record and finished second in the North Central Conference with an 8-4 mark. The Huskies finished as the runner-up in the NCC Wells Fargo Finals, losing to regular and post season league champion, Minnesota State University, Mankato in the championship game. SCSU did advance to the NCAA North Central Region tournament for the ninth time in school history and the first time since the 2002-03 season.

The Huskies were relatively young last season, with only two seniors on the roster. The starting line-up included two sophomores, two juniors and one senior. "Last year we learned good work habits and what it takes to play night in and night out," said head coach Kevin Schlagel who begins his tenth season at the helm of the Huskies. "We hope we can continue with those habits and play consistent ball."

Among the four returning starters are two All-North Central Conference players in junior guard David Dreas (Winnona) and senior guard Adam Sullivan (Green Bay, WI). Dreas led the 2005-06 Huskies in scoring with 18.4 points per game and led the North Central Conference in league scoring. He also ranked among the top ten in NCAA statistics in free throw shooting percentage. As the point guard, he directed the team, leading them to a second place finish in the North Central Conference regular season, a second place Wells Fargo Finals finish, and to a ninth NCAA Division II North Central Region tournament appearance. Dreas was named to the Wells Fargo Finals All-Tournament team and the Daktronics Inc., All-North Central Region team. Sullivan averaged 11.9 points and 4.6 rebounds. He led the NCC in three-point field goal shooting percentage. He made 73 three-point baskets during the season.

The other two returning starters are junior guard Eric Greene (Kingston, WI) and senior forward Kelly Byrne (Springfield, MO). Greene averaged seven points and 2.5 rebounds per game and was the Huskies top defender. Byrne averaged 7.2 points and 3.2 rebounds.

Figuring into the equation in 2006-07 will be two new recruits. Matt Schneck is a 6-8 post from Whitefish Bay, Wisconsin. A prep all-conference and state all-star player, Schneck averaged 14.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game his senior season. He played on the #1 ranked team in Wisconsin that posted a 20-2 overall record. Ben Novak is a 6-9 post that transferred from Mendocino (CA) Community College. He averaged eight points and seven rebounds and was named to the all-conference team.

A total of 12 players will return to the roster and with the addition of four signees, the Huskies will have added depth in 2006-07. "We should be a very deep, very experienced group of players," said head coach Kevin Schlagel, who begins his tenth season leading the Huskies.

With only two seniors and one senior in the starting line-up last season, the Huskies posted a 20-11 overall record, finished second in the North Central Conference with an 8-4 record, placed second in the Wells Fargo Finals tournament, and advanced to the NCAA North Central Region Tournament. Matt Siegle, the lone senior starter, left the Huskies ranked 17th on the all-time scoring chart with 1,293 points and seventh on the all-time rebounding chart with 671 boards. The other senior, guard Pat Weihert was a four-year player for the Huskies.

With the entire perimeter returning and the addition of three post players, the Huskies have created flexibility on the outside and strengthened the front line.
