Huskies Open at Hoopster Classic:

The 2007-08 St. Cloud State men's basketball season kicks off at the third annual American Family Insurance Hoopster Classic hosted by SCSU on Nov 16 & 17. The Huskies first game is on Friday night the 16th at 8:00 pm when they take on Bemidji State University. All four games of the Classic will be available on the B2 Network. Tickets: Tickets for each game are \$10 for adults, \$5 for youth, and free to SCSU students with a valid ID.

Team Captains: Senior guards David Dreas (Winona) and Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) will serve as the team captains in 2007-08.

Receiving Votes: St. Cloud State received votes in the NABC/Division II Coaches Preseason poll released Oct. 31. Winona State University is the number one ranked team in the preseason.

Classic Schedule: The Huskies will play the late game in each night of the AFI Hoopster Classic. After opening with Bemidji State on Friday Nov. 16, SCSU will entertain the University of Mary on Saturday Nov. 17.

Series Records: The Huskies and the Bemidji State University Beavers have a long rivalry dating back to the 1923-24 season. This will mark the 124th game to be played between these two teams with SCSU leading the all-time series 86-37. The two teams met last season in Bemidji with SCSU posting an 80-50 win. St. Cloud State and the University of Mary Marauders will meet for the second time. The first game was played last season and resulted in a 86-77 Mary win. Both Bemidji State and Mary are members of the Northern

Sun Intercollegiate Conference, the league that St. Cloud State will be joining next year.

Above the Rim Radio Show: Catch the latest news from St. Cloud State men's and women's basketball and the North Central Conference every Wednesday night on the Above the Rim Coaches Show. Head men's basketball coach Kevin Schlagel and head women's basketball coach Dr. Lori Ulferts will join sports director Don Lyons on KNSI AM 1450 every Wednesday from 6:00 to 7:00 pm. The show will broadcast live from Rosters Resturant in St. Cloud.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University men's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away. This weekend, Minnesota broadcast legend Don Lyons will call the games from Halenbeck Hall.

Third in the NCC Preseason: The Huskies have been picked to finish third in the final season of the North Central Conference in the annual poll by the league media. The Huskies received 94 points while Minnesota State University, Mankato was picked to finish second with 99 points. The University of South Dakota was the overwhelming favorite to win it in 2008 with 132 points, and 18 of 19 possible first place votes. The Coyotes and Minnesota State were co-champions in 2007, with USD winning the NCC post season tournament.

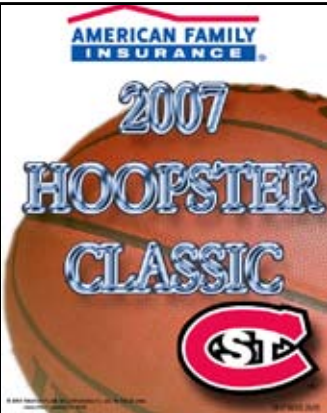

Hoopster Classic Notes: 2007 marks the third year of the American Family Insurance Hoopster Classic at SCSU. The Huskies went 1-1 in the Classic last year posting a 77-67 win over Rockhurst University in day one of the tournament and falling 86-77 to the University of Mary on day two. All four teams in the 2006 Classic posted 1-1 records. Concordia-St. Paul, in the first year of the Classic in 2005, was the only team to post a perfect 2-0 record. Johnson & Wales University, also in 2005, is the only team to finish 0-2 in the AFI Hoopster Classic.

St. Cloud State Info: The Huskies posted a 19-11 overall record in 2006-07 and finished third in the North Central Conference with a 7-5 record. SCSU won their opening round game of the NCC tournament 63-52 over Nebraska-Omaha, before falling in the semifinals 78-73 to #2 seed Minnesota State. The Huskies also earned a trip to the NCAA DII North Central Region tournament where they dropped their opening round match-up 100-73 to eventual national runner-up Winona State.

Bemidji State Info: The Beavers ended the 2006-07 season with a 5-23 overall record and a 5-13 seventh place record in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. The season came to an end in the first round of the NSIC tournament in an 86-43 loss to Southwest Minnesota State. BSU will be led in 2007-08 by second year head coach Matthew Bowen.

University of Mary Info: The Marauders finished 9-18 overall last season and finished seventh in their first season in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference with a 5-13 record. U-Mary's season ended with a 77-59 home loss to Northern State. The Marauders are led by fourth year head coach Juno Pintar.

Nebraska-Omaha Info: The Mavericks posted a 12-16 record in 2006-07 and finished 3-9 in a three way tie for fifth in the North Central Conference. UNO hooked up with the Huskies in the first round of the NCC tournament last season with the Huskies moving on by virtue of the 63-52 win. The loss marked the final game for the Mavericks. UNO head coach Derrin Hansen begins his third season in 2007-08.

All-Classic Performer: SCSU senior guard David Dreas (Winona) was named to the Hoopster Classic All-Classic team in 2006, for the second straight year. Dreas averaged 18.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in the two games last season to earn the honor. UNO's Michael Jenkins also returns as a All-Classic performer.

End of the NCC: The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), four golf championships (1994, 2004, 05, 07), two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 04), and one basketball championship (1989).

Head Coach Kevin Schligel

Kevin Schligel (St. Cloud State, 1976) opens his eleventh season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2007-08. He enters the new year with a won/loss record of 198-92. He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schligel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 97-59 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schligel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Five times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-5 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schligel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.
