Ride The Mustangs: In their final game before the holiday break the Huskies head to Marshall, Minn. for a 7:00 p.m. tilt with Southwest Minnesota State University. SMSU enters the game 7-3 overall and 3-1 in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference.

Return To Host Crookston: After the short but sweet lay-off the men are back in Halenbeck Hall on Dec. 29 for a 3:00 p.m. match-up with the University of Minnesota, Crookston. The Golden Eagles, also of the NSIC, come into the game 3-8 and 1-2 in conference play.

Rematch With Concordia: After just meeting on Dec. 13, the Huskies and Concordia-St. Paul will meet again less than three weeks later. This time in St. Paul, on Dec. 30 at 4:00 pm, where the Golden Bears are 6-1. Overall this season, CSP is 7-3, and 2-1 in the NSIC, with one game to play before they meet the Huskies.

Game With Sioux Falls To Open 2008: Not long after the calendar turns, on Jan. 2, the Huskies will get back to action with a non-conference home game against the University of Sioux Falls (S.D.). The Cougars sit at 4-9 on the season, with one game to play before their 7:00 pm their meeting with SCSU.

Huskies Ranked 8th: The National Association of Basketball Coaches released their new poll last week on Dec. 11, and for the first time this season the Huskies were in the top-10. SCSU jumped four spots all the way to #8, after moving to 8-0 last week. This is the highest ranking for SCSU since the 2001-02 season when they spent the first five weeks at #5 in the polls.

Tickets: Tickets for all men's basketball home games are \$10 for adults, \$5 for youth, and free to SCSU students with a valid ID. For more information call 1-877-SCSUTIX or 320-308-2137.

Team Captains: Senior guards David Dreas (Winona) and Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) will serve as the team captains in 2007-08.

Above the Rim Radio Show: Catch the latest news from St. Cloud State men's and women's basketball and the North Central Conference every Wednesday night on the Above the Rim Coaches Show. Head men's basketball coach Kevin Schlagel and head women's basketball coach Dr. Lori Ulferts will join sports director Don Lyons on KNSI AM 1450 every Wednesday from 6:00 to 7:00 pm. The show will broadcast live from Rosters Restaurant in St. Cloud.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University men's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

Third in the NCC Preseason: The Huskies have been picked to finish third in the final season of the North Central Conference in the annual poll by the league media. The Huskies received 94 points while Minnesota State University, Mankato was picked to finish second with 99 points. The University of South Dakota was the overwhelming favorite to win it in 2008 with 132 points, and 18 of 19 possible first place votes. The Coyotes and Minnesota State were co-champions in 2007, with USD winning the NCC post season tournament.

David Dreas (Winona) began the season #17 on the SCSU all-time scoring list with 1,305 career points. With 21 points against Concordia-St. Paul and 12 against U-Mary he now has 1,463, and breaks into the top-ten, surpassing the most recent addition to the list Nate Miller (2005). Dreas is seventh in the NCC at 15.8 points per game.

End of the NCC: The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), four golf championships (1994, 2004, 05, 07), two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 04), and one basketball championship (1989).



News and Notes

Win Streak Stopped at 9-0 : With the Huskies at 9-0, they traveled to Bismarck, N.D. to take on the University of Mary, and U-Mary handed SCSU their first loss with a 77-48 Marauder win. U-Mary brought their A-game and controlled the entire contest. For the game the Marauders shot nearly 60% while SCSU was down at 27%, and only 15% from three-point range compared to 66% for the home team. The second half began with SCSU down seven, but less than five minutes in they were down 18, and by the 7:21 mark the Marauder lead was at 31 points. David Dreas (Winona) led the Huskies with 12 points.

Golden Bears Downed In Halenbeck: Concordia-St. Paul came into their game with SCSU carrying a 7-2 record, and left 7-3 after a 72-57 loss to the Huskies. SCSU took a 39-27 lead into half time on 15-27 (55.6%) shooting and 5-9 (55.6) three point shooting. Dreas played 34 minutes and scored 21 points to lead the Huskies while Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) recorded the first SCSU double-double of the season with 15 points to go along with 11 rebounds.

About Southwest Minnesota State: The Mustangs (7-3) come into the game as winners of their last three and five of their last six, including a big 86-61 win over Minnesota Duluth on Dec. 16. In the win over UMD, three SMSU players scored 17 or more points, and the Mustangs scored the first 18 points of the second half to turn an eight point deficit into a 10 point lead. Led by seventh year head coach Greg Stemen, the Mustangs went 20-10 and 14-4 in the NSIC to finish second in the conference in 2006-07. SMSU had their season ended in the championship game of the NSIC tournament at the hands of Winona State, 80-70. Matt Fletcher, at 14.9 ppg, leads the Mustangs in scoring for 2007-08.

About Minnesota, Crookston: The Golden Eagles will be looking to get back on the winning track against the Huskies, having dropped their last game 96-80 to Mayville State University (N.D.). At 3-8 overall and 1-2 in the NSIC, UMC's most recent win came against rival Minnesota, Morris in a 93-70 victory on Dec. 14, that saw UMC nail seven second half three-pointers. The Golden Eagles are led by sixth year head coach Jeff Oseth, and finished 3-24 overall and 2-16 in the NSIC for a ninth place tie during the 2006-07 campaign. Through 11 games, Bryce Cummings leads the Golden Eagles at 11.5 ppg.

About Concordia-St. Paul: The Golden Bears sit at 7-3 on the season with their last game being their Dec. 13 loss to SCSU. For the season, CSP is led by Craig Heiman's 17.7 ppg. Before they meet the Huskies, the Golden Bears will host Augustana College on Dec. 20. First year coach Kelly Boe's squad has dropped two of their last three after winning six of their first seven.

About Sioux Falls: The University of Sioux Falls Cougars (4-9) are a member of the National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) and compete in the Great Plains Athletic Conference (GPAC). USF is coming of a 83-62 road win over York College that snapped a three game losing skid. Gerard Van Leur led the Cougars in the game with a double-double scoring 16 points and grabbing 11 rebounds. USF is led by seventh year head coach Shane Murphy, who has led his team to four NAIA national tournaments as well as a final four berth following the 2003-04 season. Last season the Cougars finished 28-5, and won the GPAC for the second straight year, before advancing to the National Tournament.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) opens his eleventh season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2007-08. He enters the new year with a won/loss record of 198-92. He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 97-59 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Five times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-5 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.
