Huskies To Host Peacocks: The St. Cloud State men got to rest last week with just one game and the weekend off, but return to action this week on Wednesday, Dec. 5, in Halenbeck Hall when they host Upper Iowa University at 7:00 p.m. in a non-conference match-up.

Saturday Night Match-Up With St. John's: In the first all Husky double header of the season for SCSU on Dec. 8, the Husky men follow the women's 6:00 p.m. game with their 8:00 p.m. nightcap with St. John's.

Free Throw Shooting Seals Sixth Straight Win: On the road facing Minnesota State University Moorhead the Huskies saw a 19-point lead with 13:23 remaining in the second half, whittled away to just three with 28 seconds to go. With the Dragons forced to foul, they sent Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, Wis.) to the line where he nailed both of his free throws, followed on the next possession by David Dreas (Winona), who made one of his two final free throws to add the final insurance to the 80-74 victory.

Huskies Ranked 14th: St. Cloud State entered the 2007-08 season unranked in the National Association of Basketball Coaches/Division II preseason poll. However, after starting the season 5-0, the Huskies found themselves ranked 14th in the first NABC/DII poll of the regular season released on Nov. 27. Bentley College (Mass.) is the nation's top ranked team, while North Central Conference preseason favorite, the University of South Dakota, sits at sixth.

Team Captains: Senior guards David Dreas (Winona) and Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) will serve as the team captains in 2007-08.

The show will broadcast live from Rosters Restaurant in St. Cloud.

On the Radio: St. Cloud State University men's basketball games will air live on KNSI 1450 AM during the 2007-08 season. The pre-game show will begin one-half hour prior to tip-off both home and away.

Third in the NCC Preseason: The Huskies have been picked to finish third in the final season of the North Central Conference in the annual poll by the league media. The Huskies received 94 points while Minnesota State University, Mankato was picked to finish second with 99 points. The University of South Dakota was the overwhelming favorite to win it in 2008 with 132 points, and 18 of 19 possible first place votes. The Coyotes and Minnesota State were co-champions in 2007, with USD winning the NCC post season tournament.

David Dreas

David Dreas (Winona) began the season #17 on the SCSU all-time scoring list with 1,305 career points. With 23 points against MSU Moorhead he now has 1,394, and is less than 50 points away from breaking into the top-10 on the all-time list. At 14.8 ppg, Dreas is currently the 11th leading scorer in the NCC.

About Upper Iowa: The game with the Peacocks will mark just the eighth meeting between the two schools in a series that dates back to the 1951-52 season. It was UIU who got the upper hand in that initial matchup, but since, it has been all Huskies winning six straight in the series and holding the 6-1 all-time advantage including a 77-60 win last season. A member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Upper Iowa is led by second year head coach Brian Dolan. In his first season in Fayette, Dolan led UIU to a 3-25 overall finish and 2-16 finish in the Northern Intercollegiate Sun Conference. Over the past weekend, Upper Iowa dropped their first two NSIC games and sit at 0-8 overall on the 2007-08 season.

About St. John's: With 102 meetings all-time, SJU is one of just five schools to face St. Cloud State over 100 times. With 58 wins in the series, the Huskies hold the advantage compared to 44 wins for St. John's. In last season's match-up, St. Cloud State got that 58th win, with a 90-78 victory over the Johnnies. SJU is led by legendary head coach Jim Smith, who entered 2007-08 with 671 career wins. His win record is the 28th best all-time mark in all divisions of college basketball. The Johnnies enter the week with a 3-0 record after an 80-77 win against St. Mary's in Winona, Minn. Before they meet the Huskies however they will play twice, against Carleton College on Dec. 3, and against Gustavus Adolphus College on Dec. 5.

6-0 For the Second Time In Four Seasons: The move to 6-0 is the second time in the past four seasons the Huskies have gotten off to such a start. In 2004-05 SCSU also began 6-0 before dropping their seventh game 59-70 to Colorado State-Pueblo. After the loss the Huskies promptly put together another eight game win streak en route to a 21-8 finish.

End of the NCC: The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), four golf championships (1994, 2004, 05, 07), two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 04), and one basketball championship (1989).

Wabizewski Giveth and Taketh Away: Senior point guard Dusty Wabizewski (Appleton, Wis.) maintained his lead on the NCC assist and steal charts. With 34 total assists and 5.67 assists per game, Wabizewski leads at 4.29 assists per game. In steals, his 17 total in six games is second to Ryan Meissner's (UMD) 19 in eight games, but his 2.83 steals per game average is tops ahead of Meissner at 2.38.

More From MSU Moorhead: With the Huskies down one to the Dragons in a closely contested first half, a Wabizewski free throw tied the score at 22-22 at the 8:15 mark of the opening period. His second free throw started the closing rally, and gave the Huskies a lead they would not relinquish. Dreas, who would go on to score seven points in a 2:52 span finishing with a three-pointer at 3:38, led the 20-10 rally to give the visitors the halftime lead at 42-32.

Carmichael Has Best Outing of Season: Junior forward Brett Carmichael (Elk River) added 14 points in the win, finishing second only to Dreas's 23. Eight of his points came in the first half with his second basket at the 16:27 mark giving the Huskies their first lead. Also his two free throws late in the half helped extend the Husky lead to double-digits heading into the break.

Head Coach Kevin Schligel



Kevin Schligel (St. Cloud State, 1976) opens his eleventh season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2007-08. He enters the new year with a won/loss record of 198-92. He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schligel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 97-59 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schligel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Five times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-5 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schligel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.

Schligel is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schligel and Andrew Cone.
