**Last Go 'Round:** The Huskies will be playing in their final game of the 2007-08 regular season this weekend. On Wednesday Mar. 5, the NCC tournament begins.

**So We Meet Again:** After hosting the Coyotes on Feb. 16, SCSU will now hit the road to close out the season series with #16 South Dakota. In that initial meeting, SCSU scored the upset, earning a 75-71 win over then #10 USD.

**Vikings Put Huskies Away in Second Half:** St. Cloud State began the second half trailing by just five at 45-40, but before Matt Schneck scored the first bucket of the second half Augustana ran their lead to 56-40 on the strength of a 9-0 run. SCSU was unable to get within 12 the rest of the way and fell by a 68-86 score.

**Around The NCC:** It took an extra session on Feb. 21, but Minnesota State was able to squeak by Augustana 78-74 giving the Mavericks the outright NCC title for the second time in three years. They also shared the title with USD last season making it three straight for MSU.

**Tickets:** Tickets for all men's basketball home games are \$10 for adults, \$5 for youth, and free to SCSU students with a valid ID. For more information call 1-877-SCSUTIX or 320-308-2137.

**Team Captains:** Senior guards David Dreas (Winona) and Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) will serve as the team captains in 2007-08.

**Third in the NCC Preseason:** The Huskies have been picked to finish third in the final season of the North Central Conference in the annual poll by the league media. The Huskies received 94 points while Minnesota State University, Mankato was picked to finish second with 99 points. The University of South Dakota was the overwhelming favorite to win it in 2008 with 132 points, and 18 of 19 possible first place votes. The Coyotes and Minnesota State were co-champions in 2007, with USD winning the NCC post season tournament.

David Dreas (Winona) scored 18 points against Augustana on Feb. 23 to move just a single point away from the second spot on SCSU's all-time list. With one regular season game and at least one tournament game remaining, Dreas has 1,773 career points.

Dreas is second in the NCC in scoring at 18.0 ppg.

End of the NCC: The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), four golf championships (1994, 2004, 05, 07), two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 04), and one basketball championship (1989).



News and Notes

Series Record: With the win in their last meeting, the Huskies closed the gap on South Dakota and now trail by just one game in the 50 year old series history at 29-30.

About South Dakota: When the Huskies toppled South Dakota on Feb. 16 it was the third straight loss for a team that had climbed all the way to the number four spot in the national rankings. The loss was the end of a winless three game road swing at Nebraska-Omaha, Minnesota State, and SCSU. All four of the Coyotes losses came in conference play, putting to rest any thoughts of a possible repeat as NCC champions. The Coyotes were finally able to break out of their slump against North Dakota on Feb. 21 when they earned a 91-68 victory, improving to 20-4 (5-4) on the season. USD put the game away early when they hit five three s in the first five minutes and led 20-0 with 14:59 still left play in the first half. North Dakota never got within 15 points for the rest of the game. USD won again 79-70 over Minnesota Duluth and is now 21-4, 6-4 heading into the final weekend. Dylan Grimsley, Eric Hall, and Jesse Becker all average better than 10 points per game for the Coyotes.

Last Time Out: For the first time all season, the Huskies allowed a 30 point scorer as USD s Eric Hall hit six three en route to a 30 point night. The difference, however, was the balanced Husky scoring attack that saw Matt Schneck s 17 points lead four players in double figures. SCSU led for most of the game, but USD put the pressure on when it mattered most and never let the game get out of reach. The Huskies fell behind the Coyotes 53-51 with under 10:00 minutes to go. As time continued to wind down David Dreas hit two free throws to go up by seven, and finally with one second left, an Andrew Bernstetter free throw sealed the 75-71 win.

Head Viking: Augustana s Corey McIntosh paced his squad with his first career double-double scoring 22 points while dishing out 11 assists in the Vikings 86-68 win over SCSU. The Huskies shot less than 30% from the field in the second half after shooting nearly 50% in the first half. Through the first 20 minutes, SCSU never held the lead, but was never out of it, and on six different occasions got within one point of Augustana. The story was different in the second half though, when AC shot 57% compared to 28% for SCSU, as the Vikings put the game away.

Nine of 17: With a 17-9 record, the 2007-08 season marks the ninth straight year that head coach Kevin Schlagel has led his team to 17 or more wins. Also, outside of the 98-99 campaign,

10 of Schlagel s 11 Husky squads have reached the 17 win mark.

Rare Opportunity: Not since the 2001-02 season has SCSU taken both games from South Dakota. In the first meeting of the season SCSU won 97-81 to improve to 5-0 before running to an 11-0 start. The Huskies and Coyotes then met up again in the final regular season game of the season where SCSU scored a 73-60 win to close the season 12-6 in the NCC and on a four game winning streak. As fate would have it, the two teams squared off again in the first round of the NCC tournament where SCSU earned the rare three-game sweep with a 95-90 double overtime victory.

New Playoff Scenarios: The Huskies still have a chance to host the first round of the NCC tournament on Wednesday, March 5. Currently in fifth place, SCSU sits behind Augustana, South Dakota and Nebraska-Omaha who all have four losses. Augustana and Nebraska-Omaha have secured home court on March 5. The fifth seed could go to the Huskies or the University of South Dakota. A South Dakota win over visiting Augustana College on Thursday, would give the Coyotes the fifth seed. A USD loss to Augustana and a Husky win at USD would give SCSU the fifth seed and home court.

Do You Need My Assistance: With 11 assists against Augustana, Dusty Wabiszewski became only the fifth player in program history to record over 400 career assists. With a career total of 408 he sits in fifth place all-time. His senior season has been his best yet, and with 170 assists and counting, Wabiszewski currently has the ninth best single season assist tally in team history. Alex Carlson, directly ahead of Wabiszewski in eighth with 180, is the only other player to earn a spot since the start of the 2000 season. His 11 assists against Augustana also marked the third straight game and fourth time in the last five games that he has recorded double-digit assists.

Regional Rankings: Despite a 15-8 division II record and a 14-8 in region record the Huskies were left out of the top-10 again this week when the new Regional Rankings were released Feb. 20. After falling to another in-region opponent in Augustana, it would appear that the Huskies only shot at the Regional tournament would be to run the table and win the NCC tournament, earning the automatic bid.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) opens his eleventh season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2007-08. He enters the new year with a won/loss record of 198-92. He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 97-59 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Five times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-5 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.
