Away and Home Again: The Huskies will have to leave the friendly confines of Halenbeck Hall for their next test but two nights later get to return home as North Central Conference play continues.

To Mankato We Will Go: St. Cloud State will resume the conference season with a short road trip south to Mankato for an 8:00 pm match-up with Minnesota State on Jan. 17. The Mavericks enter the game 12-4 and 2-0 in the NCC after opening with wins over Minnesota Duluth and North Dakota.

Augie Comes to Town: On Jan. 19 at 4:00 pm the Huskies are back home to host Augustana College. The Vikings sit at 13-4 and 1-1 in the NCC after a pair of overtime games, falling to UNO but beating USD. On Jan. 17, Augustana will play Minnesota Duluth before coming to St. Cloud.

Huskies Start 2-0: The University of North Dakota and Minnesota Duluth came to town to open conference play, and in the final season of the NCC the Huskies got off to a 2-0 start with a 74-54 win over UND and a 63-59 win over UMD. David Dreas with 25 and 20 points paced the Huskies who never trailed against UND and held off a surging Bulldogs squad.

Huskies Ranked 20th: The National Association of Basketball Coaches released their latest poll on Jan. 8, and St. Cloud State continued to be ranked among the nation's best at number 20. NCC rivals South Dakota and Nebraska-Omaha were also ranked in the poll at third and 12th respectively. The Huskies have been ranked every week of the regular season.

Third in the NCC Preseason: The Huskies have been picked to finish third in the final season of the North Central Conference in the annual poll by the league media. The Huskies received 94 points while Minnesota State University, Mankato was picked to finish second with 99 points. The University of South Dakota was the overwhelming favorite to win it in 2008 with 132 points, and 18 of 19 possible first place votes. The Coyotes and Minnesota State were co-champions in 2007, with USD winning the NCC post season tournament.

David Dreas

David Dreas (Winona) began the season #17 on the SCSU all-time scoring list with 1,305 career points. After scoring 25 points against North Dakota, he moved into 4th place all-time and with 20 against UMD he became just the fourth Husky ever to score 1,600 career points. Dreas is 2nd in the NCC averaging 18.8 points per game.

End of the NCC: The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), four golf championships (1994, 2004, 05, 07), two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 04), and one basketball championship (1989).

Bulldogs Give Huskies Tough Test: On Jan. 12 Minnesota Duluth came to town looking to give SCSU their first conference loss and early on it looked as if they would when UMD jumped ahead 6-0 and held the lead for nearly the first six minutes of the game. After a close first half the Huskies went into halftime ahead by four at 35-31, and out of the break used an 11-4 run to go up by 11 at 46-35. With 12:02 remaining the Huskies still led by 11, but at 4:16 they led by two at 59-57. A three point play by Dusty Wabiszewski gave SCSU a five point lead at 62-57, before the game ended at 63-59.

North Dakota Downed To Open Conference Play: UND came into the game with the Huskies having won 10 of their last 11 games, only losing to Division I Iowa State during the stretch. Any doubts about the outcome were answered early when Matt Schneck gave the Huskies the lead for good with two free throws at the 14:37 mark of the first half. The points started a 15-2 SCSU run that Schneck capped himself with a breakaway dunk to give the Huskies a 16-13 lead midway through the opening period. A 37-27 halftime score led to an identical second half for each team and the game ended with SCSU winning 74-54 to open the final North Central Conference season 1-0.

About Minnesota State: The Mavericks of Minnesota State University enter the game with SCSU carrying a 12-4 overall record following a 2-0 opening weekend in league play. The purple Mavs started conference play with an impressive 92-72 win over Minnesota Duluth on the road and followed it up with a 71-66 decision over North Dakota at home. The Mavericks have won their last three games, and their only losses in their last ten games came from a home and home series with #4 Winona State. MSU is directed by seventh year head coach Matt Margenthaler who has led his team to three consecutive NCAA tournaments. Last season the Mavericks shared the regular season NCC crown with South Dakota and, after knocking SCSU out of the NCC tournament in the semi-finals, fell to the Coyotes in the championship game. Winless in three attempts last year, the Huskies last beat Minnesota State during the 2005-06 season.

About Augustana: The Augustana Vikings are the owners of a 13-4 record and 1-1 mark in the NCC. Augustana made things interesting in their first NCC game going into double overtime before eventually falling 98-97 to #12 Nebraska-Omaha. Two nights later the Vikings again found themselves in overtime with a top-25 team. This time it was #3 South Dakota and Augustana had fate on their side as they were able to pull off the upset winning 95-90 in the extra session. Fifth year head coach Tom Billeter entered the 2007-08 season with a 42-69 record at the helm of the Viking squad and a 139-119 career mark. Augustana had won four straight before falling to UNO, and earlier this season rattled off seven consecutive wins. SCSU scored the season sweep of the Vikings in 2006-07 first winning 81-76 on the road and following it up with an 85-80 home win.

In Good Company: Already just one of three coaches in the programs 85 year history to record over 200 wins, head coach Kevin Schlagel became the second winningest coach in school history with the win over North Dakota on Jan. 10. After defeating Minnesota Duluth Schlagel's career record stands at 211-95 while Butch Raymond holds the record for coaching wins with a 231-142 career mark.

NCC Player of the Week: On Jan. 7 David Dreas was honored as the North Central Conference men's basketball player of the week following his performance in the Huskies' three games during the holiday break. During the stretch Dreas played 35.0 minutes per game and averaged 24.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 3.7 assists, and 3.3 steals per game. As the Huskies went 2-1 with wins over Minnesota, Crookston and the University of Sioux Falls, Dreas saw his scoring average rise from 16.7 to a league second best 18.3 heading into conference play.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) opens his eleventh season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2007-08. He enters the new year with a won/loss record of 198-92. He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 97-59 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Five times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-5 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.
