Have We Already Met: With their two games this week, the Huskies will meet two teams they have already played and beaten this season. Minnesota State University Moorhead comes to town on Jan. 22, and then the Huskies head to the University of Minnesota Duluth on Jan. 26.

Non-Conference For The Last Time: When the Huskies take on MSU Moorhead at 7:00 pm on Jan. 22, it will mark their final non-conference game of the year. It will also mark the final time the two teams will meet as non-conference foes as the Huskies move into the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference next season.

Bulldog Buddies: After meeting in St. Cloud during the first weekend of NCC play the Huskies pay a return visit to Minnesota Duluth just two weeks later for a 3:00 pm match up on Saturday Jan. 26.

Vikings Surge In Second Half: With the Huskies looking to get back in the win column against Augustana, things were looking good as they took a four point lead into halftime. But SCSU was out scored 46-30 in the second half the dropped their second straight 75-63.

Rough Night In Mankato: The Huskies hit the road to take on Minnesota State, Jan. 17, with each team holding the NCC's best mark at 2-0. It wasn't the Huskies night as MSU shot better than 60% in the second half to earn the 96-72 win and the top spot in the NCC at 3-0.

Team Captains: Senior guards David Dreas (Winona) and Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) will serve as the team captains in 2007-08.

Third in the NCC Preseason: The Huskies have been picked to finish third in the final season of the North Central Conference in the annual poll by the league media. The Huskies received 94 points while Minnesota State University, Mankato was picked to finish second with 99 points. The University of South Dakota was the overwhelming favorite to win it in 2008 with 132 points, and 18 of 19 possible first place votes. The Coyotes and Minnesota State were co-champions in 2007, with USD winning the NCC post season tournament.

David Dreas (Winona) began the season #17 on the SCSU all-time scoring list with 1,305 career points. He scored 15 more against Augustana, moving ever closer to a top-three spot on the SCSU charts. Dreas is 2nd in the NCC averaging 17.6 points per game.

End of the NCC: The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), four golf championships (1994, 2004, 05, 07), two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 04), and one basketball championship (1989).

All-Time Records: The Huskies hold the advantage all-time with MSUM 75-37 including a win in their last meeting, 84-74 on Nov. 27. SCSU also leads the all-time series with UMD 43-29 including their recent win, 63-59 on Jan. 12.

About Minnesota State Moorhead: The Huskies beat MSU Moorhead 84-74 on Nov. 27, and have now beaten the Dragons in four straight contests. The loss from the Huskies was the first of the season for MSUM, who lost again four nights later before ripping off seven consecutive wins. After dropping both games last weekend the Dragons are 11-6 and 4-5 in the NSIC. Losers of four of their last five, MSUM dropped road league games to Southwest Minnesota State (64-69) and Wayne State (63-70) over the weekend. The Dragons last won on Jan. 12 in a 72-47 home victory over Upper Iowa. In conference play, MSUM is led by junior forward Justyn Burgess who is seventh in the conference with 14.4 ppg. Meanwhile junior guard/forward Jamal O'Neal boasts the leagues second best mark in rebounding at 7.7 boards per contest.

About Minnesota Duluth: The win over the Bulldogs on Jan. 12 made it 10 in a row for SCSU over their northeast Minnesota rivals. The loss was the seventh in a row for UMD who also dropped their next contest to Augustana before snapping their eight game losing streak with a win on Jan. 19 over #10 Nebraska-Omaha. The Bulldogs led by six at halftime and out scored the Mavericks 41-30 in the second half as they cruised to the win. Senior guard Jordan Nuness still ranks as the NCC scoring leader at 18.6 ppg and in conference play ranks fifth at 17.3 ppg. Junior forward Brian Sykora has grabbed 9.3 rebounds per game through the young conference season which is the best mark in the NCC.

Augie Makes It Two In a Row: Things looked good for the Huskies for 29 of the games 40 minutes. Problem was those other 11 all came at the end. With 11:03 left to play in the second half, the Vikings took the lead for good and the closest the Huskies could get was within five points late. SCSU was forced to foul with a minute and a half left but Augustana was a perfect 10-10 from the free throw line down the stretch seal the 75-63 win.

Vikings Snap Two SCSU Streaks: By beating the Huskies Saturday afternoon the Vikings broke a pair of streaks by SCSU. Foremost the loss was the first at home for the Huskies who were previously were a perfect 10-0 in Halenbeck Hall. Secondly it was the first loss to Augustana since as 93-95 double overtime road loss late in the 2005-06 season.

Huskies Fall In Battle of Top Dogs: St. Cloud State and Minnesota State entered the game on Thursday night each boasting 2-0 NCC records, which topped the league standings. In a high scoring affair, the Mavericks out shot the Huskies 54% to 44% for the game which included a 62% to 48% disparity in the second half as they ran to the 96-72 victory.

Just Give Me Another Chance: In their win, the Mavericks scored a combined 40 points off turnovers and second chances, compared to 17 for the Huskies. The Huskies were out-rebounded 41-28 for the game and 14-7 on offensive boards.

Schneck Sets the Pace: In each the Huskies games this week, sophomore center Matt Schneck led the Huskies in scoring. He netted 14 against MSU, and followed it up with a 19 point nine rebound effort against Augustana. The 19 points marked the second highest total of the year for Schneck.

Wabiszewski Keeps On Sharing: In the loss to MSU, senior guard Dusty Wabiszewski dished out eight assists, marking the seventh time this season he has recorded eight or more. In nine games in his senior campaign, he has dished out at least seven assists.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) opens his eleventh season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2007-08. He enters the new year with a won/loss record of 198-92. He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 97-59 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Five times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-5 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.
