**Huskies To Take On Dragons:** The St. Cloud State men will continue their current road trip with a non-conference game in Moorhead, Minn. on Nov. 27 at 8:00 p.m. The Huskies will be taking on Minnesota State University Moorhead, and the Dragons enter the game 3-0 thus far this season after a 2-0 trip to Aberdeen, S.D. and the Super Eight Classic. In the Classic, MSUM gained an 81-66 win over Lake Superior State and an 81-72 win over Graceland University. The game will be the first at home for the Dragons who are led in scoring by junior Jamal O'Neal at 12.7 points per game. MSUM finished 13-15 in 2006-07.

**Huskies Handle Wildcats:** Behind standout performances by Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, Wis.) and Ross Winnekins (Wayzata), St. Cloud State was able to cruise to a 99-71 victory Nov. 20 over Wayne State in Halenbeck Hall. Wabiszewski handed out a career high 12 assists and Winnekins scored a career high 24 points to lead SCSU. As a team the Huskies shot nearly 60% from the field for the game. Every SCSU player was able to get on the floor, and 12 of the 13 found the basket.

**St. Cloud State 2-0 at Thanksgiving Classic:** The Huskies traveled to Omaha, Neb. for the University of Nebraska-Omaha Thanksgiving Classic on Nov. 23 and 24. SCSU opened with a convincing 89-68 win over Montana State-Billings and escaped with a 52-50 win over Colorado State-Pueblo to close the weekend.

**Team Captains:** Senior guards David Dreas (Winona) and Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) will serve as the team captains in 2007-08.

**Receiving Votes:** St. Cloud State received votes in the NABC/Division II Coaches Preseason poll released Oct. 31. Winona State University is the number one ranked team in the preseason.

**Third in the NCC Preseason:** The Huskies have been picked to finish third in the final season of the North Central Conference in the annual poll by the league media. The Huskies received 94 points while Minnesota State University, Mankato was picked to finish second with 99 points. The University of South Dakota was the overwhelming favorite to win it in 2008 with 132 points, and 18 of 19 possible first place votes. The Coyotes and Minnesota State were co-champions in 2007, with USD winning the NCC post season tournament.

David Dreas (Winona) began the season #17 on the SCSU all-time scoring list with 1,305 career points. With 40 points in three games last week he now sits at 12th all-time with 1,371 points scored in a Husky Uniform.

**End of the NCC:** The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status. The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 90, 91, 93, 94, 97, 98, 99, 2002, 03, 04, 05, 06) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), four golf championships (1994, 2004, 05, 07), two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991). The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 87, 88, 90, 91), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 04), and one basketball championship (1989).



**Records Against MSU Moorhead:** In their only game of the week the Huskies are matched up with Minnesota State Moorhead. With 111 meetings dating back to 1932-33, only Minnesota State Mankato, Winona State, and Bemidji State have battled more with SCSU. The Huskies hold the advantage in the all-time series winning 74 of those games to just 37 for MSUM, including the last three. Last season SCSU scored a two point victory, winning 68-66.

**Huskies Start 5-0:** For just the third time under head coach Kevin Schlagel, St. Cloud State has begun a season with five consecutive wins. The last time was just three years ago in 2004-05 when his squad began that season with six straight victories. The best start to a Schalgel coached team came in 2001-02 when the Huskies rattled off 11 wins to begin the season before finishing with a 21-7 record.

**Hanging On For The Win:** Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, Wis.) scored a game high 16 points to lead the Huskies past Colorado State-Pueblo, and SCSU needed every one of them to sneak away with the 52-50 win. Wabiszewski scored the final SCSU points when he hit a three with 2:29 left to play that put the Huskies up 52-45. A sequence of missed shots and fouls by SCSU allowed CSU-Pueblo to get back within two with 1:21 still remaining. A foul by Ross Winnekins (Wayzata) gave CSU-P the ball one last time with 35 seconds to play, but Ty McTyer missed a lay-up with two seconds left of play that would have sent the game into overtime, preserving the victory for the Huskies.

**Career Nights Against Montana State-Billings:** In the 89-68 win over Montana State-Billings on Nov. 23, eight different Huskies set or tied career high marks in either points, rebounds or assists. Spencer Bartz (Hinckley) and Jesse Fisher (Pequot Lakes) led the charge as each set new career highs for points. Fisher netted 15 points bettering his previous mark of 10 set earlier this season, while Bartz knocked down 11 to top his previous best of eight, also set just this season. Fisher added six rebounds to also tie his previous best. Dusty Wabiszewski and David Dreas each tied their career mark in rebounds against MSU-Billings. Wabiszewski pulled down eight, and Dreas grabbed nine boards, while Andrew Bernstetter grabbed a career high three rebounds in the contest. Taylor Witt (Morris) with two assists, Josh Ortmann (Buffalo) with three assists, and Ross Ver Heul (Viborg, S.D.) with two points were also among those setting career highs in the game.

**Bartz on Top of the Charts:** Spencer Bartz remains atop the list of the top three-point shooters in the North Central Conference. Through five games Bartz is 7-9, shooting .778 from behind the arc. He is ahead by just one, with second place sitting at 6-8 this season.

**Wabiszewski Giveth, and Taketh Away:** The Huskies Dusty Wabiszewski also leads the NCC in a pair of categories. His 31 assists are nine better than his closest competitor, and he averages nearly two assists/game better than second place. Wabiszewski also boasts a league high 13 steals on the young season, ahead of second place with 10.

**Sharing the NCC Lead:** At 5-0 St. Cloud State shares the leagues best record with preseason favorite South Dakota. Not far behind 5-0 SCSU and USD, is 4-0 Nebraska-Omaha.

**Head Coach Kevin Schligel**

Kevin Schligel (St. Cloud State, 1976) opens his eleventh season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2007-08. He enters the new year with a won/loss record of 198-92. He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schligel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 97-59 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schligel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Five times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-5 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schligel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.
