This Week: The St. Cloud State men's basketball team will visit the nation's capitol for two non-conference games this week. On Tuesday, Dec. 19, the Huskies will play at Bowie State University (MD) in a 6:00 p.m. (CT) game. Thursday, the Huskies will play at Columbia Union (MD) and tip-off at 12 noon (CT).

Year End Schedule: The Huskies will play two games before reaching the New Year. SCSU's holiday schedule includes a game at Minnesota-Crookston on Dec. 29 and a home encounter on Dec. 31 against Northern Michigan at 2:00 p.m.

The Record: St. Cloud State is 9-1 after posting a home overtime win against Southwest Minnesota State 76-73 and a road win at Wayne State (NE) 65-32.

On the Radio: Husky Basketball has a new radio home in 2006-07. KNSI 1450 AM Radio will air Husky men's basketball. Don Lyons will call the games from Maryland. The pre-game show begins one-half hour prior to tip-off.

St. Cloud State Notes: The Huskies have won eight in a row including two wins last week...it's the longest win streak since the Huskies won seven straight last season and eight straight during the 2004-05 season...SCSU is 4-0 on the road this season...junior guard David Dreas (Winona) scored 47 points in the Huskies two wins last week, including a season high 30 points against Wayne State...he has scored in double figures in four straight games and eight of ten this season...Dreas leads the North Central Conference in scoring this week with his 19.3 points per game average...he was named the NCC Player of the Week on Dec. 11... junior guard Eric Greene (Kingston, WI) scored a season high 14 points against Wayne State including six points on three steals near the end of the first half... junior guard Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) leads the NCC in steals for the second straight week with 2.60 per game... SCSU's win over Southwest Minnesota State was the first overtime game of the season for the Huskies... SCSU is averaging 76.1 points and allowing 62.1 this season...the Huskies are out rebounding their opponents 35.0 to 32.7.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) is in his tenth season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2006-07. He enters the new year with a won/loss record of 179-81. He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 90-54 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Four times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-4 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.

Opponent Notes

About Bowie State University: The Bulldogs are 5-2 overall and are coming off an 87-80 loss to Saint Augustine's on December 12. BSU has won two of its last three games. Three players average in double figures for the Bulldogs. They are led by senior guard Gil Goodrich as he averaged 27.6 points per game. Senior forward Tyrone Beale leads the team in rebounding with 10.0 boards per game and averages 19.7 points per game. Junior guard Orlando Wright is averaging 13.6 points per game. As a team, the Bulldogs average 89.1 points per game and allow 84.9. BSU has been out rebounded by its opponents 42.6 to 40.7 this season. Three juniors and two seniors make up the Bulldogs starting line-up. BSU head coach Luke D'Alessio is in his eighth season with the Bulldogs. Bowie State is a member of the Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association (CIAA-East), and NCAA Division II conference. Shaw University is a member of that same conference. The St. Cloud State women's basketball team played and defeated Shaw 78-71 in the quarterfinals of the 2006 NCAA Division II Elite Eight held in Hot Springs, Arkansas. Last season the Bulldogs posted a 19-11 overall record and finished 10-6, good for second place in the East Division. The Bulldogs lost all five starts from a year ago. The Huskies and Bulldogs will play each other for the first time.

About Columbia Union College: The Pioneers are 0-10 heading into Thursday's game with the Huskies. CUC has three players that average double figures in scoring. Corey Bluth averages 15.2 points and a team high 7.8 rebounds per game. He is supported by Marice Stallion, who averages 14.3 points and Darren Travis, averaging 13.4 points. The Pioneers average 73 points on offense and are allowing 88.4 points per game. They are being out rebounded this season 42.2 to 36.2. Calvin Dunbar is the head coach of the Pioneers. Last season the Pioneers posted a 6-20 overall record as an independent. This is the first meeting between these two teams.

About Minnesota-Crookston: The Golden Eagles are 0-11 after suffering a 95-71 loss at the University of Minnesota Duluth in Dec. 16. UMC's next game will be against the Huskies on Dec. 29. St. Cloud State holds the series advantage 12-0 and last year the Huskies defeated the Golden Eagles 73-65 in St. Cloud. Freshman guard Bryce Cummings and junior guard Aaron Smith lead UMC in scoring, averaging 10.6 points and 10.0 points, respectively. Senior forward Mike Thompson is the leading rebounder with 5.2 boards per game. UMC averages 69.4 points per game and is allowing 82.8 points. They have been out rebounded by a margin of 39.2 to 32.9. Head coach Jeff Oseth is in his third season with the Golden Eagles. UMC is a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, and last year posted a 4-24 overall record and 1-13 league mark.

About Northern Michigan: The Wildcats are 5-6 overall entering the week of Dec. 18. Northern Michigan will play Finlandia on Dec. 18 and UW-Stevens Point on Dec. 28, both at home, before heading to St. Cloud on the 31st. NMU has won four straight heading into this week, the last victory an 82-80 win over Ashland. Senior forward Ricky Volcy leads the team in scoring and rebounding, averaging 23.3 points and 11.0 rebounds per game. Senior guard Will Washington adds 14.6 points and junior guard Jake Suardini 10.0 points per game. The Wildcats average 74.3 points and are giving up 74.4 points per game. They have been out rebounded 37.6 to 36.9. Northern Michigan is an NCAA Division II member of the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Conference (GLIAC). Last year, NMU posted a 17-11 overall record and tied for second in the Northern Division of the GLIAC with a 13-5 mark. Head coach Dean Ellis is in his 21st season with the Wildcats and has a 20-year career record of 322-241. The all-time series between the Wildcats and Huskies is tied at 6-6. The last meeting was during the 2004-05 season an 85-72 Husky win.
