2010-11 SEASON COMES TO AN END: The St. Cloud State men's basketball team finished the 2010-11 season with a 15-14 overall record, while finishing Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference play in sixth place with a record of 12-10. The Huskies made it to a third straight NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament Championship and are now 8-1 in tournament play in the team's first three seasons in the league.

SENIOR STARS: St. Cloud State says farewell to five standout seniors this season. The seniors include Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph), Jesse Fisher (Pequot Lakes), Josh Ortmann (Buffalo), Nate Phillips (Rosemount) and Taylor Witt (Morris). All five seniors have combined for 512 total games played and 277 starts for the Huskies during the last four seasons. All five athletes have scored a combined 4,188 points, while posting an 83-40 overall record in four winning seasons.

WINONA STATE ENDS TOURNAMENT RUN: The No. 6 seeded Huskies could not recover from a tough first half of play in a 58-41 loss to No. 5 Winona State University in the NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament Championship Sunday afternoon at the Gengelhoff Center.

HUSKIES UPSET NO. 14 U-MARY: SCSU ended the No. 14 nationally ranked University of Mary's 16-game winning streak with a 65-59 win in the semifinal round of the NSIC/Sanford Health tournament Saturday evening. With the Huskies up 61-59 with 15 seconds to go in the game, sophomore Shaun Jensen (Spring Lake, Park) rebounded a missed Husky free throw and was fouled to put him at the line, where he made the two biggest free throws of the season to put St. Cloud State up 63-59. Then moments later, Jensen grabbed another rebound on the front of a one-and-one free throw miss from the NSIC Player of the Year Anthony Moody and was fouled before burying two more free throws and the Marauders streak.

SCSU BEATS AUGIE IN ROUND ONE: The No. 6 Huskies beat No. 3 Augustana College 79-73 Wednesday night in a quarterfinal game of the NSIC/Sanford Health tournament Wednesday night in Sioux Falls, S.D. It is the third straight season that both teams have played three games against one another. The Huskies have won two games out of three games in all three seasons with one win a piece in a playoff setting.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of husky basketball. Schlagel and his squad are coming off the most successful season in school history after going 29-6 in 2009-10 to earn a trip to the NCAA Final Four in Springfield, Mass.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have now been 20-game winners seven times. Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 266-118 overall record.

Schlagel's squads have went on to win the NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship in 2009 and 2010, to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Weekly Notes

1,700 CLUB: Senior **Taylor Witt** (Morris) finishes his career No. 4 on the all-time scoring list at SCSU after scoring 74 points in the NSIC tournament. He became one of four SCSU players to score 1,700 points in a career. He has also scored in double figures in 27 of 29 games this season and scored more than 20 points in 17 games. Witt scored 584 total points in 2010-11 to finish four points behind his brother Forrest.

A COMPLETE PLAYER: Senior **Andrew Bernstetter** (St. Joseph) finished his career with 1,081 points, which is 29th on the SCSU all-time list. He grabbed the 700th rebound of his career on Mar. 2 and finishes his career with 721 total boards. He became the seventh player in school history to record 700 rebounds and

became one of six players to score over 1,000 points and grab over 700 rebounds in a career. Bernstetter finished the regular season 17th in the NSIC in scoring with 13.9 points a contest and was third in the league in rebounding with 8.7 a game and 191 total boards.

DEADLY AT THE LINE: Witt set a school record Mar. 2 with his 451st free throw made. He passed Dan Hagen's 30-year record at 450 with his ninth free throw against Augustana. He ends his career with 465 made free throws in 570 attempts (81.6%).

NOT IN MY HOUSE: Bernstetter finished the season with 50 blocks after leading the NSIC in swats during the regular season. He leaves SCSU with a school record 174 blocks in his career and a single season school record of 72 blocks in 2009-10.

NSIC HONORS: Witt and Bernstetter were named All-Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference first and second team members respectfully. Witt earned his third First Team All-NSIC nod, while Bernstetter was named Second Team All-NSIC for the

second time in his career. Witt was also named to his third NSIC All-Tournament Team on Mar. 6.

TOURNAMENT RECORD: Witt set a new NSIC Tournament record with 39 points on Mar. 2 versus Augustana. He passed Winona State's Kyle Schlaak who scored 37 points in 2001. He also finished with the highest scoring average of the tournament at 24.7 points a game.

SCSU IRON MAN: Witt set a school record for most appearances in a career at SCSU with 123 games played. He has not missed a game in his career to pass his brother Forrest for most games played and made 95-straight starts for the Huskies.

SHARP SHOOTER: Senior captain **Josh Ortmann** (Buffalo) finished his career 19th on SCSU all-time list with 78 made three's and is 17th in three point attempts with 267.

SLIMMEST OF MARGINS: SCSU outscored their opponents 2,112 to 2,100 this season (72.8 ppg to 72.4 ppg.)
