Matt Schneck Named Academic All-NCC:

Sioux Falls, S.D.. – St. Cloud State University men's basketball sophomore center Matt Schneck has been named to the Academic All-North Central Conference team, announced today Feb. 28, by the league office.

The Whitefish Bay, Wis. native is in the midst of his second season at SCSU and was named to the team of 12 student athletes by a league wide vote of conference sports information directors.

Schneck carries a 3.67 GPA as a Pre-Business major, and earlier this month was named Academic All-District by ESPN the Magazine.

Schneck has been a starter in every game for the Huskies this season and is currently the teams second leading scorer. He is also the teams leading rebounder, and leads the team in field goal percentage. Schneck has stepped up his play in conference games, where his 14.9 ppg lies just outside the NCC top-10.

The Huskies have just one regular season game remaining, this Saturday Mar. 1 on the road at the University of South Dakota. With a 17-9 record and 5-6 mark in NCC play, a win this weekend and a little help could get the Huskies a first round NCC tournament game at home. We'll know for sure after everything plays out, tip-off with the 21-4 Coyotes is set for 4:00 pm.

St. Cloud State University is the largest member of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities (MnS-CU) system. Founded in 1869, and located in St. Cloud, Minn. along the banks of the scenic Mississippi River, SCSU boasts an enrollment of 16,000 students and is a member of NCAA Division II athletics where they compete in the North Central Conference (NCC).
