Ross Winnekins Named Academic All-NCC:

Sioux Falls, S.D.. – St. Cloud State University men's basketball sophomore center Ross Winnekins has been named to the Academic All-North Central Conference team, announced today Feb. 28, by the league office.

The Wayzata, Minn. native is in the midst of his second season at SCSU and was named to the team of 12 student athletes by a league wide vote of conference sports information directors.

Winnekins carries a 3.21 GPA as a Mass Communications major.

Winnekins has appeared in every game for the Huskies this season and has been a starter in the last five. The team's fourth leading scorer, he is also second on the team in rebounds and is shooting a team best 83% from the free throw line.

The Huskies have just one regular season game remaining, this Saturday Mar. 1 on the road at the University of South Dakota. With a 17-9 record and 5-6 mark in NCC play, a win this weekend and a little help could get the Huskies a first round NCC tournament game at home. We'll know for sure after everything plays out, tip-off with the 21-4 Coyotes is set for 4:00 pm.

St. Cloud State University is the largest member of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities (MnS-CU) system.
