**Ross Ver Heul Named to the Academic Honor Roll:**

Sioux Falls, S.D. – The North Central Conference continues to announce their post-season awards, and today Mar. 13, the 2007-08 NCC Commissioner's Academic Men's Basketball Honor Roll was released with four Huskies named to the squad.

With four student-athletes on the 17-member squad, the Huskies sit alongside Augustana and North Dakota as the best represented teams on the Honor Roll. To qualify the student-athletes must have a minimum 3.20 grade point average, have completed at least two semesters at their current school and have competed against outside competition.

Among the Huskies listed was forward Ross Ver Heul of Viborg, S.D. The sophomore is undeclared, and earns a spot on the Honor Roll in his first year of eligibility.

Ver Heul came off the bench to appear in 15 games for the Huskies this season who closed out 2007-08 with a 17-11 record and 5-7 fifth place tally in the North Central Conference.
