David Dreas Selected to NABC/NCAA Division II All-Star Game:

Indianapolis, Ind. – St. Cloud State senior men's basketball player, David Dreas, has been selected as one of 20 NCAA Division II basketball players to participate in the National Association of Basketball Coaches/NCAA Division II All-Star Game. This is just the latest honor for Dreas who completed his outstanding career for the Huskies this winter.

The Winona native will represent St. Cloud State as a member of the West squad in the game to be played March 28 at the Naismith Memorial Hall of Fame in Springfield, Mass. The West All-Star team is comprised of players from the Great Lakes, North Central, South Central and West regions, while the East team is made up of players from the East, Northeast, South and South Atlantic regions. The All-Star Game will be a part of the NCAA Division II Men's Basketball Elite Eight which is being held March 26, 27, and 29 at the MassMutual Center in Springfield, Mass.

Only one other player from the NCC or the North Central region will be joining Dreas in Springfield for the third annual All-Star Game. Atila Santos of Minnesota State is also one of the 10 players selected to the West squad.

Dreas led the Huskies to a 17-11 overall record in 2007-08 and led the team in scoring at 17.8 points per game. The team's leading scorer the last three seasons, Dreas became the most prolific three-point shooter this season with 250 made in his career as well as becoming the Huskies second all-time leading scorer with 1,802 career points.

Already this post season Dreas has been named first team All-NCC, first team Daktronics All-North Central Region, and first team NABC All-North Central District. During his senior campaign he was also a two-time NCC player of the week.

In the second Division II All-Star Game in 2007, the West All-Star Team defeated the East All-Stars, 97-92. Kevin Johnson of Humboldt State University finished with 18 points, 13 rebounds, and 4 blocked shots on his way to earning Most Outstanding Player for the West All-Stars. Christian Burns of Philadelphia University recorded 18 points and 11 rebounds to earn MOP honors for the East All-Star Team.
