**Matt Schneck Named ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District:**

St. Cloud, Minn. – St. Cloud State University men's basketball sophomore center Matt Schneck has been named to the District Five All-Academic Third Team by ESPN the Magazine. Schneck is the only Husky, and one of just three players from the North Central Conference, to receive the honor.

The Whitefish Bay, Wis. native is in his second year at SCSU and is the owner of a 3.67 GPA as a Pre-Business major. Once nominated, the honorees were selected by the national voting members of the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA).

In addition to his success off the court, Schneck is one of three Huskies to start in all 23 games for SCSU this season. The teams second leading scorer at 12.6 points per game, Schneck leads SCSU in rebounds at 6.8 per game. He is also the team leader in field goal percentage, making better than 60% of his shots from the field which puts him second in the NCC as one of just two players shooting above the 60% mark.

He has produced all three of the Huskies double-double's this season, most recently a 13 point, 11 rebound effort this past Saturday, Feb. 9, against Minnesota State University. Twice this season he has went over 20 points including a career high 25 against Concordia University-St. Paul on Dec. 30.

With just four regular season games remaining on the schedule, Schneck and the Huskies will close out the home portion of the 2007-08 campaign this week with games against Nebraska-Omaha on Feb. 16 at 8:00 pm, and South Dakota on Feb. 16 at 4:00 pm. SCSU is currently 16-7 on the season and sits in fifth place in the NCC with a 4-4 league mark.

St. Cloud State University is the largest member of the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities (MnS-CU) system. Founded in 1869, and located in St. Cloud, Minn. along the banks of the scenic Mississippi River, SCSU boasts an enrollment of 16,000 students and is a member of NCAA Division II athletics where they compete in the North Central Conference (NCC).
