2004-5 ST. CLOUD STATE UNIVERSITY MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM NEWS



Release Date: November 9, 2004

Exhibition: St. Cloud State will close out the preseason with an exhibition game against the University of Minnesota Golden Gophers Friday, November 12 at Williams Arena (14,625) in Minneapolis, Minn. The tip-off at Williams Arena is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. This will be the first match-up ever between these two schools and it will not count in either teams overall record. Minnesota returns one starter from a team that a year ago posted a 12-18 overall record and finished tied for tenth in the Big Ten with a 3-13 record. The Gophers were 10-7 at Williams Arena last season. Senior guard Adam Boone is the lone returning starter but will not be in the line-up for at least the first three months of the season. He is joined by 12 newcomers on the UM roster.

Season Opener: St. Cloud State (0-0 overall) will open up the regular season at the University of Minnesota-Crookston (0-0 overall) on Monday, November 15. The game will tip-off at 7:00 p.m. at Lysaker Gym (3,000) on the UMC campus.

Series Record: St. Cloud State leads the all-time series with Minnesota-Crookston 9-0. Last season the Huskies defeated the Golden Eagles in the season and home opener 89-55. Matt Siegle led the Huskies with 26 points and 11 rebounds in the victory.

On the Radio: Both the Minnesota and Minnesota-Crookston games will be broadcast live on 1390 AM The Fan in St. Cloud with Sports Director Jay Caldwell calling the play-by-play. KVSC 88.1 FM will also call the game live. The KVSC broadcast can be heard on the web at www.kvsc.org, while the 1390 broadcast will be streamed via the SCSU athletics web site at www.stcloudstate.edu/athletics and www.1390thefan.com.

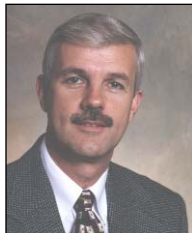
2003-04 Record: The Huskies posted a 17-11 overall record and finished tied for fifth in the North Central Conference with a 7-7 record. SCSU won nine of their first ten games in 2003-04 but lost five of their last seven to end the season.

Home Opener: St. Cloud State will open the 2004-05 home season on Saturday, November 20 with a non-conference game against Southwest Minnesota State University. Game time is 7:00 p.m. at Halenbeck Hall.

Head Coach: Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his eighth season as the head coach of the Huskies. He has accumulated a 138-62 overall record in his seven seasons as head coach. He has also compiled a 75-45 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Three times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-3 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.



Assistant Coaching Staff: Matt Reimer (Central College) is in his eighth season as the top assistant to Coach Schlagel. Reimer also served for two seasons as a graduate assistant coach under Butch Raymond in 1995-96 and 1996-97, bringing his overall experience with the Huskies to nine seasons. Prior to SCSU, Reimer served as an assistant basketball coach at New London-Spicer High School for four seasons. Cory Schlagel (St. Thomas Univ.) begins his first season as a graduate assistant coach with the Huskies. Prior to joining the SCSU staff, Schlagel was an assistant baseball and girls basketball coach, and math teacher at Rush City High School.

Team Captains: Senior guard Nate Miller (Little Falls) and senior forward Steve Trull (Crystal Lake, IL) will serve as the Husky captains in 2004-05.

2004-05 Outlook: The Huskies return a solid nucleus of eight players from a year ago, including three returning starters. Among the starters are the team's top returning scorer in senior guard Nate Miller who averaged 17.5 points per game and was named Honorable Mention All-North Central Conference. Junior forward Matt Siegle led the team in rebounding with a 6.3 average and dropped in 12.5 points per game, and the other starter, Steve Trull averaged 7.4 points and 5.9 rebounds. The addition of five new players in 2004-05 will give the team added depth and greater competition on the floor.
