GOLDEN OPPORTUNITY:

The St. Cloud State men will have a good chance to see where they stand before the season begins when they play an exhibition game against the University of Minnesota on Nov. 3. The Golden Gophers were a 20-win (20-14) team a season ago and posted a 8-10 record in the Big Ten Conference.

FOR THE RECORD: St. Cloud State wrapped up the 2007-08 season with a 17-11 overall record and a 5-7 mark in NCC play. The win total made it the 10th season in head coach Kevin Schlagel's 11 at SCSU, that the Huskies reached 17 wins.

SERIES HISTORY: While the Huskies and Golden Gophers have never truly met on the court, decades ago SCSU would match up with the Minnesota "B" squad. The teams first met in the '35-'36 season with Minnesota B gaining the 52-35 win. After a year off, the two teams met again in '37-'38 and '38-'39 with Minnesota B winning each match-up, however by much closer scores of 31-29 and 32-26 respectively. Then in the '39-'40 season the Huskies finally broke through and took their first game from the Minnesota B team 32-30. Two years later in '42-'43, SCSU won again 49-31 in the final match-up between the teams.



Matt Schneck

ALL-AMERICAN BOY: Junior center Matt Schneck was honored on Oct. 13 by Street & Smith by being named a preseason Honorable Mention All-America. It is the first All-America honor for Schneck who averaged 13.0 points and 6.6 rebounds per game as a sophomore last season. Following his sophomore campaign, Schneck was named a Academic All-District V Third Team honoree by CoSIDA and ESPN the Magazine.

HUSKIES FIFTH IN THE PRESEASON: The Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference released it's preseason coaches poll on Oct. 22, with the Huskies listed fifth. In the new 14-team league, NCC transfer and 2007-08 champion Minnesota State earned the top spot with

seven first place votes. NSIC runner-up last season, Northern State had to settle for second again, getting five first place votes to land in the number two spot. Defending league and National champion Winona State grabbed the final two first place votes and came in at third place. Finishing just ahead of the Huskies with 139 points to SCSU's 131 was Augustana in fourth place.

HOLES TO FILL: For the first time in three seasons, and just the third time under coach Schlagel's guidance, the Huskies do not return an All-Conference performer. SCSU lost each of their All-Conference winners from a year ago as first team member David Dreas and Honorable Mention performer Dusty Wabiszewski each graduated after last season.

FRESH FACES: The Huskies welcome four new players to the team in 2008-09, ready to make an impact right away. Theo Rothstein joins the Huskies from nearby St. Michael-Albertville H.S. after a stellar career where he scored over 1,000 points and earned All-Conference honors. Also out of high school is Iowa native Brett Putz from Forest City H.S. Putz was a record setting scorer on his way to All-State accolades as a prep. Junior college transfer Mahmoud Abdelfattah comes to SCSU from Wilbur Wright Community College in Illinois where he earned All-Conference, All-Region, and All-American Honors. Another transfer in 2008-09 in Michael Riley, who comes to SCSU from Minnesota West Community and Technical College where he averaged double figures in scoring. Finally red-shirting this winter will be Scott Hawkins from New Ulm Public H.S. where he gained Honorable Mention All-State notice while averaging better than 20 points per game.

HUSKIES FIFTH IN THE NCC: With a 5-7 conference mark, the Huskies finished the fifth in the final season of the storied league. The tally broke a string of three consecutive top-three finishes for the Huskies, and it was first since another fifth place finish in the 2003-04 season. Minnesota State won the league title with an 11-1 conference record, the third straight season MSU had won or shared the title.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schalgel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
