### FOR RELEASE NOV. 12, 2008

**TIME TO PLAY:** With their exhibition tilt behind them, the Huskies got back to work with two more weeks of practice before opening the season. And finally this weekend the regular season is here. The Huskies host the Radisson Suite Hotel St. Cloud Hoopster Classic Nov. 15-16 in Halenbeck Hall. SCSU will entertain Metro State College of Denver, Wayne State (Neb.) and Minnesota Crookston at the Hoopster Classic. The Huskies play against Metro State on Nov. 15 and Wayne State on Nov. 16, each game is slated for a 4:00 pm tip-off.

**NORTHERN SUN RISING:** If 2007-08 was the swan song to the NCC, then 2008-09 will be the welcome party for the NSIC. Newly expanded to 14 teams, the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference can boast some of the nations best basketball teams and players. Winona State has won two of the last three national championships and Northern State ended last season ranked in the top-five in the country. Meanwhile Minnesota State, and Augustana were each in the NCAA tournament a year ago. With 20 NSIC games on the schedule, the conference season will now start in early December. To start league play, the Huskies get thrown right into the fire as they travel to defending national champion Winona State on Dec. 5.

**DOUBLE DATE:** With the expanded conference, the Huskies won't be able to match up with everybody twice, as they could in the NCC. After making the trip through the league once, the Huskies will get a second crack at Bemidji State, Concordia, Minnesota Crookston, Minnesota Duluth, Minnesota State, Southwest Minnesota, and Winona State.

**RUNNIN WITH THE RODENTS:** The Huskies hung right in with the Golden Gophers for a full 40 minutes on Nov. 3, before falling by the 88-80 final. The score was tied at the half, 49-49, but Minnesota needed a last second three to keep them from trailing heading into the locker room. Coming out of the break, the Huskies scored first to go back on top and still held a 52-51 lead at the 17:41 mark. Once Minnesota went up 53-52 at 16:24, they would be up for good. The Huskies shot only 33% in the second half, including 23% from behind the arc, which allowed Minnesota to seize control of the game. After falling behind by as much as 16 in the second half, the persistent Huskies chipped away at the Gopher lead, to finish within single digits at 88-80.

**MILESTONE WATCH:** Two things to watch for as the season gets underway will be head coach Kevin Schlagel's chase of Butch Raymond for the coaching victory record at SCSU, and junior center Matt Schneck's countdown to 1,000 points. Currently, Schlagel has 215 wins, second only to Raymond's 231, and Schneck has 658 points, just 342 away from 1,000.

**LEAGUE GAMES OVER THE WEEKEND:** Some NSIC teams have already started their regular season, and none more impressive that Southwest Minnesota. The Mustangs went 3-0 at the Disney West Coast Classic to earn the Tournament Championship. Minnesota Duluth opened at the Disney East Coast Tip-Off Classic and went 2-1, falling in the title game to Florida Southern College. Minnesota State also opened at the Disney East Coast Tip-Off Classic, and finished 2-1 as well. The Mavericks however, dropped their first game, before winning their final two.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

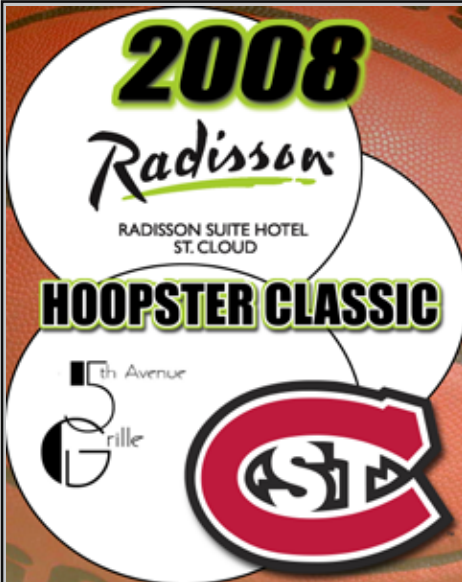
**ROADRUNNERS NOTES:** Metro State is a member of the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference (RMAC). Last season, the Roadrunners posted a 19-12 overall record and finished third in the RMAC East Division with a 12-7 record. Two Metro players have been named to the RMAC Preseason All-East team. Senior forward Jesse Wagstaff and senior guard Marquise Carrington were honored. Wagstaff is the top returning scorer for the Roadrunners as he averaged 14.7 points and 6.4 rebounds last season. Carrington averaged 14.3 points and dished out 110 assists last season. The Roadrunners have been picked win the East Division and finish second overall in the RMAC this season. Head coach Brannon Hays (Cal Lutheran) begins his third season at the helm of the Roadrunners. Hays has a 47-16 record at Metro State and is 105-94 in seven seasons as a head coach. He was the head coach at Colorado Christian for five years.

**WILDCATS NOTES:** Wayne State College is a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC). The Wildcats posted a 16-13 overall record last season and finished 10-8 in the NSIC, good for a fourth place tie. The Wildcats return two starters from last season in senior guard David Walters and senior forward Jonathon Thomas. Walters averaged 5.4 points and 2.8 rebounds. Thomas averaged 9.9 points and 6.8 rebound per game. The Wildcats were picked to finish ninth in the NSIC preseason basketball coaches poll. Head coach Rico Burkett (North Dakota) begins his ninth season with the Wildcats. He has compiled a 100-122 overall won/loss record.

**GOLDEN EAGLE NOTES:** The University of Minnesota, Crookston is also a member of the NSIC. The Golden Eagles posted a 5-22 overall record last season and finished tenth in the NSIC with a 2-16 league record. Among the top returners for the Golden Eagles are senior guard Matt Pelzer, junior guard Bryce Cummings, and sophomore guard Akeem Cubie. Pelzer average 5.0 points per game and had 27 steals on the season. Cummings is the top returning scorer for UMC. He averaged ten points and 2.4 assists per game. Cubie averaged 9.1 points per game and was a 53.8 percent field goal shooter. Head coach Jeff Oseth (MSU-Moorhead) is in his sixth season with the Golden Eagles and has a 23-114 overall won/loss record.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program. Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).



Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schalgel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
