BORDER BATTLE: St. Cloud State and Saint John's University meet up this weekend in their annual battle for central Minnesota bragging rights. Tip-off is set for 7:30 on Nov. 22 in Sexton Arena on the campus of SJU.

FOR THE RECORD: After the Radisson Suite Hotel St. Cloud Hoopster Classic the Huskies sit at 2-0 on the young season while St. John's enters at 0-1.

SERIES HISTORY: For the 104th time the Huskies and Johnnies will match up on the hardwood. SCSU scored a 82-56 win over SJU last season in Halenbeck Hall to extend their lead in the all-time series to 59-44. The Huskies have won two straight over the Johnnies.

ABOUT THE JOHNNIES: Led by 45th year head coach Jim Smith, St. John's enters 2008-09 off a 14-12 season a year ago. After finishing in a fifth place tie in the MIAC with an 11-9 record, the Johnnies were bounced in the first round of the MIAC tournament by third seeded Carleton. SJU had four players average double digit points a season ago, but return only one of them in sophomore Chris Schwartz.



Schwartz put up 12.9 points per game in his first season in Collegeville. SJU opened the new campaign on Nov. 15 against UW-Stevens Point, and fell on the road 97-70. In the loss Schwartz posted a team high 23 points. Fellow sophomore Aaron Burtzel grabbed a team high 12 rebounds in the loss. Long time coach Jim Smith brings 685 wins into the 2008-09 season, and is one of the few coaches to have coached in 1,000 career games. The winningest coach in Minnesota collegiate basketball history, Smith has led SJU to seven MIAC titles, five MIAC playoff titles, nine NAIA national tournaments and eight NCAA DIII tournaments. The Johnnies were in the NCAA tournament as recently as 2007.

BROTHERLY LOVE: Tim and Ellie Ortmann might have a tough time choosing which team to cheer for on Saturday. Their sons Josh and Nathan will suit up for the Huskies and Johnnies respectively. Josh is a 6-3 sophomore guard for the Huskies and has started that first two games this season while averaging 4.5 points and 1.4 rebounds. He also set a career high with six assists in the Huskies opener against Metro State. Nathan is a 6-5 junior wing for the Johnnies and did not see any action in the St. John's opener.

THE 700 CLUB: With 693 career points, junior center Matt Schneck will look to get his 700th career point on Saturday against St. John's.

DOUBLE DOUBLE-DOUBLES: Andrew Bernstetter scored 16 points and grabbed a career high 10 rebounds against Metro State to tally the first double-double of his career. A night later Schneck led the way with 24 points and 10 boards for the eighth if his career. The Huskies now have four double-doubles in their last four games.

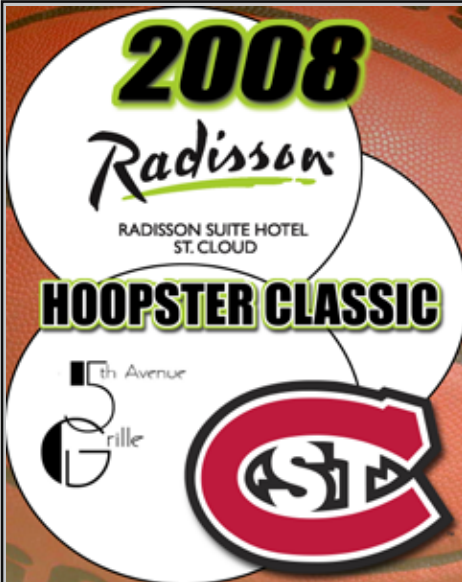
TAYLOR MADE: Sophomore guard Taylor Witt lit up the scoreboard in the opener against Metro State. Witt knocked down a career high 27 points and hit 7-10 three's on his way there. The 27 points was nearly 10 better than his previously high of 18, and his seven three-pointers, and three steals in the game were also career highs.

HUSKIES SWEEP THROUGH: The Huskies went 2-0 at the Radisson Suite Hotel St. Cloud Hoopster Classic, and for the second consecutive season the Huskies ran through the Classic unscathed. SCSU is now 4-0 in their last four Hoopster Classic games and 6-2 all-time.

CLASSIC GAMES: The Huskies went 2-0 in their two games, while Minnesota Crookston went 0-2. Metro State and Wayne State each finished 1-1 with wins over UMC and losses to SCSU.

WAYNE STATE HANDLES MINNESOTA CROOKSTON: Wayne State raced out to a 41-21 halftime lead over Minnesota Crookston in the opening game of the Radisson Suite Hotel Hoopster Classic. The Wildcats shot better than 55% in the first half and nearly 60% from three point range as they built up the 20-point advantage. Meanwhile the Golden Eagles shot only 44% from the field and really struggled from behind the arc, shooting just 13% in the period. UMC was able to turn the tables slightly in the second half and outscored WSC 26-19 in the half, while also outshooting them 41%-39%. However the Wildcat lead was too much to overcome and UMC suffered the 60-47 defeat.

ROADRUNNERS RUN BY GOLDEN EAGLES: Minnesota Crookston came out on fire and hit six threes in the first seven minutes of play to hold a 22-15 lead at the 13:10 mark of the opening stanza. The tides quickly turned however as UMC was outscored 44-16 for the rest of the half as Metro sprinted to their 59-38 half-time advantage. The two teams then played a nearly even second half to finish by the 85-66 final. Metro State was led by Jesse Wagstaff and his 27 points on 10-15 shooting and 5-7 free throw shooting. No other Roadrunner finished in double figures. Akeen Cubie led the way for UMC with 19 points.

MORE NOTES

FAMILIAR PLACE: With their win in the season open over Metro State began the season 1-0 for the 23rd straight season. The last time the Huskies didn't open the season with a win was in 1983, when SCSU lost to Iowa State in opener 37-77.

GOOD RUN: In their game with Metro State, the Huskies saw their lead shrink all the way to just three points after a pair of Roadrunner free throws. From there however, the Huskies went on to score 12 straight points and hold a commanding 81-66 lead with just 18 seconds left to play. The catalyst to the scoring binge was a Taylor Witt to Andrew Bernstetter alley-oop that brought the crowd to their feet and energized the Huskies.

IN THE BOOKS: Newcomer Mahmoud Abdelfattah got his name in the stat sheet under the scoring summary on Sunday as he netted the first four points of his Husky career against Wayne State. Abdelfattah was the only SCSU newcomer to score over the weekend.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program. Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
