### FOR RELEASE NOV. 24, 2008

#### CARL'S JR. MAC MARTIN TOURNAMENT:

Following the Thanksgiving holiday the Huskies will head west to Chico, Calif for the Carl's Jr. Mac Martin Tournament, hosted by California State University, Chico (commonly known as Chico State). The Huskies will open with the Humboldt State Lumberjacks on Friday, Nov. 28, at 7:30 CT, and then play the tournament host Chico State Wildcats at 9:30 CT on Nov. 29.

**FOR THE RECORD:** Following their win over St. John's the Huskies improve to 3-0 on the young season. This marks the second straight season SCSU has been 3-0.

**SERIES HISTORY:** SCSU and Humboldt State will reunite following a 40-year hiatus. The last meeting came during the 1968-69 season with the Huskies winning 81-64 to give them the 1-0 all-time advantage. Chico State however, will take on SCSU for the first time, and becomes the Huskies 160th different opponent (among 4-year schools) in the programs history.

**TURKEY GAMES:** This weekends trip to California will be the first of its kind for SCSU under Coach Schlagel. The Huskies have played in Omaha, Duluth, and even Boca Raton, Fla. over the holiday in recent years, but never to California. Schlagel is 15-2 in games played on the Thanksgiving holiday weekend, as has won his last four.

**HUSKIES RUN PAST JOHNNIES:** The Johnnies shot better from the floor than the Huskies in the first half, but SCSU put up 15 more shots in the period and got enough of them to fall to create SCSU's 44-30 halftime lead. Brett Carmichael led the way for the Huskies in the half with 13 points. In the second half the Huskies shot 44% compared to 37% for the Johnnies as they put the game out of reach. SCSU also held a huge 46-27 advantage on the boards. The Huskies won for the third straight time over the Johnnies.

#### FIVE HUSKIES HIT DOUBLE FIGURES:

Five different players scored over 10 points as SCSU topped SJU. Carmichael led the way with 13 points and was matched by Craig Coenen with his 13, just off a career mark (14). Josh Ortmann tallied 12 to just miss a career high (13) and Taylor Witt and Matt Schneck

each pitched in 11. The last time SCSU had five players hit double-digits was on 1/22/08 when SCSU beat visiting MSU Moorhead 88-71 in Halenbeck Hall. David Dreas (25), Witt (18), Ross Winnekins (13), Schneck (12) and Andrew Bernstetter (12) all made the grade.

**OCTOGENARIAN:** With the win over SJU, Husky head coach Kevin Schlagel recorded his 80th career road victory.

**TRIPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE:** For the third time in three games, and the fifth time in the last five SCSU games, the Huskies have tallied a double-double. This time it was again Matt Schneck as he scored 11 points to go along with 10 rebounds.

**BOUNCING BALLS:** With 46 rebounds against SJU, the Huskies posted their best mark in a Calendar year. On 11/23/07, SCSU grabbed 55 boards in a 89-68 win over Montana State-Billings.

**NSIC RANKINGS:** After their 3-0 start the Huskies one of the hottest shooting teams in the league. At .492, SCSU sits in fourth place, and is just being the teams in front of them in Minnesota Duluth (.500) and Minnesota State (.497). Northern State is pacing the field with their .551 shooting percentage. The Huskies are second in the league in turnover margin with a per game mark of +6.67. Also in scoring margin, SCSU is third in the NSIC at +16.3 points per game. Individually, Josh Ortmann leads the NSIC in assist/turnover ratio with a mark of 12.00.

**NSIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** Following his performance in the Hoopster Classic, the Huskies Matt Schneck was named the first NSIC player of the week for the new season on 11/18. Schneck averaged 17.5 points and 7.5 rebounds in the two games.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.



**PLAYER NOTES**

**4 THEO ROTHSTEIN:** Saw four minutes against St. John's and grabbed a career high three rebounds...also dished out one assist.

**10 BRETT PUTZ:** In 17 minutes against SJU, scored his first career points as a Husky with nine on the contest coming off 4-6 shooting...was 1-3 from three point range for his first career three-pointer...also grabbed a career high three rebounds.

**12 SPENCER BARTZ:** Saw eight minutes against St. John's

**14 MICHAEL RILEY:** Saw his most significant action as a Husky, helping close out the Johnnies...in seven minutes he grabbed one rebound, one steal and dished out two assists.

**20 TAYLOR WITT:** Started for the third straight game and hit double figures for the third straight game...scored 11 points to go along with four assists and two steals in 25 minutes..provided the evening highlight by making a no-look basket under the net after stealing a Johnnie inbound pass.

**24 JOSH ORTMANN:** Earn third start and just missed scoring a career high with 12 points, but did have be most productive game of the season...was a perfect 4-4 from the free throw line and added four rebounds, three assists, and a steal in 25 minutes.

**30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAHAT:** Played most complete game as a Husky with career highs of seven points and five rebounds in 15 minutes.

**32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER:** Started for the third time in as many games...scored five points and grabbed one rebound in 20 minutes...added two steals and one assist.

**34 BRETT CARMICHAEL:** Started for the third time and led the Huskies out of the gate and to the victory...scored 13 first half points that would stand up as a team game high...grabbed seven rebounds, six on offense, and handed out three assists...was perfect at the line going 3-3...played a team high 27 minutes.

**40 JESSE FISHER:** In 14 minutes grabbed two rebounds, passed out one assist and went 4-4 from the charity stripe to finish with four points.

**42 CRAIG COENEN:** Missed a career high by one point, finishing with 13 on the evening...went 6-10 from the field and 1-1 from the line...pulled down four rebounds and added two assists and two steals.

**50 MATT SCHNECK:** Started for the third time...recorded his second double-double in as many games with 11 points and 10 rebounds (nine on defense)...also tallied one steal in 15 minutes of play.

**OPPONENT INFO**

**ABOUT THE LUMBERJACKS:** Humboldt State is currently 3-2 on the season and is riding a three game winning streak. After starting with two straight losses (including 52-103 to NSIC team Southwest Minnesota) HSU has rattled off three wins and topped 83 points in each. Leading the way has been Kyle Baxter who, despite just one start, is the only player averaging double figures at 11.6 points. A solid shooting team, HSU is averaging 45% from the floor including a 32% shooting mark from behind the three-point line. Expectations are high early in the season for the Lumberjacks as they come off a 20-9 season where they were regular season California Collegiate Athletic Association champions and earned a NCAA tournament berth.

**ABOUT THE WILDCATS:** Chico State enters at 0-4 after playing each of their first four games away from home. Senior forward Andy Bocian has been a spark for the Wildcats with an average of nearly 24 points and has led CSUC in scoring in three of four games, including a 36 point outburst on 11/21. In three of four games (including the last two) the Wildcats have held the lead at the half, only to see it slip away each time. In the fourth game, CSUC was down 46-25 at the break, and despite outscoring their opponent in the second half, could not complete the comeback. Chico State is playing for new head coach Greg Clink who took over after long time head coach Puck Smith retired last season. Clink inherited a program that was 7-20 and 3-17 in CCAA conference play in 2007-08.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
