CONFERENCE CALL WITH THE CHAMPS:

What better way to open the season in the new conference than with the defending league and national champions. SCSU begins Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference (NSIC) play in Winona, Minn. on Dec. 5 at 8:00 pm with Winona State who has won two of the last three NCAA titles and the last three NSIC championships. On Dec. 6 the Huskies will travel to Fayette, Iowa for an 8:00 pm tilt with Upper Iowa. This will mark the NSIC opener for all three schools.

FOR THE RECORD: Following a pair of losses over the weekend, SCSU now sits at 3-2 after the non-conference season. Winona State enters the weekend with a 4-2 overall mark while Upper Iowa sits at 1-4.

SERIES HISTORY: The Huskies will meet the Warriors for the 120th time on Friday, with SCSU holding the all-time advantage at 86-34. The last time the two teams met, WSU was also coming off a National Title and they hosted SCSU in the first round of the 2007 NCAA Tournament, where they won 100-73, before finishing as national runner-up. SCSU and Upper Iowa will meet for just the ninth time, with the Huskies riding a seven game win streak in the series. Last season in Halenbeck Hall SCSU scored a 72-49 win.

START ON THE RIGHT FOOT: The Huskies will look to get a good start in the new conference. SCSU has won their last four conference openers, and in eight of 11 years under coach Schlagel have started the conference season 1-0. The Huskies last loss to open league play came in the 2003-04 season with a 79-85 home loss to North Dakota State.

MR. CONSISTENCY: For the fourth and fifth times of the season Matt Schneck hit double figures for scoring. On Nov. 28, he was part of a Husky quartet of double-digit scorers with 11 points, and on Nov. 29 he led the Huskies with 14 points as three players got to 10 or more.

DO YOU NEED MY ASSISTANCE: In the loss to Humboldt State on Nov. 28, SCSU tied a season high with 18 assists. They tied the mark set just a game earlier at St. John's and were lead by Taylor Witt and Brett Carmichael who each had five.

NOT SO FREE THROWS: The Huskies shot a season low four free throws against Chico State on Nov. 29, and made just one of them. Conversely Chico State went to the line 21 times, making 17 as they shot 81% for the game.

JUST GIVE IT AWAY: The Huskies had a combined 39 turnovers over the weekend that led to a combined 41 points for the opponent.

AND BARTZ HITS ANOTHER THREE: The Huskies nailed a season high 11 three-pointers in the loss to Humboldt State, and Spencer Bartz provided five of them. Bartz was a catalyst off the bench for SCSU, making 5-10 threes with four coming in the second half as SCSU played catch-up with the Lumberjacks. Bartz finished shooting 5-10 from behind the arc on his way to a career high 18 points.

ALMOST MADE IT: At the 3:42 mark of the second half against Humboldt State, Andrew Bernstetter grabbed his own rebound and got the quick put-back to give him 10 points and nine boards for the game. With nearly four minutes left on the clock it looked like Bernstetter may get his second career double-double. However that was not the case and he fouled out to finished just a rebound shy. It was the first game this season that SCSU did not have a player with 10+ rebounds.

NSIC RANKINGS: The Huskies still boast one of the better shooting teams in the NSIC as they ranked fifth in the league at 47% from the floor. SCSU also rests in the upper half of the league in scoring at sixth with 76 points per game and in scoring margin at +3.8 which is also sixth. Matt Schneck is fifth in the NSIC in field goal percentage at 59% and is sixth in rebounds at 7.2. Taylor Witt is eighth in assists with 3.40 per game and Andrew Bernstetter is fifth in blocked shots at 1.0 per game.

PLAYER NOTES

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Played two minutes against Humboldt State... played career high 18 minutes against Chico State and recorded first career points going 1-2 from the floor.

10 BRETT PUTZ: Tabbed six points off a pair of threes against Humboldt State while also grabbing two rebounds...played eight minutes and dished out one assist against Chico State.

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Came off the bench to have a career night against Humboldt State hitting 5-10 threes and 6-11 shots to net a career high 18 points while playing 22 minutes...did most of his damage in the second half as SCSU erased a 13 point deficit to tie the game...against Chico State chipped in three rebounds, two assists, two steals and one point.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Saw only action of the weekend late in the game against Chico State.

20 TAYLOR WITT: Had his second best game as a Husky with 19 points on 7-15 shooting as SCSU fell to Humboldt State...also tabbed a career high five assists to move into eighth place on the NSIC assists per game chart...despite not scoring the following night against host Chico State, still is second on the team and 14th in the NSIC at 13.8 points per game.

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Against Humboldt State went 1-3 from the three-point line to tally only three points of the game...the following day against Chico State went 2-8 from the floor to turn in four points along with three rebounds.

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAHATTAH: Scored four points, grabbed three rebounds and had two assists off the bench against Humboldt State...scored a career high 11 points a night later against Chico State while going 5-8 from the floor in 18 minutes.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Narrowly missed his second career double-double with 10 points and nine boards against Humboldt State...added three assists, a block and a steal to the effort...grabbed just three points against Chico State to go along with five rebounds...tallied a season high two blocks and currently ranks fifth in the NSIC at 1.0 block per game... is also 13th with 6.0 rebounds per game, and 11th with 2.20 offensive rebounds per game.

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Posted career high five assists against Humboldt State along with seven points and six rebounds...went 5-6 from the free throw line, missing his first of the season...tallied four points, three rebounds, and two steals against Chico State...is currently 12th in the NSIC in steals as 1.60 per game.

40 JESSE FISHER: Posted best performance of the season against Chico State, scoring 10 points and grabbing four boards in just 11 minutes on the floor...went 5-6 from the field to tie a SCSU season high for shooting percentage (.833).

42 CRAIG COENEN: Scored eight points against Humboldt State and grabbed three rebounds in 14 minutes...against Chico State played 11 minutes and tallied one assist.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Posted 11 points and six rebounds against Humboldt State...led the Huskies with 14 points against Chico State and added five rebounds...has now hit double figures in each game this season and in his last six games, the second best stretch of his career (10).

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Saw limited action over the weekend.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE WARRIORS: Winona State has been the talk of the NSIC of late, winning three straight league titles and two of the last three NCAA Division II championships. However, gone from those teams are a trio of seniors, a pair of All-Americans, and the DII player of the year. In 2008-09 the Warriors are led by junior David Johnson as he has put up 14.5 points per game so far on the season. After winning their opener, Winona State dropped back-to-back games on the road to BYU-Hawaii to fall to 1-2. Since however, WSU had won three straight including their last two in convincing fashion over Division III Augsburg (89-48) and Gustavus Adolphus (75-59). One of the better shooting teams in the league, WSU is currently hitting 49% from the field and 41% from behind the arc on their way the second best mark in the NSIC at 87.3 points per game. The Warriors are under the direction of 11th year head coach Mike Leaf who has assembled a 131-33 mark in his 10 seasons in Winona.

ABOUT THE PEACOCKS: At 1-4 the Peacocks got their first win of the season over the Holiday weekend with a 84-68 win over Bemidji State. With the opening of the conference season also comes the first chance for UIU to play a game at home. Upper Iowa began the season with three road games before playing two neutral site games in the inaugural NSIC Holiday Hoopsfest. Of the three road games to start the season, two were against Division I competition as UIU fell to UW-Milwaukee (59-87) and lost a close one to South Dakota State (65-69). In the recent win over Bemidji State Matt Lesan poured in 31 points to lead UIU past BSU. Upper Iowa shot better than 55% from the field and 40% from three-point range to earn the win. Head coach Brian Dolan leads the team in his third year at the helm and the Peacocks came into the season 12-44 under his guidance.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
