**BEEN AWAY TOO LONG:** For the first time in nearly a month the Huskies will return to Halenbeck Hall. After opening the season at the Hoopster Classic, SCSU took to the road for five straight games over three consecutive weekends. Now this weekend SCSU gets to host the first two of a five game home stand. In the first ever NSIC games in Halenbeck Hall, SCSU will host MSU Moorhead on Dec. 12 and Minnesota, Crookston on Dec. 13. Each game is slated for an 8:00 pm tip-off, at the conclusion of the women's 6:00 pm games.

**FOR THE RECORD:** After two wins on the road SCSU comes into the week with a 5-2 overall record and a 2-0 mark in the NSIC. MSU Moorhead split last weekend and sits at 2-3 overall and 1-1 in the NSIC while Minnesota, Crookston dropped both over the weekend and is 2-6 overall with an 0-2 league mark.

**SERIES HISTORY:** This may be the first matchup with the Dragons and Golden Eagles in the new conference, but Huskies have a long history with each school. MSU Moorhead is one of just five teams to tangle with St. Cloud State over 100 times at 113 since the 1932-33 season. In the series SCSU holds a 76-37 advantage, including a 2-0 mark last season. While not as lengthy, SCSU and UMC have met consistently since the series started in 1995-96. In 14 total meetings SCSU has dominated, winning all 14, including a 89-67 win last season.

**10-10-220:** After the wins over the weekend, head coach Kevin Schlagel now has 220 career wins as SCSU head coach.

**30 ROCK:** Josh Ortmann became the first Husky in almost a calendar year to hit the 30 point plateau. Against Winona State Ortmann scored a career high 30 points on the strength of 8-12 shooting from the floor, 5-8 from three-point range, and 9-10 from the free throw line. Also in the game he grabbed career highs with five rebounds and four steals while pitching in three assists. None of which were bigger than his pass to a streaking Matt Schneck in the lane for the winning basket in overtime. Ortmann is the first Husky to hit 30 points since David Dreas hit 31 on Jan. 26 last season.

**COMMON PLACE:** For the fifth straight season the Huskies won their conference opener and for the third straight season SCSU has opened conference play 2-0. SCSU will look to go 3-0 in the conference for the first time since 2001-03 when SCSU ran off five straight wins on their way to a 13-3 league record.

**NOT SO COMMON PLACE:** With the overtime game against Winona State, it marked the first extra session the Huskies had played since the

2006-07 season. They last time SCSU played in overtime was a 90-83 regular season ending loss to South Dakota on 2/24/07.

**HELPING HAND:** Against Winona State SCSU set a season high with 22 assists. Taylor Witt led the way with a career high nine in the game.

**NOTHIN' BUT NET:** After one weekend of league play the Huskies sit as the best three-point shooting team in the league at .535. SCSU made a season high 12 treys in the win over Upper Iowa. A tall test for the Huskies lies with Minnesota, Crookston who is currently tops in the NSIC in three-point percentage defense, holding their opponents to just a .174 clip from the arc.

**WEEKEND AT BERNIES:** Andrew Bernstetter was named NSIC player of the week after averaging 18.0 points and 8.5 rebounds while collecting nine assists and two blocks over the weekend. Against Winona State he tallied his second career double-double with 18 points and 10 rebounds, and he shot 13-17 from the field and 9-15 from behind the arc over the weekend. He is the second Husky this season, and the first sophomore since 2005-06 to earn player of the week honors.

**DOUBLE IT UP:** Matt Schneck scored in double figures in both games over the weekend to run his streak to eight straight games scoring 10+ dating back to last season. In 18 of his last 20 games, Schneck has hit double figures, with eight and nine point nights being the only aberrations. Taylor Witt has put together a similar streak, hitting double-digits in six of seven games this season.

**PARTY LIKE WE SCORED 99:** With 99 points in the win over Winona State, SCSU produced their highest point total since they also scored 99 in a win over Wayne State (Neb.) on 11/20/07. 99 has been a plateau for the Huskies of late as SCSU has not hit the century mark since the 2002-03 season when they scored 101 in a win over Macalester. Just seven times under Kevin Schlagel have the Huskies hit 100, with Minnesota, Crookston being the only team to suffer the tally twice.

**TOUGH TO BEAT:** Against Upper Iowa Craig Coenen was perfect. The senior was 1-1 from the field, nailing a three, and was 4-4 from the free throw line on his way to seven points.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.



**PLAYER NOTES**

**4 THEO ROTHSTEIN:** Played four minutes against Winona State and six minutes against Upper Iowa scoring career high three points.

**10 BRETT PUTZ:** Played one minute against Winona State and five minutes with one rebound and one assist against Upper Iowa.

**12 SPENCER BARTZ:** Did not play against Winona State and played four minutes against Upper Iowa.

**14 MICHAEL RILEY:** Did not see any action over the weekend.

**20 TAYLOR WITT:** In overtime win at Winona State scored 14 points, and dished out a career high nine assists while leading SCSU to their highest assist total of the season. Also tallied a career high with two blocks against the Warriors and posted SCSU's best day at the free throw line going 5-5. Against Upper Iowa, led all scorers with 19 points, with 12 coming in the second half as SCSU battled back from a halftime deficit.

**24 JOSH ORTMANN:** Had a breakout game while leading SCSU to the OT win over Winona State. Scored a career high 30 points, becoming the first Husky to do so since 1/26/08. Went 9-10 from the free throw line and 5-8 from three point range in the game. Also grabbed career high five rebounds and had three helpers, including the game winning assist to Matt Schneck for the winning basket in overtime. The following night scored 10 points to post the first back-to-back double-digit scoring games of his career.

**30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAHATTAH:** Played 10 minutes against Winona State scoring three points, and played eight minutes against Upper Iowa scoring two points with a career high three assists.

**32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER:** Named NSIC Player of the Week after he scored 18 points in each game for just the second back-to-back 10+ scoring games of his career. Against Winona State led the Huskies with 10 rebounds for his second career double-double while also adding a career high five assists. Against Upper Iowa, also was the team leader on the boards with seven in the game and four more assists. Went 9-15 from behind the arc over the weekend and is currently fourth in the NSIC in three-point percentage at .600.

**34 BRETT CARMICHAEL:** Scored a season high 14 points against Winona State while also grabbing a season high eight rebounds. Against Upper Iowa dished out four assists and collected three steals to go along with two points.

**40 JESSE FISHER:** Did not see any action against Winona State and played four minutes against Upper Iowa.

**42 CRAIG COENEN:** Scored four points, grabbed three rebounds, and tallied two assists against Winona State. Netted 11 points on a perfect day of shooting against Upper Iowa, going 1-1 with a three from the floor and 4-4 from the free throw line.

**50 MATT SCHNECK:** Scored 16 points and grabbed seven rebounds against Winona State. Scored the game-winning basket at the buzzer in overtime to give the Huskies the win. Scored 14 points the following night and added four rebounds and two steals in the win over Upper Iowa. Has hit double figures in every game this season.

**54 ROSS WINNEKINS:** Did not see any action over the weekend.

**OPPONENT INFO**

**ABOUT THE DRAGONS:** MSU Moorhead (2-3, 1-1) enters off a split in their NSIC opener. MSUM topped Bemidji State 71-67 on Dec. 5, before falling to Minnesota Duluth 48-68 on Dec. 6. The Dragons opened the season with a 73-60 win over crosstown rival, Division III Concordia College. Following the win MSUM dropped a pair of games at the NSIC Holiday HoopsFest to Wayne State (57-66) and Augustana (64-93). MSU Moorhead is coming off a season where they finished 14-14 and placed seventh in the NSIC with a 7-11 record. Early in 2008, the Dragons have been led by Justyn Burgess whose 16.6 points and 5.0 rebounds per game are each team bests. Grant Fossum and Andrew Van Havermaet round out the double digit scorers as each averages 10.8 points. Fossum and Van Havermaet lead MSUM from the free throw line as they have posted .880 and .889 marks respectively, leading MSUM to the fourth best team free throw percentage in the NSIC at .737.

**ABOUT THE GOLDEN EAGLES:** This will be the second visit to St. Cloud in the last month for Minnesota, Crookston (2-6, 0-2) as they opened the season at the Hoopster Classic on Nov. 15 & 16. Ironically, UMC has played equally as many games in Halenbeck hall this season as SCSU with two a piece. UMC dropped both games at the Hoopster Classic to start 0-2 before beating Minnesota-Morris (59-45) for their first win. The Golden Eagles best performance came two games later when they scored season high 82 points in an 82-63 win over Wartburg College of Iowa. Since however UMC has lost three straight, including home NSIC games to Minnesota Duluth (56-58) and Bemidji State (57-67). The only Golden Eagle to average double digits, Akeem Cubie has posted 10.9 points per game through eight games. Matt Pelzer leads the team in rebounding with 6.3 per game. Last season UMC finished 5-22 overall and last in the NSIC at 2-16.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
