### FOR RELEASE DEC. 15, 2008

**SLOW RIDE, TAKE IT EASY:** After three straight weekends of back-to-back games the Huskies slow it down a bit with just three games over the next three weeks. This week on Dec. 20, the Huskies return to the non-conference schedule as they host NAIA Dakota State in an 8:00 pm tilt in Halenbeck Hall. Although an official regular season game for SCSU, the game will count as an exhibition for Dakota State.

**FOR THE RECORD:** SCSU will enter the game with a 7-2 overall record and 4-0 mark in NSIC play while riding a four game winning streak. The Trojans sit at 5-8 overall and 0-2 in DAC play.

**SERIES HISTORY:** Saturdays game will mark the fourth meeting between the two schools with SCSU having won all three previous meetings. The last time came in the 2006-07 season, as a 79-39 SCSU victory.

**ONE OUT OF TWO AIN'T BAD:** Now at 4-0 in the NSIC, the Huskies are one of just two teams to make it out of the first two weekends with out a blemish. SCSU and travel partner Concordia currently sit atop the NSIC with identical records, and are heading for a clash of the unbeaten's on Jan. 3.

### STEALING RECORDS:

On Dec. 12 against MSUM, Brett Carmichael stole his way into the Husky record books. Carmichael tallied six steals against the Dragons which ties him with six others, including Spencer Bartz, David Dreas and Dusty Wabiszewski who all accomplished the feat last season. After the performance against MSUM, Carmichael sits as the league leader in steals.

**CAREER NIGHT FOR ROTHSTEIN:** First year forward Theo Rothstein had the best game of his young career against Minnesota, Crookston, setting career highs with 10 points, five rebounds, two assists, and a pair of steals. He also played a season high 22 minutes in the contest.

**I LOVE THE 90'S:** The Huskies scored over 90 points in each of their games over the weekend, and have topped 90 point mark in three of their four NSIC games. After the early part of the season the Huskies lead the NSIC in scor-

ing offense at 89.2 points per game. The high scoring has led to an average margin of victory of 15.0 points, which is also the NSIC's best. SCSU scored over 90 points just once last season. Under Kevin Schlagel, the most the Huskies have reached 90+ points is five times in a season.

**EVERYBODY'S DOING IT:** For the first time in the 2008-09 season SCSU had every player scored. Against Minnesota, Crookston on Dec. 13, every player in uniform scored at least three points. Included in the scoring was seven points from Michael Riley who the night before score his first points as a Husky

**STREAK STOPPED:** Matt Schneck had a run of nine consecutive games scoring in double-digits heading into the UMC game on Dec. 13. In 22 minutes against the Golden Eagles Schneck was 2-4 from the field and 5-6 from the line to finish with nine points, stopping the streak one game shy of tying his personal record set last season.

**PERFECTION:** For the second time in as many weeks the Huskies had a player finish the night shooting perfect. Against UMC, in just 11 minutes of play, Jesse Fisher went 4-4 from the floor and 1-1 from the line for nine points, his second highest mark of the season.

### APPARENTLY YOU JUST RUN FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME:

After seeing MSUM stretch the lead to their biggest of the game at 11 points, SCSU put together a 31-9 run to close the first half and open the second, turning the 11-point deficit into an 11-point lead that the Huskies would not lose. The next night SCSU used a 23-4 run into and out of halftime that turned a seven-point SCSU lead into an insurmountable 26-point advantage.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** Matt Schneck leads the conference (NSIC games) in offensive rebounds with 3.5 per game, and Andrew Bernstetter in currently tops the league in three-pointers made with 3.50 per game. SCSU also boast three of the leagues top-10 scorers with Taylor Witt (16.5) in fourth, Bernstetter (15.8) at sixth, and Schneck (14.8) in ninth.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

**PLAYER NOTES**

**4 THEO ROTHSTEIN:** Scored six points, pulled down one rebound and had one steal against MSU Moorhead before having a career game against Minnesota, Crookston. Posted career highs against UMC with 22 minutes, 10 points, five boards, and two assists and two steals. Was one of three players in double figures.

**10 BRETT PUTZ:** Scored seven points with one assist and one rebound against MSU Moorhead and scored six points against Minnesota, Crookston off of back-to-back threes to jump-start the Huskies in the second half.

**12 SPENCER BARTZ:** Scored two points against MSU Moorhead with one huge block of the Dragons 7-0 post. Added three points, two assist and a steal against Minnesota, Crookston.

**14 MICHAEL RILEY:** Scored his first career points as a Husky with two against MSU Moorhead, before bettering the total with seven against Minnesota, Crookston as well as one rebound and one steal.

**20 TAYLOR WITT:** Led the Huskies against MSU Moorhead with 21 points, topping the 20-point plateau for the second time of the season while adding a game high six assists. Made it four straight in double figures (tying a career high) with 12 against Minnesota, Crookston, and four more assists. Currently fourth in the NSIC in scoring and assists.

**24 JOSH ORTMANN:** Scored seven points with three rebounds and two assists against MSU Moorhead and came back with six points, two assists and two more steals against Minnesota, Crookston. Currently fourth in the NSIC in steals.

**30 MAHMOUD ABDEL FATTAH:** Against MSU Moorhead, was held scoreless for the first time since the season opener, but came back with six points, four rebounds and a game and career high five assists against Minnesota, Crookston.

**32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER:** Has now scored in double figures in a career long four straight games after posting 13 against MSU Moorhead and a team high 14 against Minnesota Crookston. Also added 11 total rebounds and seven total steals over the weekend. Currently leads the NSIC in three-pointers made, is fourth in offensive rebounds, sixth in scoring and steals, seventh in rebounds, and eighth in three-point percentage.

**34 BRETT CARMICHAEL:** Against MSU Moorhead tied the SCSU record with six steals in the contest to go along with four points, three rebounds and three assists. Scored four points again versus Minnesota, Crookston with two rebounds, two assists, and two more steals. Currently the NSIC leader in steals.

**40 JESSE FISHER:** Scored six points with two boards and one block against MSU Moorhead before a perfect shooting day against Minnesota, Crookston. Against UMC went 4-of-4 from the floor and 1-of-1 from the line for nine points.

**42 CRAIG COENEN:** Against MSU Moorhead, scored four points with one rebound and one assist. Scored five points with three boards against Minnesota, Crookston.

**50 MATT SCHNECK:** Charted third double-double of the season with 20 points and an SCSU season high 11 rebounds on the strength of 7-of-9 shooting from the floor and 6-of-9 from the line. Against Minnesota, Crookston, finished with nine points and six rebounds. Currently the NSIC leader in offensive rebounds leading SCSU the a second place tally as a team in the category. Ninth in the NSIC in scoring and seventh in rebounds.

**54 ROSS WINNEKINS:** Did not see any action over the weekend.

**OPPONENT INFO**

**ABOUT THE TROJANS:** Dakota State University out of Madison S.D. enters the week with a 5-8 overall record and a 0-2 mark in Dakota Athletic Conference (DAC) play. DSU will play one more time before they meet the Huskies, hosting the University of Sioux Falls (S.D.) on Dec. 16. Tabbed for an eighth place conference finish in the preseason, the Trojans dropped their opener before ripping off three straight wins in early November. However since Nov. 15, DSU has went just 2-7, including a five game losing skid before winning last Saturday 86-78 over Peru State. In an exhibition contest against the NSIC's Augustana, the Trojans fell 51-103. DSU averages 72.6 points per game while giving up and average of 77.5. A pair of Trojans currently average double figures for scoring with Sean Baitinger leading with 12.0 ppg followed by Derek Kreutzfeldt at 10.2 ppg. Baitinger also leads from behind the arc making good on 35% (9-26) of his three point attempts and has topped the 20 point mark twice this season. Big man Bryce Snyder leads all players from the floor at .486.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
