TO NEW BEGINNINGS: The Huskies close out the non-conference season and 2008 before opening 2009 with the rest of the NSIC season. On Dec. 30 at 6:00 pm the Huskies return from their 10-day break to host St. Mary's University in their final non-conference match-up. A little time off to celebrate the New Year and SCSU then returns to NSIC play against Concordia University on Jan. 3 at 4:00 pm. Each game will take place in Halenbeck Hall, and follow the women's games two hours prior.

FOR THE RECORD: The Huskies enter the week with a 8-2 overall record and a 4-0 mark in the NSIC. St. Mary's counters with a 2-6 overall tally and 1-3 record in MIAC play. Concordia meanwhile, sits at 6-4 on the season and also stands at 4-0 in the NSIC.

SERIES HISTORY: St. Cloud State and St. Mary's have met just one time previously, way back in the 1932-33 season, resulting in a 38-35 SCSU win. Concordia though, has met up with St. Cloud State 10 times, including twice last season. In Halenbeck Hall, SCSU won 72-57, while CU turned the tides in St. Paul to win 61-57.

10-FOOT HIGH STEEL CAGE: It will be a last man standing match when St. Cloud State hosts Concordia on Jan. 3. Only one unbeaten team will be left when its all said and done, and have the early led in the battle for the conference title.

FLASH POINT: It may have looked like the points were coming in a flash to Dakota State as the Huskies hung 120 points on them on Dec. 20. SCSU had not topped the century mark since a 101 performance in a win over Macalester College in the 2002-03 season. Macalester was also on the losing end of the Huskies single game scoring record, a 144-74 win to start the 1990-91 season. The most SCSU has put up in the Kevin Schlagel era is 121 in a 122-121 OT loss early in the 1998-99 season to an Augsburg squad led by current NBA star Devean George.

YOU'RE THE BEST, AROUND: The 120 points were an NSIC best for the season, and one of several season highs the Huskies set. The 21 threes and 43 attempts were each better than the 17-of-36 U-Mary put up in November while the 32 assists tied the season high Minnesota

State set just a day earlier. Also the Huskies 43 field goals made are second best, behind MSU from the same game a day earlier.

EVERYBODY'S STILL DOING IT: Against UMC, the Huskies had each player in uniform score, and for the second straight game the Huskies accomplished the feat. Against Dakota State each player finished with at least two points led by a season high seven players in double figures.

THREE AMIGOS: Josh Ortmann, Matt Schneck and Taylor Witt each finished with 17 points to lead the Huskies. This was the first game of the season where at least three players had over 15 points each.

THREE FOR ALL: The Huskies set a school record and posted the second best mark in DII this season with 21 three-pointers against Dakota State. Only the 22 threes put up by Georgia State on 12/8 better the Huskies this season. The Huskies had 11 threes by halftime and cruised past the old record of 15 set three times. Most recently SCSU put up 15 in a 92-90 win at North Dakota on Jan. 4, 2007. Taylor Witt and Josh Ortmann led the way with five threes each.

HELP, I NEED SOMEBODY, HELP: The Huskies dished out a season high 32 assists against Dakota State, 10 better than the 22 SCSU put up against Winona State on 12/5. Taylor Witt led the way against Dakota State with his eight helpers. The best single game assist performance by St. Cloud State came on 12/29/99 with 33 against Bemidji State. For the first time this season, every player in uniform had an assist.

61 AND DONE: The 61 first half points by the Huskies were a new season high for points in half. In the second, SCSU came back with 59, which tied the previous season high.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

PLAYER NOTES

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Had second consecutive career game. Scored 10 points, pulled down six boards, dished out four assists and grabbed three steals. Also went 4-of-4 from the free throw line. One of a season high seven players in double figures.

10 BRETT PUTZ: Scored a career high 14 points, making four three-pointers in the process. Put up a SCSU season high 14 three-point shots. Also had four rebounds, three assists, and two steals.

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Helped the Huskies to the three-point record by going 4-5 from behind the arc for 12 points, second best mark of the season. Also had two assists and one rebound.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Went 2-5 from behind the arc to finish with six points, just missing a career high. Also handed out a pair of assists and had one steal, playing a season high 15 minutes.

20 TAYLOR WITT: One of a trio of players to lead the way with 17 points, hitting double figures for a career high fifth straight game. Just missed a career high, finishing with a game high eight rebounds. Went a season best .714 (5-of-7) from behind the arc. Also had two rebounds and a steal. Fifth in the NSIC in scoring (15.2), third in assists (4.60), fifth in three-point percentage (.479) and three-pointers made (2.30).

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Had second best scoring day of the season, finishing among the trio of 17-point scorers. Led the way from three-point land hitting 5-of-6 shots on his way to a 6-of-7 (.857) day, which stands as the best single game for the Huskies this season. Finished with three assists, two rebounds, and two steals.

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAHATTAH: Did not play against Dakota State.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Tied a career high and posted a game high with 10 rebounds, including a season high seven defensive rebounds. Also chipped in seven points and two assists in 18 minutes of play. Fifth in the NSIC in offensive rebounds (2.40), eighth in three-pointers made (2.10), ninth in rebounding (6.8) and blocked shots (0.80).

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Scored two points to go along with four rebounds, three assists and one steal. Third in the NSIC in steals (2.20).

40 JESSE FISHER: Posted season highs with 12 points and five rebounds. Went 4-of-5 from the floor and 4-of-6 from the free throw line. Also had three steals, two assists and one block.

42 CRAIG COENEN: Scored six points on 1-of-3 shooting and a perfect 4-of-4 from the free throw line. Also finished with three rebounds and two assists.

50 MATT SCHNECK: One of three players to post a game high 17 points, his third highest total of the season, and did so on 8-of-12 shooting. Grabbed seven rebounds and added one assist, one block and one steal. Second in the NSIC in field goal percentage (.604), sixth in rebounding (7.1), seventh in offensive (2.20) and defensive rebounds (4.90), 10th in scoring (14.7).

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Did not play against Dakota State.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: Led by first year head coach Todd Landrum, St. Mary's will be taking the court for the first time in 20 days. Their last game action came on 12/10 in the form of a 64-102 home loss to MIAC rival St. Thomas. At 2-6 overall, the Cardinals have lost three straight with their last win coming on 12/3, 67-65 over a winless Macalester College. The Cardinals average near 66 points per game while allowing over 82 ppg for an average scoring margin of nearly -17 ppg. Their scoring offense ranks 10th in the MIAC while their scoring defense ranks 11th. SMU is being out shot .496-to-.415 from the field and .367-to-.274 from behind the arc. Cardinal opponents also hold a small advantage on the boards at just over four rebounds per game. Sophomore Will Wright leads SMU in scoring at 21.3 ppg and ranks second in the MIAC in scoring for all games and league games. Fellow sophomore Lukas Holland is fifth in the league in scoring at 16.3 ppg.

ABOUT THE GOLDEN BEARS: This may sound familiar. After dropping a pair of games in California over Thanksgiving weekend, they have reeled off five straight victories, including four in NSIC play to sit atop the league standings at 4-0. SCSU's travel partner, CU went 4-0 to open the NSIC against the same four teams as the Huskies. Most recently on 12/18, the Golden Bears struggled to beat Northwestern College, eventually coming away with the 88-84 OT win. CU need a last second three-pointer from leading scorer Craig Heiman to force the extra session. After four conference games, Heiman is second in the NSIC at 17.0 ppg. Earlier in the Northwestern game, the Golden Bear junior scored his 1,000th career point. He is also the leading rebounder for CU, averaging 6.8 a game. Heiman has scored in double figures in each game this season and topped 20 twice. Sammy Ricks, Matt Caldwell, and Mike Cunningham have each also topped 20 points at one point during the season.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
