SNAP BACK TO REALITY: The conference season resumes in full this weekend with a pair of games, and continues on the Friday-Saturday schedule until the season ends in late February. The Huskies will hit the road this weekend, for the first time in nearly a month, on Jan. 9 when they travel to the University of Minnesota Duluth, before heading to Bemidji State University on Jan 10. Each game is slated for an 8:00 pm start, and will follow the women's games which start at 6:00 pm.

FOR THE RECORD: After winning a pair of games last week, SCSU enters this week at 10-2 overall and 5-0 in the NSIC. Minnesota Duluth resides just behind the Huskies in the league standings at 5-1, and are 11-5 overall. Bemidji State enters with a 3-9 overall mark and a 2-4 record in the NSIC.

SERIES HISTORY: This week the Huskies match up with a pair of their oldest foes. SCSU and Minnesota Duluth began playing in the 1932-33 season and have since matched up 74 times. After sweeping UMD last season, SCSU has won 11 straight in the series and holds the 44-29 all-time advantage. A year after the Huskies began playing basketball, they began playing Bemidji State. Since the 1923-24 season, SCSU and BSU have tangled 124 times. Last season SCSU won to make it 13 straight in the series and hold a 87-37 lead in the series.

COULD YOU EARMUFF IT FOR ME: Don't look now, but the Huskies are alone in first place after the win over Concordia, SCSU stands as the last unbeaten team in conference play with a 5-0 record. With a 10-2 overall record, the Huskies are one of just three teams to win over 80% of their games. The others (Minnesota State and Northern State) can be found among the Top-25.

PETE AND REPEAT WERE IN A BOAT, PETE FELL OUT, WHO WAS LEFT: The Huskies will be looking for a repeat when they take on UMD this weekend. After knocking off the only other unbeaten team, the Huskies will be challenged again in their very next game. Minnesota Duluth boasts a 5-1 league mark, and is alone in second place.

HOT 100: Senior Craig Coenen has now played in 99 career games after last weekend, and will play in his 100th career game coming up this weekend. At 108 games, Coenen will break into the top-20 on the SCSU all-time charts.

SWEET 16: In their win over Concordia, the Huskies held the Golden Bears to just 16 first half points, the lowest opponent total for a half this season. The Huskies held CU to just seven field goals in the period on 24 shots as the Golden Bears shot less than 30% for the half. By the end of the game SCSU had given up just 46 points, on 32.3% shooting, for their best defensive performance of the season.

YOU'RE KILLIN' ME SMALLS: He may not be the biggest guy on the floor, but Brett Putz has been playing big and hurting opponents of late. Putz has scored in double figures in the last three games, including a career night with 18 points and six rebounds in the win over CU. Putz played 18 minutes and nailed 4-5 threes to help move SCSU into sole possession of first place.

CONFERENCE CONFIDENCE: With their 5-0 conference record, SCSU has matched their best start to a conference season under Kevin Schlagel. In the 2002-03 season, the Huskies began the NCC season 5-0 on their way to a regular season title and NCC Tournament Championship. The SCSU record came in the 85-86 season when the Huskies went 14-0 to start league play before also winning a conference championship.

UP THROUGH THE QUAD AND INTO THE GYMNASIUM: Yes that's right, the Huskies are streaking. Winners of seven straight, SCSU has not lost since their trip to California in late November. A 6-0 December has carried over to a 1-0 start to January. Most recently the Huskies won nine in a row to start last season.

NSIC PLAYER OF THE WEEK: After averaging a double-double with 20.5 point and 10.5 rebounds while shooting 68% from the field, the Huskies Matt Schneck earned his second player of the week honor. His four double-doubles are a career high for a season and tied for the NSIC lead.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.



PLAYER NOTES

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Scored four points with three rebounds and tied a career high with three steals against St. Mary's. Added two points and one board against Concordia.

10 BRETT PUTZ: Hit double figures with 10 points against St. Mary's. Had career night against CU with 18 points and six rebounds while shooting 7-of-10 from the floor and 4-of-5 from three-point range to finish as the games second leading scorer. Has hit double figures in three straight games and currently leads the NSIC (conf. games only) in three-point percentage (.600).

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Earned first start of his career against St. Mary's and played 15 minutes with two points and two steals. Played eight minutes against Concordia.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Tallied one assist and one steal against St. Mary's. Finished with two rebounds against Concordia.

20 TAYLOR WITT: Finished with three points and six assists against St. Mary's. Tallied another three points to go along with eight more assists and two steals against Concordia. Currently second in the NSIC (conf. games only) in assists per game (5.80), and ninth in assist/turnover ratio (1.26).

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Finished with 10 points, two rebounds, two assists, and two steals against St. Mary's. Tallied one assist against Concordia. In NSIC games, ranked fourth in steals (1.80).

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAH: Finished with two points, three assists, two steals, one rebound, and his first career block against St. Mary's. Tallied two steals and one rebound against Concordia.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Scored seven points and pulled down seven boards against St. Mary's. Scored 10 points with four rebounds and two steals including 2-of-3 from behind the arc and 2-of-2 from the stripe against Concordia. In NSIC games, ranks second in three-point field goals made (3.20), fourth in steals (1.80), fifth in offensive rebounds (2.40), sixth in three-point percentage (.516), eighth in scoring (14.6), and ninth in rebounds (6.4).

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Did not play against St. Mary's. Returned to the court against Concordia and grabbed five rebounds with one assist, one rebound, one block and one steal. Ranks second in the NSIC in steals (2.80).

40 JESSE FISHER: Scored season high 13 points, including a 4-of-4 mark at the line and pulled in six boards while adding a SCSU season high four blocks against St. Mary's. Also provided the highlight of the night with buzzer beating full court shot at the end of the first half. Scored three points and grabbed seven rebounds against Concordia.

42 CRAIG COENEN: Scored eight points with four rebounds against St. Mary's. Scored four points with one rebound against Concordia. Should play in his 100th career game against Minnesota Duluth.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Named NSIC player of the Week. Scored a game high 17 points with seven rebounds and two blocks against St. Mary's. Had best game of the season with 24 points and 14 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the season. Shot 68% over the weekend. In NSIC games only, ranks first in field goal % (.625), second in offensive rebounds (3.80), second in scoring (15.2) third in rebounds (8.4), and ninth in defensive rebounds (4.60).

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Returned to the line-up against St. Mary's and played 16 minutes with six points and a team-high eight rebounds. Scored two points with one rebound against Concordia.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE BULLDOGS: After winning three straight last week, including two in the conference, Minnesota Duluth sits in second place in the league standings. A much improved squad, UMD has already won more games this season (11) than they did all of last season (9), while more than doubling their conference win total (5 vs. 2). The biggest win of the season may have been their latest, a 62-59 upset on the road over #24 Augustana. Now UMD returns home to Romano Gym where they are 3-1 on the season. The Bulldogs have been paced all season by the forward-center combo of Brian Sykora and John Vaudreuil. At 6-7 and 6-8 respectively, each is averaging near 15 points and have posted four double-doubles this season. In addition Sykora is one of the most accurate free throw shooters in the NSIC, making good on better than 93% of his attempts. 7-2 in their last nine games, the Bulldogs suffered their only conference loss to defending champion Winona State, and a nonconference loss to Division I South Dakota.

ABOUT THE BEAVERS: After splitting on each of the first two weekends on the conference season, Bemidji State fell twice last week and has lost three straight. Their last win came on 12/18 over Jamestown (61-50) and their last NSIC win came on 12/13 over Upper Iowa (75-70). The Beavers have been road warriors this season, and will be home for just the sixth time on the season when the host SCSU. BSU is 1-3 on their home court. Seth Haake and Jake Lindstrom lead the Beavers in scoring with 10.3 and 10.1 points per game respectively. However it was Patrick Cassidy who was the top scorer in their last two games, with 25 on 1/2 and 13 on 1/3. Sergej Baskov leads the way on the boards with 5.2 rebounds per game. Despite being in the upper half of the league in scoring offense, Bemidji State is being out-scored by 8.0 points per game. They are also being out-rebounded by nearly seven rebounds per game.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
