### FOR RELEASE JAN. 12, 2009

**HALENBECKONING:** After a week away, the Huskies return to the friendly confines of Halenbeck Hall where they are unbeaten (7-0) this season. Though the coming week will provide their biggest test yet. On Jan. 16, the Huskies host Southwest Minnesota at 8:00 pm in the first of four straight home games. The following night they return to host sixth ranked Minnesota State, also at 8:00 pm.

**FOR THE RECORD:** After losing twice last weekend, St. Cloud State falls to 10-4 on the season and 5-2 in the NSIC. Southwest Minnesota and Minnesota State each split over the weekend leaving SMSU at 11-5 overall and 4-3 in the conference, and MSU at 14-3 on the season with a 5-2 mark in league play.

**SERIES HISTORY:** In the short history of Southwest Minnesota, the Mustangs have matched up with St. Cloud State 45 times since the 1969-70 season. While SCSU leads 31-14 all-time, SMSU got the best last season with an 82-68 victory. Since the 1923-23 season, St. Cloud State has played Minnesota State, 163 times, more than any other team. While SCSU leads in the series 88-75, MSU has been closing the gap of late, winning the last six.

**MAMA I'M COMIN' HOME:** It will be a welcome site to return to Halenbeck Hall for the Huskies as they are 7-0 on their home floor this season. The Huskies average 87.6 points and have won by an average margin of 25.3 in their seven home contests. The closest games the Huskies played came at the Hoopster Classic with 11 and 12 point victories to open the season.

**GET IN THE CAR FRANK:** No more Streaking for the Huskies. Their seven-game winning streak was not the only streak broken over the weekend. SCSU had their 11 game win streak against Minnesota Duluth and 13 game streak against Bemidji State broken as well. The Huskies had not lost to the Bulldogs since a 60-65 setback in the 1994-95 season. A year earlier was the last time the Beavers earned a victory over the Huskies, with a 91-107 win in the 1993-94 season.

**IF YOU START ME UP I'LL NEVER STOP:** First year guard Brett Putz responded well to his first career start, putting up 16 points and finishing in double figures for the fifth straight game. His streak of double-digit scoring is the longest active on the team, and tied for the second best such mark for the Huskies this season.

**PERFECT 10:** Also over the weekend, Putz went a perfect 10-for-10 at the free throw line. He was 6-for-6 against UMD and 4-for-4 the following night against BSU. With the performance he improves his team leading free throw percentage to .875.

**CENTURY CLUB:** Craig Coenen reached a milestone over the weekend, playing in his 100th game as a Husky against Minnesota Duluth. A night later, Coenen was in the starting line-up, and reached yet another milestone, as he grabbed a career high 11 rebounds.

**BERNIES BIG DAY:** Andrew Bernstetter had maybe his best game of the season against Bemidji State. He posted 18 points against the Beavers which is one off a career high and ties a season high. In addition he pulled down a career high 14 rebounds for his third double-double of the season. The 14 boards tie the SCSU season high.

**THREE IS NOT THE CHARM:** For the second time this season the Huskies have lost back-to-back games, and for the second time they will look to respond with a win. SCSU lost three straight to close last season, with the last being in the first round of the NCC tournament. The Huskies have not lost three straight in the regular season since midway through the 2003-04 season.

**6-1:** The Huskies were 6-0 on the season when someone recorded a double-double heading into the weekend. After losing to BSU when Bernstetter posted 18 points and 14 boards, the Huskies fell to 6-1 in games where someone recorded a double-double.

**THAT'S RANK:** For the first time all season the Huskies found themselves on the national rankings. When the first poll of the new year was released, SCSU came in at #24, after not even receiving a vote in any of the previous polls. At 10-2, the Huskies ranked for the first time in almost a year, with the last time being Jan. 15, 2008.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Played 16 minutes against UMD and tallied four points. Played four minutes against BSU.

10 BRETT PUTZ: Came off the bench to lead the Huskies with a career high 19 points against UMD. Started first career game against BSU and scored 16 points. Went 10-for-10 from the line over the weekend and currently leads the Huskies in free throw percentage. Also nailed seven three's in the two games and is ninth in the NSIC in three point percentage and three-pointers made. Scored 100th career point against BSU.

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Went 2-for-2 from behind the arc and finished with eight points against UMD. Played four minutes against BSU.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Did not play over the weekend.

20 TAYLOR WITT: Scored two points with four rebounds and two assists against UMD. Tallied 21 points for his second highest total of the season against BSU and six assists. Hit double figures for the first time in the last four games. Sixth time in the last nine games with six or more assists. Second in the NSIC in assists, sixth in steals, ninth in assist/turnover ratio, and 15th in scoring.

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Was held scoreless in back-to-back games for the first time this season. Grabbed one rebounds against UMD and two rebounds and one assist against BSU.

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAH: Played eight minutes with two points and three rebounds against UMD. Both points came off free throws, and has made eight of his last nine free throw attempts. Did not play against BSU.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Scored six points with two rebounds against UMD. Recorded third double-double of the season with 18 point and a career high 14 rebounds against BSU. 14 rebounds ties an SCSU season high. First loss for SCSU when he records a double-double. Third in the NSIC in three-pointers made, fifth in offensive rebounds, ninth in rebounding, and steals, 10th in defensive rebounds and 15th in scoring.

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Tallied two points and two rebounds against UMD. Scored four points with two rebounds, two assists and three steals against BSU. Second in the NSIC in steals.

40 JESSE FISHER: Scored five points with five rebounds against UMD. Scored five points with six rebounds against UMD.

42 CRAIG COENEN: Scored four points with two rebounds while playing in his 100th career game against UMD. Started first game of the season against BSU and played 32 minutes to tally a career high 11 rebounds to go along with two points.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Scored six points and pulled down four points in against UMD. Did not play against BSU.

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Finished with six point and four rebounds against UMD. Played three minutes against BSU.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE MUSTANGS: Southwest Minnesota started the season by going 3-0 at the Disney West Coast Classic - including a win over then #24 For Lewis in the title game - to earn Disney Champion Honors. The Mustangs then went on to beat Division I North Dakota and jump into the top-25 at #19. After a 1-1 showing at the NSIC Holiday HoopsFest SMSU fell to #24, and a subsequent 1-1 week dropped the Mustangs out of the rankings entirely. A narrow one-point victory on the road over the University of Sioux Falls has now led to 4-1 mark in their last five games, losing only to Winona State on 1/9. SMSU responded to the Friday night loss to WSU, with a huge 80-57 win over Upper Iowa on 1/10. At 4-3 in NSIC play, the Mustangs sit in a tie for seventh place, behind the log-jam of 5-2 teams in third place. Jon DeRock has only started in two games this season, but leads SMSU in scoring at 10.5 points per game, and in the only player to average double figures. Ross DeMasi leads the Mustangs and the NSIC in rebounding with 10.3 per game. Four times this season, DeMasi had recorded a double-double, including three occasions where he has pulled down 16 boards. Last season, Southwest Minnesota when 17-12 and 11-7 in the NSIC to finish in third place, but were on the outside looking in when the regional selections came. They ended their season with a 70-74 loss to Northern State in the semifinals of the NSIC tournament.

ABOUT THE MAVERICKS: Minnesota State enters the week as the #6 ranked team in the country. MSU won or tied the final three NCC championships and was the preseason NSIC favorite this season. Most recently they had their five-game winning streak stopped at the hands of the defending champion Winona State Warriors, 85-100. MSU held a one-point lead at halftime, but WSU took the lead for good with 13:29 left to play in the second half. The Mavericks win streak began after a 69-79 loss to Northern State, and before the setback, MSU had strung together nine straight wins after a season opening loss. The Mavericks began the season with a preseason ranking of eight, and have been in the top-10 ever since. The Mavericks are led by their front court who all average in double figures, led by Jake Morrow at 17.1 points per game. Morrow along with Mitch Gosson and Travis Nelson combine to score 41.6 points per game, which is 47% of the Maverick offense. Morrow was first team All-NCC last season while Gosson earned Honorable Mention accolades. MSU will be looking for a return to the postseason this winter as well. Last season they fell in the first round of the regional, but two seasons ago they were in the regional championship game. MSU is 4-2 away from Taylor Center this season and will be on the road for the first time since their loss to NSU on 12/13. Minnesota State is outscoring their opponents by more than 18 points per game and hold a +7 advantage on the boards.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
