DON'T GO CHANGIN': Despite a stumble against Southwest Minnesota, St. Cloud State showed just how tough they can be at home with their win over #9 Minnesota State. And they will need to be just as tough again as two red hot teams enter Halenbeck Hall this weekend. On Jan. 23 the Huskies host the University of Mary Marauders, and on Jan. 24, the 16th ranked Northern State University Wolves visit Halenbeck Hall. Each tip-off is set for 8:00 pm.

FOR THE RECORD: After splitting last weekend the Huskies now stand with an 11-5 overall record and a 6-3 mark in the NSIC. Friday's opponent U-Mary, enters the game with a 5-11 tally and 3-6 record in the NSIC. Northern State begins the week tied with SCSU at 6-3 in the conference and boasts a 13-3 record overall.

SERIES HISTORY: The Huskies and Marauders have only matched up three times before, and have alternated victories each time. U-Mary holds the 2-1 advantage and won the first meeting two seasons ago. Last season the teams split, with each winning at home. Northern State and St. Cloud State have met 26 times before, but none since the 2001-02 season. SCSU holds a 17-9 lead, and won in the two latest meetings.

AGAINST THE BEST: After one game against a ranked opponent in 2008-09 the Huskies sit at 1-0. SCSU will not have to wait long for another chance as 16th ranked Northern State visits St. Cloud. Last season SCSU was 1-2 against ranked competition.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: With the win over Minnesota State it marked the first such occurrence since the 2005-06 season. The Huskies had lost six straight to the Mavericks, including two by an average score of 73.5-91.5 last season.

DICK ENRICO WOULD BE PROUD: The Huskies definitely showed their second wind on Saturday night. After MSU scored the final six points of the first half and opened their lead up to as much as 11 in the second half, SCSU put together an 18 minute stretch of basketball that saw them regroup and out-score the Mavericks 51-34. Down the stretch, the Huskies made 5-of-6 free throws to seal the win.

DOING THE SPLITS: For the first time this season the Huskies split a weekend series. Every previous weekend had resulted in two wins of two losses for SCSU. Also with the loss to Southwest Minnesota on Jan. 16 it marked

the first three-losing streak in the regular season since the 2003-04 season.

GET OFF MY LAWN: The Huskies have been able to defend their home turf this season and with an 8-1 record in Halenbeck Hall they have the second best home mark in the NSIC. Only Minnesota State at 10-1 can claim a better record at home this season. Last season the Huskies went 12-3 in Halenbeck.

BRETT PUTZ IT IN THE NET: First year Brett Putz went 4-of-4 at the free throw line over the weekend and extended his streak to 14 straight attempts without a miss. The last miss for Putz came on Dec. 30, late in the game against St. Mary's, in his final attempt. Putz has recorded at least two free throws in the last four games.

COENEN THE BARBARIAN: Senior Craig Coenen had a career night, and was a major factor in the Huskies win over the Mavericks. Coenen played 34 minutes and scored a career high 16 points as well as pulled down 10 boards for his first career double-double.

BERNSTETTER DOES IT AGAIN: Along with Coenen, Andrew Bernstetter posted a double-double against the Mavericks with his 12 points and 10 rebounds. The fourth double-double of the season for Bernstetter, he is one of just seven NSIC players to have four or more. The Huskies are 3-1 when Bernstetter records a double-double.

CONFERENCE STANDINGS: The Huskies began last week tied for third in the NSIC, but after going 1-1 on the weekend, SCSU sits tied in fourth this week. St. Cloud State is tied with Northern State, Minnesota State and Southwest Minnesota. Augustana won twice last weekend to jump from fourth to first.

THREE'S A CROWD: After being held scoreless in three straight games, Josh Ortmann responded in a big way over the weekend. First against Southwest Minnesota he broke out of the slump with an eight point performance, and then in the big win over Minnesota State, Ortmann was of the Huskies leading scorers as he tallied 16 points, including nine in the second half during the comeback.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

PLAYER NOTES

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Played 23 minutes against SMSU and scored nine points, his best since Dec. 20. Scored two points against MSU.

10 BRETT PUTZ: Scored six points against SMSU to snap streak of five straight games in double figures. Scored 11 points against MSU, including the games final two free throws and led the team with three three-pointers made.

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Scored six points and grabbed a career high four rebounds against SMSU. Did not score against MSU.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Tied a career high with two assists against SMSU.

20 TAYLOR WITT: Led the way for the Huskies with 11 points against SMSU. Again led in scoring with 19 against MSU as well as a career high six rebounds and a career high-tying nine assists. Score seven straight points and nine total over the final 3:48 to give SCSU the win. Out-scored MSU 9-8 over the span.

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Scored eight points against SMSU, and doubled the total the following night with 16 in 28 minutes against MSU. Took team high 14 field goals in the game.

30 MAHMOUD ABDEFATTAH: Scored three points against SMSU.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Scored eight points and had a season high four blocks against SMSU. Tallied fourth double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds against MSU. The only player to score in every game this season.

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Scored eight points and pulled down seven rebounds against SMSU, and scored seven points with two boards, two assists and two steals against MSU.

40 JESSE FISHER: Scored nine points and just missed a season high with six rebounds against SMSU. Earned first start of the season against MSU.

42 CRAIG COENEN: Pulled down five rebounds against SMSU. Played a season high 34 minutes against MSU and had a career night. Scored career high 16 points and grabbed 10 rebounds for his first career double-double.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Did not play over the weekend.

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Did not play over the weekend.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE MARAUDERS: The University of Mary was one of just three teams to win twice last weekend and did so in impressive fashion. The weekend began with an 80-77 overtime win over Minnesota Duluth, who entered the game alone atop the conference standings. The Marauders then backed it up by knocking off Bemidji State, 80-76, who entered the game riding a four game win streak and had just beaten 11th ranked Northern State the night before. At 15.7 points per game, senior guard Geoff West leads U-Mary in scoring. In 11 games this season West has led the Marauders in scoring, including the last five. He contributed 21 and 19 respectively to the two wins last weekend, but also has 27 and 34 point efforts this season. He is also the leading three-point threat for the Marauders, hitting 40 on the season for a .408 clip from behind the arc. Joining west atop the U-Mary scoring charts are forward Eric Erdmann and guard Jordan Wilhelm who average 9.2 and 8.9 points respectively. UM's leading rebounder is Danny Sandvig at 4.8 per game. The U-Mary offense averages 68.0 points per game while they are allowing 74.8 for an average scoring margin of -6.8. From the field, the Marauders are shooting .430 and allowing their opponents to shoot .508. UM does hold the advantage from behind the arc as they make 8.4 three-pointers per game while they limit their opposition to just 5.5 threes a game. On the boards they average 29.4 a game while they allow 35.0 for an average margin of -5.6. U-Mary has been outscored 604-501 in the first half this season.

ABOUT THE WOLVES: Northern State boasts the leagues top scorer, and it's not even close. Kevin Ratzsch -- the NSIC preseason Player-of-the-Year -- has had his way with the league this season. He leads the conference with two 30-point games and 13 different times he has produced 20 or more points in a game. Only once this season was he not the Wolves leading scorer. After ripping through the nonconference season 6-0 -- including non-conference wins over NSIC opponents UMD (63-59) and BSU (73-70) at the NSIC Holiday HoopsFest -- Northern State has dropped three conference games to sit at 6-3. Two of those losses, however, have come in overtime. In the first weekend of the season NSU fell in OT to Augustana, 71-79, and most recently they dropped an overtime decision to Bemidji State 93-100. On Saturday Jan. 10, in a win over U-Mary, NSU head coach Don Meyer set history with his 903rd career collegiate win, which passed legendary Indiana and Texas Tech head coach Bobby Knight for first place all time. Last season Meyer, Ratzsch and the Wolves produced 29 wins against just four losses, the problem was that all four came from Winona State the eventual National Champion. NSU ended their 2007-08 season in the North Central Region Championship game with a 68-60 loss to Winona State. In the first rematch this season, WSU got the best of NSU again, handing the Wolves a 75-85 loss in Winona, NSU's only regulation loss of the season. Northern State hasn't had to travel much yet this season and will enter the week with just a 1-1 record in road games.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
