FREQUENT FLIER MILES: Having wrapped up their four game home stand, the Huskies now enter a stretch where six of their final nine games are on the road, beginning with two this weekend. The Huskies hit the road for the first time since Jan. 10 when they travel to Wayne State on Friday Jan. 30 and to #22 Augustana on Saturday Jan. 31. Each tip-off is set for 8:00 pm.

FOR THE RECORD: After their second consecutive weekend split the Huskies sit at 12-6 over all and 7-4 in the NSIC. Augustana is also 7-4 in the NSIC and is 13-5 overall. Wayne State meanwhile, is 8-10 overall and 4-7 in the conference.

SERIES HISTORY: St. Cloud State already holds a 1-0 lead on the season over Wayne State after the Huskies won at the Hoopster Classic to start the season. The win was the fourth straight over the Wildcats, and gave the Huskies an 8-2 lead in the all-time series. A long time North Central Conference rival, Augustana, has matched up with St. Cloud State 71 times since the 1947-48 season. SCSU lost two to Augie last season, but still leads the all-time series 38-33.

ROAD RECORD: After playing nine of their last 11 games at home, the Huskies now hit the road where they are just 3-3 this season, and 3-4 in games played away from Halenbeck Hall. Their last road win was on Dec. 6 over Upper Iowa

VERSUS THE TOP-25: With the current NABC Top-25 poll, Saturday's opponent Augustana is ranked #22 in the country. If they stay in the polls it will give SCSU three ranked opponents in their last five games. SCSU is currently 1-1 against ranked teams, but have yet to play one on the road.

CONFERENCE STANDINGS: Before their games last week, SCSU was in a four-way tie for fourth place in the league. After beating U-Mary in Friday, the Huskies jumped into a five-way log jam in second place at 7-3. However after SCSU fell to Northern State on Saturday they fell back in the pack and are currently in a three-way tie for fifth place at 7-4. This weeks opponent, Augustana is one of the teams tied at fifth with St. Cloud State, after losing twice last week and falling from first place. Wayne State is alone in 10th place at 4-7 after also losing twice last weekend. The top seven teams in the conference standings are separated by just 1.5 games.

RIDE WITT YOU: The Huskies have been paced by Taylor Witt in the recent absence of their leading scorer, Matt Schneck. Witt -- the Huskies second leading scorer -- had the second best scoring night of his career against U-Mary as he poured in 25 on the night. The next night against Northern State he added 14 and hit double figures for a career high-tying fifth straight game. A team high nine times this season he has lead the Huskies in scoring, including four of the five games played without Schneck.

BERNING UP: After scoring in double figures in four straight games in December, Andrew Bernstetter has added four more double-digit scoring games in January. The difference is that he has been unable to score in back-to-back games during the stretch. Since scoring 10 points in the Huskies win on Jan. 3, he has alternated double and single digit scoring nights in each game since. Against Northern State, he led SCSU with 15 points, and he is one of three players with 10 games with 10+ points.

15 IN A ROW: Brett Putz's streak of consecutive free throws made came to a halt against Northern State. With his second free throw of the game, Putz missed for the first time in 2009, breaking a streak that began on Jan. 9.

15 ALL AT ONCE: Theo Rothstein was needed to play increased minutes over the weekend, and responded with his two best performances of the season. Against U-Mary he scored a career high 15 points, and the next night he came back with 12 points while playing a career high 27 minutes. Rothstein was 5-of-5 from the field against U-Mary, a new SCSU season best.

REGIONAL RANKINGS: The first regional rankings of the season come out this week on Wednesday Jan. 28. The Huskies will be helped by wins over North Central Region foes in Metro State, Winona State and Minnesota State, but hurt by their four recent losses.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

PLAYER NOTES

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Had his most productive weekend as a Husky yet. Played 24 minutes and scored a career high 15 points with three steals in the win over U-Mary, and added 12 more in the loss to NSU where he played a career high 27 minutes. Shot an outstanding 9-of-11 from each the field and the free throw line over the weekend.

10 BRETT PUTZ: Scored 12 points and grabbed career high seven rebounds against U-Mary. Scored 13 points while playing 36 minutes against Northern State. Has now moved into fourth place on the Huskies season scoring chart. 11th in the NSIC in three-pointers made (1.82) and 13th in three-point percentage (.435).

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Scored one point against U-Mary and did not score against Northern State.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Scored two points against U-Mary.

20 TAYLOR WITT: Paced the Huskies with 25 points against U-Mary, including the first five for SCSU and 11 of their first 18. Fourth career time over 20 and second at 25 or more. Added 14 in a career high 38 minutes against Northern State, marking the first time in five games that he did not lead SCSU in scoring. 2nd in the NSIC in assists (5.00), 5th in minutes played (32.00), 6th in steals (1.45), 8th in scoring (14.6), 9th in three-pointers made (1.91), and 10th in assist/turnover ratio (1.38).

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Went 6-for-6 at the free throw line, scoring all of his points from the charity stripe over the weekend. Scored four against U-Mary and two against Northern State.

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAH: Played six minutes with two assists against U-Mary.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Scored seven points and had seven rebounds against U-Mary. Led the Huskies with 15 points against Northern State while adding another seven rebounds. Was 4-4 from the free throw line against NSU. Also had six blocks over the weekend, and is one away from a tying his single season high of 22. 3rd in the NSIC in blocked shots (1.45), 5th in offensive rebounds (2.36), 6th in rebounding (6.7), 7th in three-pointers made (2.00), 8th in defensive rebounds (4.36), 18th in scoring (12.6) and 19th in minutes played (28.36).

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Scored five points and pulled down seven rebounds against U-Mary. Went 8-of-12 from the free throw line on his way to 13 points while just missing a career high (9) with eight rebounds. Scored in double figures for the first time since Dec. 5. Tallied three steals on the weekend and has recorded one in 14 of the Huskies 17 games this season. 2nd in the NSIC in steals (2.00), 13th in blocked shots (0.73), 19th in rebounding (4.5) and 30th in minutes played (26.82).

40 JESSE FISHER: Scored two points in each game over the weekend.

42 CRAIG COENEN: Scored six points with three-rebounds against U-Mary, and scored one point with four rebounds against Northern State.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Did not play for the second straight weekend with an injury.

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Will miss the remainder of the season due to injury.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE WILDCATS: At 8-10 and 4-7. Wayne State has had an up and down year, never winning or losing more than two games in a row, which doesn't bode well for the Huskies as the Wildcats enter the game off two straight losses. Wayne State is 4-4 at home this season, including a 2-3 home mark in conference games. In league games Jonathon Thomas leads the way for the Wildcats with 15.5 points per game followed by Brian Metz with 13.4 ppg. In only three of Wayne State's 18 games has someone other than Thomas or Metz led them in scoring. Thomas is also WSC's leading rebounder at 7.5 per game with Metz not far behind at 6.5 rpg. Most recently Wayne State posted an 0-2 weekend on the road at Minnesota State and Southwest Minnesota. The Wildcats are one of the better defensive teams in the conference as they hold their opponents to a league fourth-best 68.6 points per game. However they counteract by scoring only 66.7 ppg which in 10th in the conference for a scoring margin of -1.9. On the glass, Wayne State is second in the league with a rebounding margin of +5.5. Free throw shooting and turnovers have hurt the Wildcats this season as they rank 12th in the conference in each. They are shooting less than 70% from the line, and give the ball away an average of three times a game more than they take it away. Metz leads the league in field goal shooting at a 68% clip, and Thomas ranks fourth in the league, shooting better than 56%. The pair also leads the league in offensive rebounds as Thomas averages a lead leading 3.36 per game, and Metz is second at 2.91 per game.

ABOUT THE VIKINGS: 13-5, 7-4 Augustana climbed all the way to the top of the NSIC standings, where it sat alone in first place, before falling to a fifth place tie after two road losses last weekend. It began with a 57-64 loss to Southwest Minnesota, and wrapped up with a 63-86 drubbing from Minnesota State. The Vikings shot just 38% from the field and 20% from behind the arc against Minnesota State. The night before things were even worse as Augie shot only 37% from the field and less than 20% from behind the arc. In league play, Augustana averages 45% on field goals which in eighth in the league and 36% on three-pointers which is fifth in the NSIC. To get to first place a week earlier Augustana capped a four game win streak by knocking off defending champion Winona State, 88-72 in Sioux Falls, snapping the Warriors 10 game win streak in the process. Augustana is 5-1 at home this season, suffering only a three-point loss to Minnesota Duluth at the Elmen Center. Against league opponents, the Vikings are led by Eric Krogman and Cody Schilling who each average 11.5 points per game. David Foster is not far behind at 11.4 ppg. As a team, Augie ranks seventh in the league in scoring offense, at 70.5 points per game, and they are even better in scoring defense where they rank third in the NSIC, holding their opponents to just 67.3 points per game. Krogman is also leads the league in rebounds, averaging 8.5 per game. Schilling may be the early favorite for NSIC freshman of the year. On his way scoring 11.5 ppg, he shoots 54% from the field. 50% from behind the arc and 85% from the free throw line.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
