**REMATCH, ON OUR COURT:** The Huskies closed their first trip around the NSIC last weekend, and this week begin a string of seven rematches to close the season. The first set of games brings Minnesota Duluth and Bemidji State into Halenbeck Hall on Friday Feb. 6 and Saturday Feb. 7 respectively. The Huskies lost on the road to each team in early January.

**FOR THE RECORD:** After posting the weekend sweep, the Huskies sit at 14-6 overall and 9-4 in the NSIC. Minnesota Duluth is tied with SCSU at 9-4 in the conference, and it 15-8 overall. Bemidji State holds a 5-8 record in league play and is 7-13 in all games.

**SERIES HISTORY:** After being swept on road to the Bulldogs and Beavers last month, the Huskies saw a pair of long winning streaks over each team end. SCSU still holds a 44-30 all-time lead over UMD, but the Husky loss on Jan. 9 broke an 11-game winning streak over the Bulldogs. Against BSU, SCSU holds an 87-38 advantage in the all-time series, but the Beavers win on Jan. 10 snapped a 13-game Husky winning streak.

**REGIONAL RANKINGS:** The first regional rankings of the season were released on Jan. 28, and the Huskies came in at sixth, as one of seven NSIC teams in the top-10. The top-eight teams in the final rankings will advance to regional play, and Northern State heads the current list of contenders. This is the first time the Huskies have been on the regional rankings since the end of the 2006-07 season when they were eight in the final report, earning the eighth seed in the NCAA Central Region Tournament.

**CONFERENCE STANDINGS:** Winona State won their only game of the weekend to move to 10-3 in the NSIC and remain in first place while Southwest Minnesota won twice to move into a tie with WSU. St. Cloud State needed both of their wins to keep pace, and remain one game back of the leaders at 9-4. Tied in third with SCSU is Minnesota State and Minnesota Duluth. Northern State (8-5) and Augustana (8-5) each went 1-1 over the weekend and are now tied for sixth place. Concordia (7-6) also went 1-1, and rounds out the top-eight.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK:** After his performance against Wayne State and Augustana, Taylor Witt was named NSIC player of the Week by the league office. He averaged 21 points and 7.5 assists in the Huskies two wins including 30 points against Augustana.

**NEW BEGINNINGS:** The Huskies seem to thrive on the turning of the calendar. After Matt Schneck won the first NSIC player of the week

award of the season on Nov. 18, SCSU has own the first player of the week of each month. Andrew Bernstetter won it after the first weekend of conference play on Dec. 8, and Schneck won again as the first honoree of the new year on Jan. 5.

**REVERSAL OF FORTUNE:** the Huskies entered the weekend carrying a 3-4 record away from Halenbeck Hall, including losses in their last two road games. But now after gaining two crucial NSIC road wins. It appears that SCSU has turned the tide, which will be key with four of their final five games in the road.

**MONTH-BY-MONTH:** SCSU went 3-2 in November before ripping through December with a 6-0 mark. Two straight wins then closed January with a 5-4 record and the Huskies will now close the regular season with seven games in February.

**30 ROAD:** Twice this season the Huskies have posted 30-point games, and each time is has come on the road. First Josh Ortman against Winona State on Dec. 5, and now Taylor Witt poured in 30 in the win over Augustana. Only four players in the NSIC have scored 30 points in a conference game this season, and the Huskies boast two of them.

**229 DOWN:** Head Coach Kevin Schlagel notched his 228th and 229th career wins over the weekend, leaving him just two wins away from tying Butch Raymond for the all-time wins record at SCSU with 231.

**FREE AND EASY:** The Huskies shot 88.9% (32-of-36) from the free throw line against Augie, which sets a new season high bettering the 84.2% SCSU posted on Nov. 22 against St. John's. It is the best since the Huskies shot 90% (9-of-10) on Feb. 23 last season, also against Augustana.

**SECOND HALF SHOOT-OUT:** Against Augie, the two teams combined for 62 points at the break, but in the second they exploded for 124 points, doubling the first half total. The 60 points scored, was the most by SCSU in the second half this season, while the 64 points allowed was the most in any half by SCSU.

**OFF THE BENCH:** Matt Schneck had started 69 consecutive games before suffering an injury on Jan. 9. After sitting out for five straight games, Schneck was in uniform, but not in the starting line-up on Jan. 30 against Wayne State. For the first time since the second game of his first year, he came off the bench. The following night he was back as a starter.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Scored 10 points with five rebounds against WSC, along with an assist, a block and a steal. Scored in double figures for a personal best third straight game. Scored seven points with two assists and three steals against Augustana. 15th in the NSIC in steals (1.15).

10 BRETT PUTZ: Scored seven points with two assists and two steals against Wayne State. Huskies second leading scorer with 16 points against Augustana. Went 8-of-8 from the free throw line over the weekend. 13th in the NSIC three-pointers made (1.77), 14th in three-point percentage (.411).

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Scored three points against Wayne State, grabbed one rebound against Augustana.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Played two minutes against Wayne State.

20 TAYLOR WITT: NSIC Player-of-the-Week. Scored 12 points and had six assists against Wayne State. Scored career high 30 points against Augustana and tied a career high with nine assists. Went career best 13-of-15 from the free throw line. Hit 11 free throws in the final 2:54 to seal the SCSU win over Augie. Has now scored in double figures in seven straight games, and led SCSU in 10 games. 2nd in the NSIC in assists (5.38), 3rd in minutes played (32.00), 4th in scoring (15.6), 8th in assist/turnover ratio (1.52), 11th in three-point percentage (.421), 11th in three-pointers made (1.85), 12th in steals (1.23).

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Scored four points with three steals against Wayne State. Scored five points against Augustana.

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAHATTAH: Grabbed four rebounds against Wayne State with two assists.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Led the Huskies against Wayne State with 13 points and seven rebounds. Also had two steals and two assists. Score in double figures in back-to-back games for the first time since Dec. 12 & 13. Huskies are 2-1 when he is the leading scorer. Scored three points with four rebounds against Augustana. 4th in blocked shots (1.38), 6th in three-pointers made (1.92), 6th in offensive rebounds (2.23), 9th in rebounding (6.5), 11th in defensive rebounds (4.31), 22nd in scoring (11.9), 22nd in minutes played (28.00).

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Scored five points with one rebound and one steal against Wayne State, and scored four points with three assists, two rebounds, and one block against Augustana. 3rd in the NSIC in steals, 15th in blocks.

40 JESSE FISHER: Started for the second time on the season against Wayne State and finished with five points, five rebounds, and a career high five blocks. Against Augustana tied a career high with 15 points and set a new career high with eight rebounds in just 15 minutes of play.

42 CRAIG COENEN: Finished with one point and three boards against Wayne State and two points and three more boards against Augustana.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Against Wayne State played for the first time since Jan. 9 and finished with six points and four rebounds in 20 minutes of play. Returned to the starting line-up against Augustana and went 7-of-12 from the field for 14 points, and just missed a double-double with nine rebounds.

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Will miss the remainder of the season due to injury.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE BULLDOGS: Minnesota Duluth split at home on the weekend and have not won back-to-back games since Jan. 9 & 10 when they swept St. Cloud State and Concordia. The wins over SCSU and CU capped a season high five-game win streak, but since the Bulldogs are just 2-3 in their last five games. Last weekend UMD lost to Southwest Minnesota in a heart breaker 55-56, but rebounded beat #13 Minnesota State 73-65. Against SMSU, UMD was trailing 36-53 with 9:43 left in the game, but strung together a 19-1 run throughout the remainder of the game only to fall one point short. Against MSU, UMD took the lead with their second bucket of the game and never trailed after, opening up their lead to as much as 14. In each game John Vaudreuil led the Bulldogs in scoring, including a 28-point effort against the Mavericks. Vaudreuil -- the Bulldogs co-leading scorer -- has led UMD in scoring in 12 games on the season, and fellow leading scorer Brian Sykora has led UMD in seven other games. In only five games this season, has the pair not paced the Bulldogs. UMD is 5-4 on the road this season and dropped their last two on Jan. 16 & 17 to U-Mary and Northern State respectively. Minnesota Duluth is one of the better shooting teams in the league, hitting from a .475 clip from the field which ranks third and includes a second place mark from behind the arc at .392. They also are second best in the NSIC at defending the shot, holding their opponents to .432 mark from the field. Minnesota Duluth's main deficiency comes at the free throw line where rank 10th in the conference with a .703 tally.

ABOUT THE BEAVERS: When St. Cloud State last saw Bemidji State they were in the midst of a four-game winning streak, capped off on Jan. 16 with a double overtime road win over then 11th ranked Northern State. The Beavers Seth Haake and Brady Fairbanks each scored 29 points, leading BSU to the 100-93 win. Since the 16th however, the Beavers have lost four straight, including 66-84 to #13 Minnesota State and 54-66 to Southwest Minnesota last weekend. After last weekend, the Beavers would be the first left out of the NSIC Tournament if it started today. After being picked to finish 13th in the preseason, at 5-8 in league play, they are two games behind Concordia at 7-6 for the final playoff spot. In each of their last two losses, the Beavers were out-done on the boards, suffering a -21 margin to MSU and a -16 margin to SMSU. Opponents have also done a good job of limiting the Beavers leading scoring Seth Haake during the last four games as well. Haake, who scored 16, 21, 23, and 29 point during BSU's four stright wins, has scored 17, 12, 12, and 10 during their last four losses. BSU also shot just 34% and 38% respectively in their last two losses as well. Against SMSU on Jan. 31, BSU became the first team this season to give up 1000 points in conference games, and they rank 14th in the NSIC in scoring defense, allowing 77.1 points per game.

**HEAD COACH KEVIN SCHLAGEL**



Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.

Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
