**HIGH STAKES:** The Huskies begin a crucial four game road stretch this week as they head to Southwest Minnesota on Feb. 13 and #21 Minnesota State on Feb. 14. Each with 20 wins, the Mustangs and Mavericks are a combined 19-3 at home this season. Just a game behind league leading SMSU, and tied in second with MSU, first place could be up for grabs for SCSU this weekend. Each game is set for an 8:00 pm tip-off.

**FOR THE RECORD:** The three teams in question went a combined 7-0 last week, and 6-0 against the NSIC. The Huskies are currently tied for second place at 11-4 in the conference and 16-6 overall. The Mustangs lead the league with a 12-3 NSIC mark and a 20-5 overall record. The Mavericks also boast a 20-5 overall tally, and are tied with the Huskies in second place at 11-4.

**SERIES HISTORY:** The Huskies split when SMSU and MSU came to St. Cloud last month, falling to the Mustangs before beating the Mavericks. The Huskies have now lost two in a row to Southwest Minnesota, but in 46 all-time meetings, hold a 31-15 advantage. SCSU's recent win over Minnesota State snapped a six game losing streak to MSU and increased the SCSU lead to 89-75 in 164 all-time contests.

**WINS RECORD:** Against Bemidji State head coach Kevin Schlagel tied the SCSU men's basketball record for career coaching victories with 231. Former coach Butch Raymond went 231-142 from 1984-1997 before Schlagel took over. With a career mark of 231-109, Schlagel will look for his record breaking 232nd win on Feb. 13, as well as his 17th win of the season, giving him 11 season's out of 12 where he has led SCSU to at least 17 victories.

**REGIONAL RANKINGS:** When the most recent rankings were announced on Feb. 4, the Huskies were surprised to see their position drop from sixth to seventh, despite winning to games. Friday's opponent, Southwest Minnesota, jumped all the way from fifth to become the new number one, while Saturday's opponent, Minnesota State, fell from fourth to sixth.

**CONFERENCE STANDINGS:** The race for the NSIC crown just keeps getting tighter as four top teams went 2-0 over the weekend. SCSU, SMSU and MSU were joined by Northern State with unblemished weeks. One of NSU's win's came over Winona State, giving the Warriors a split, dropping them into a second place tie with SCSU and MSU, and leaving SMSU alone in first place. The second place Huskies are just a game out of first place, but they are also just a game out of fifth.

**CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT:** With 11 conference wins, the Huskies have now officially locked up a spot in the NSIC tournament, but with just three games separating the top-eight teams, the final standings are still a long way from being determined. Evidence: Eighth place Concordia (9-6) could still win out, get help, and host the whole thing.

**RETURNING THE FAVOR:** After losing to both Minnesota Duluth and Bemidji State in their first meeting, the Huskies returned the favor, and avoided the season sweep in the process. The Huskies have not been swept by the Bulldogs since the 1981-82 season and have not been swept by the Beavers since the 1972-73 season.

**FOUR IN A ROW:** The Huskies have now won four straight conference games for the first time since 2005-06. That season SCSU rattled off six straight NCC wins on their way to an 8-4 league record.

**SCHNECK COUNTDOWN TO 1,000:** Matt Schneck has an outside chance to reach 1,000 career points before the end of his junior season, despite missing four and a half games with an injury. Schneck has 897 career points, and the Huskies have five regular season games and at least one tournament game remaining. To get there he would need to average just over 17 points per game the rest of the way. He currently averages 14.1 points per game.

**BRETT PUTZ ON A CLINIC:** For the eighth and ninth time this season, Brett Putz posted a perfect game at the free throw line, going 2-for-2 in each game and 4-for-4 on the weekend. Since Jan. 9 has missed just one free throw and has currently made 12 straight. His 28-for-29 (.966) mark in conference play would easily top the NSIC leader board, but he is two made free throws shy of qualifying for the standings.

**HIGHS IN THE 50'S:** During their current four-game winning streak, the Husky defense has turned it up a notch, holding three of their four opponents to scores in the 50's. Eight times this season, SCSU has held an opponent under 60 points.

**WHEN STEALING IS OK:** Andrew Bernstetter became the seventh player in SCSU history to record a school record six steals in a game, after he accomplished the feat against Minnesota Duluth.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.



PLAYER NOTES

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Scored four points against Minnesota Duluth, and added four more on 2-of-2 shooting against Bemidji State.

10 BRETT PUTZ: For the first time since 2008, was held to under 10 points in back-to-back games. Played over 30 minutes for the third time against Minnesota Duluth, scoring seven points. Scored seven again with a career high three steals against Bemidji State. Went 4-of-4 at the line and has now made 12 consecutive free throws. 14th in the NSIC in three-pointers made (1.67).

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Against Bemidji State scored 12 points in a seven minute span down the stretch to seal the win. Went 2-of-3 from three point range and 4-of-4 from the free throw line.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Did not see action over the weekend.

20 TAYLOR WITT: Led the Huskies for the sixth time in eight games with 17 points against Minnesota Duluth. Went 8-of-8 at the free throw line and dished out seven assists while playing a career high 40 minutes. Against Bemidji State, had seven more assists to go along with nine points, snapping a streak of eight games in double figures. Now has six or more assists in four straight games. 2nd in the NSIC in minutes played (32.73), 2nd in assists (5.6), 6th in scoring (15.3), 8th in assist/turnover ratio (1.56), 11th in steals (1.33), and 13th in three-pointers made (1.73).

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Grabbed two rebounds against Minnesota Duluth and scored four points against Bemidji State.

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAHAT: Did not see action over the weekend.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Scored 14 points with eight rebounds and a school record tying six steals against Minnesota Duluth. Scored 10 points with six rebounds, one block and one steal against Bemidji State. Hit a team high four three-pointers over the weekend. Has scored in double figures in four of the last five games. 5th in the NSIC in blocks (1.27), 7th in three-pointers made (1.93), 8th in defensive rebounds (8.53), 8th in rebounds (6.6), 9th in steals (1.40), 10th in offensive rebounds (2.07), 21st in minutes played (27.93), 22nd in scoring (11.9).

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Scored eight points on 2-of-5 shooting and 4-of-4 free throw shooting against Minnesota Duluth and scored two points with a season high tying eight rebounds against Bemidji State. Had four blocks for the weekend and averaged 34.0 minutes per game. 3rd in the NSIC in steals (1.87), 8th in blocks (0.87) and 25th in minutes played (27.40).

40 JESSE FISHER: Scored nine points and pulled down six rebounds with one block against Minnesota Duluth. Scored four points with three boards and a block against Bemidji State.

42 CRAIG COENEN: Went 2-of-2 from the field against Bemidji State on his way to five points, while adding two rebounds and two assists.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Scored 13 points with four rebounds, two blocks and two steals against Minnesota Duluth. Scored a team high 12 points with eight rebounds while shooting a season high 15 free throws against Bemidji State.

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Will miss the remainder of the season due to injury.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE MUSTANGS (20-5, 12-3): The number one team in the NSIC and the Central region, Southwest Minnesota has won a league best 10 straight. SMSU began the conference season 0-2, suffering losses to pre-season heavyweights Minnesota State and Northern State, but has since ripped through the league at a 12-1 clip, losing only to Winona State who was in the midst of their own 10-win streak at the time. The Mustangs are 7-2 at home this season, with the only losses being from MSU and WSU. Southwest Minnesota will try to become the first team since conference play began to hold sole possession of first place for consecutive weeks. With 20 wins, it marks the third time SMSU has done so under head coach Greg Stemen, and the fourth time in the schools history. SMSU cruised to a 78-67 win over MSU Moorhead on 2/6, and then overcame a seven-point halftime deficit to beat Minnesota, Crookston 67-46 on 2/7. The Mustangs held the Golden Eagles to just 17 second half points. The Mustangs do not have a single player who averages double figures for scoring, but they do have the league's best scoring defense, allowing less they 62 points a game. An extremely sound team, they also lead the league in rebounding margin at +8.2 rpg, turnover margin with a +3.13 mark, and in offensive rebounds where they grab 14.73 per game. Kevin Andrews and Ross DeMasi lead the team in scoring at 9.1 and 9.0 ppg respectively, and they have seven players scoring 7.0 points per game or better. In conference play, Ross DeMasi leads the league in rebounding at 8.5 per game, and he is also sixth in the NSIC in field goal percentage, hitting 57% of his shots.

ABOUT THE MAVERICKS (20-5, 11-4): Minnesota State enters the week ranked #21 in the country, and they are the only NSIC team to have been found among the top-25 all season long. The Mavericks were found in or near the top-10 for most of the season, and climbed as high as sixth earlier in the year. They fell from #9 after suffering their loss to SCSU 1/17, and recently fell from #13 after losing to Minnesota Duluth on 1/31. MSU is ranked sixth in the latest Central Region rankings, just ahead of SCSU. Their only home loss of the season came on 1/10 when they suffered a 100-85 loss to Winona State -- a game MSU was winning at halftime. Most recently the Mavericks posted a pair of win over Minnesota, Crookston (77-67) and MSU Moorhead (79-64). Against UMC, the Mavericks survived a scare when the Golden Eagles battled back from nine down in the second half to tie the score with just 2:33 remaining. The next night against the Dragons, the Mavericks used a 13-point halftime advantage to roll to the win. In conference games, Minnesota State is the second highest scoring team in the league at 80.3 points per game, as well as second in scoring margin, bettering their opponents by 9.0 ppg. The Mavericks are the second best shooting team in the league, hitting 49% of their shots from the floor and are fourth in three-point field goal percentage, connecting on better than 36%.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
