ROAD TRIP CONTINUES: The Huskies continue on their current four-game road trip with one game this weekend. On Saturday, Feb. 21 SCSU will travel to Minnesota, Crookston to cap off the season series with the Golden Eagles. Tip-off for the game is 4:00 pm.

FOR THE RECORD: The Huskies are currently 16-8 overall and 11-6 in the NSIC in fifth place. Minnesota, Crookston is 4-20 overall and in last place in the NSIC at 2-15.

SERIES HISTORY: The Huskies longest current winning streak versus any team is the 15 in a row that SCSU has posted over Minnesota, Crookston. Since first meeting in the 1995-96 season, the Huskies have won all 15 meetings with the Golden Eagles, including a 91-54 decision earlier this season in St. Cloud.

CHASING THE MARK: Head Coach Kevin Schlagel was unable to surpass Butch Raymond and set a new record for coaching wins at SCSU. Still with 231 wins, Schlagel will try for 232 against UMC this weekend. Schlagel is 13-0 versus Minnesota, Crookston.

REGIONAL RANKINGS: SCSU jumped two spots, from seven to five, when the latest regional rankings were released on Feb. 11. Southwest Minnesota stayed in the top spot for the second straight week. The only team in the top-10 left on the Huskies schedule is Winona State at #6.

CONFERENCE STANDINGS: With their two losses, St. Cloud State fell from a three-way tie for second place going into the weekend, into a fifth place tie with Minnesota Duluth following the weekend's games. Also, SCSU went from being a game out of first place to being three games out of the top-spot. Minnesota State and Winona State maintained their second place tie, and Northern State sits in fourth, a half-game ahead of SCSU.

CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT: If the season ended today, the Huskies would be on the road in the first round of the tournament. The top-seven teams in the standings are in the tournament, with final seeding still to be decided. Only the eight spot is up for grabs with Concordia having the advantage on Bemidji State. The only way for CU to fall out of eighth place is for them to lose out, with BSU winning out, which would cause a tie. With help the best SCSU could finish would be a first place tie with SMSU, but the Mustangs would hold the tie-breaker, having beaten SCSU twice.

HUSKIES IN CROOKSTON: Despite meeting 15 previous times, the Huskies have only played Minnesota, Crookston on the road four times previously -- all SCSU wins. The last meeting came in the 2006-07 season and was 83-57 in Husky favor. The average of games played in 1999, 2001, 2004 and 2006 is 83.3-65.8.

SAY IT AIN'T SO(UTHWEST): The loss to SMSU was the third straight against the Mustangs. SMSU has also won five of the last six meetings against SCSU.

ROAD RECORD: The losses over the weekend dropped the Huskies to .500 on the road in 2008-09 at 5-5 with two road games left. On the road in the NSIC, SCSU is 4-4.

HOME RECORD: With just one home game left SCSU has amassed an 11-2 home record.

3-0 WITH THREE TO GO: The Huskies are 3-0 against the three teams they have left on the schedule. SCSU beat Winona State 99-97 in OT on Dec. 5, and Concordia 68-46 on Dec. 13 in addition to their win over UMC on Dec. 13.

VS. RANKED OPPONENTS: Over the weekend the Huskies fell to 1-3 this season against teams ranked in the NABC Top-25 when the game was played. Winona State who has been in and out of the top-25 all season is the only regular season opponent left that may be ranked when they meet the Huskies.

SCHNECK COUNTDOWN TO 1000: With injuries plaguing the junior all season, Matt Schneck's chance to reach 1,000 points in his junior campaign has gotten slim. He went over the 900 career point mark against SMSU and currently has 901. With four guaranteed games left, he would need to average almost 25 points a game to reach the plateau.

SCHNECK ON THE BOARDS: Matt Schneck has also begun his assault on the SCSU all-time rebounding charts, where his 466 boards currently ranks him 20th in SCSU history. His career per game average of 6.1 is 17th all time.

BERNSTETTER FOR THREE: Andrew Bernstetter is beginning to climb SCSU charts for career three-pointers. With 67 in his two seasons, he sits 19th all-time in career three-pointers made.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

PLAYER NOTES

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Averaging 4.6 ppg. Scored two points in each game over the weekend. Scored a career high three blocks on 2/14 against Minnesota State.

10 BRETT PUTZ: Huskies fourth leading scorer at 8.7 ppg. Scored his 200th point of the season against Minnesota State. Only the second SCSU first year since 2000-01 score 200 points (Matt Schneck, 2006-07). Scored 10 against SMSU and 15 against MSU, and has scored in double figures 11 times this season. Tied a career high with three steals against Southwest Minnesota.

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Scored seven points on 2-of-4 shooting and 2-of-2 from the line against Southwest Minnesota.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Scored two points against Southwest Minnesota.

20 TAYLOR WITT: Huskies leading scorer at 14.2 ppg, and assist leader at 5.1 apg. With six points against Southwest Minnesota was held under 10 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 1/3 and 1/9. Scored a team high 16 against Minnesota State, hitting double figures for the 18th time on the season.

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Played 22 minutes and scored five points against Southwest Minnesota and scored two points in 11 minutes against Minnesota State. 22 minutes was the most since 1/17.

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAHAT: Made 1-of-2 free throws for one point in 12 minutes against Southwest Minnesota.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Leads team with 159 rebounds and is second with 249 points. Second with 6.6 rpg and third with 10.4 ppg. among top-20 all-time with 67 career three pointers. Scored five points with seven rebounds against Southwest Minnesota. Fouled out for just the second time on the season and his career. Scored 10 points with eight rebounds against Minnesota State. Has scored in 29 straight games. Against Minnesota State was held without a three-pointer for just the second time on the season and the first time since 1/16.

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Scored five points against Southwest Minnesota and eight against Minnesota State. Grabbed his team leading 38th steal on the weekend.

40 JESSE FISHER: Scored 10 points with six rebounds, and three blocks versus Southwest Minnesota, and scored seven points with four rebounds against Minnesota State. Against MSU started for the third time on the season, and fouled out for the second time on the season. 10 points against SMSU marked his fifth double-digit scoring game of the season.

42 CRAIG COENEN: Scored four points with two rebounds against Southwest Minnesota, and scored seven points with 10 boards against Minnesota State. Has recorded 10+ rebounds three times in his career, with the last two coming against MSU.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Leads the team with 6.7 rpg, and is second with 13.5 ppg. Scored four points in nine minutes against Southwest Minnesota. SMSU held Schneck without a rebound for the first time in his career. Also for the first time in his career, failed to play double-digit minutes, and his four points marked a season low, while continuing his streak of scoring at least one point in every career game he has played in. Scored his 900th career point.

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Will miss the remainder of the season due to injury.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE GOLDEN EAGLES (4-20, 2-15): Minnesota, Crookston has dropped five straight and is 1-9 in their last 10. games. Their last win came on Jan. 30 and was a 64-59 OT win at home over U-Mary. Their first conference win came on Jan. 9, also at home, and was a 63-58 win over Wayne State. Last week UMC dropped a 65-39 decision to Minnesota Duluth and an 81-72 final to Bemidji State. The 39 points against Minnesota Duluth is the lowest total for an NSIC team this season. UMC has suffered through losing streaks of four, five and eight games this season and has lost 10 games by 10 points or fewer, and five games by five points or fewer. Their 37 point loss to St. Cloud State (54-91) on Dec. 13 remains their most lopsided loss of the season. Two weekends again UMC held second half leads on both Southwest Minnesota and Minnesota State before seeing each game slip away in the second half. Eight times this season the Golden Eagles have held the lead at halftime, only to lose the lead in five of those games. The most glaring was a 40-20 lead UMC held on the road over Upper Iowa, before losing 76-73 in overtime. The Golden Eagles are 2-7 at home this season, and Saturday's game will be the final home game of the season for UMC. The Golden Eagles rank at the bottom of the NSIC in both scoring offense (57.6 ppg) and scoring margin (-12.4). They are 8th in the NSIC in scoring defense at 70.1 ppg and are second in the league in three-point field goal percentage defense at 32.6%.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
