**CONGRATULATIONS COACH!:** The Huskies 12th year head coach, Kevin Schlagel, is now the SCSU record holder for men's basketball career coaching victories. Schlagel won his 232nd career game on Feb. 21 with a 84-70 win over Minnesota, Crookston, the same team he earned his first career win against in 1997. Schlagel passes Butch Raymond who won 231 games from 1984-97.

**CLOSING TIME:** It's closing time on the regular season as the Huskies play their final two games before the postseason this week. On Wednesday, Feb. 25, SCSU will make the short trip down to Concordia for an 8:00 pm affair, and on Feb. 28 they close the regular season at home in Halenbeck Hall with Winona State, also at 8:00 pm.

**FOR THE RECORD:** With their 84-70 win over Minnesota Crookston, SCSU improved to 17-8 on the season and 12-6 in conference play. Concordia won once over the weekend as well to improve to 10-8 in league play and 12-13 on the season. Winona State also won in their only game, and is now 21-6 on the season and 14-4 in the NSIC.

**SERIES HISTORY:** The Huskies hold the upper hand in the season series with each of this weeks opponents. On Dec. 5 the Huskies opened the conference season with a 99-97 OT win over Winona State, and on Jan. 3 SCSU kicked off the new year with a 68-46 win over Concordia. In 11 all-time meetings with CU, dating back to 1999-00, the Huskies lead 9-2. SCSU and WSU have met on the hardwood 121 times since 1922-23 with SCSU holding the 87-34 lead.

**RED OUT:** Fans don't forget, the final regular season home game on Feb. 28 against Winona State will be a RED-OUT. Wear red and pack the Halenbeck Hall stands as the Huskies look to sweep the season series with the Warriors and lock up home court in the first round of the NSIC tournament.

**REGIONAL RANKINGS:** The Huskies fell from fifth to seventh when the latest ranking were released on Feb. 18. Southwest Minnesota stayed in the top spot with Fort Lewis taking the second spot and Metro State settling in third. Winona State jumped to fourth, ahead of Northern State in fifth and Minnesota State in sixth. Behind the Huskies in eighth was New Mexico Highlands.

**CONFERENCE STANDINGS:** The Huskies win, coupled with a pair of Northern State losses, leaves them in fourth place heading into the final week. Southwest Minnesota scored a huge win over Minnesota State to remain in first place and leave Winona State alone in second. MSU falls to third with Augustana and Minnesota Duluth tied with SCSU in fourth. NSU fell from fourth to seventh and Concordia remained in eighth.

**CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT:** The Mustangs are in the drivers seat for the number one seed with the Warriors just a game off the pace. The Mavericks appear to be a lock for a first round home game, leaving the Huskies, Bulldogs and Vikings left to battle it out for the final spot in the coveted top four, and the right to host. If the season ended today, the Huskies would be in the fourth spot by virtue of strength of schedule points over both Augie and UMD. If the Huskies win out, they will be in Halenbeck for the first round of the tournament. With a loss in the next two games, SCSU could still host, but would need some help.

**TOUGHER THAN THE REST:** Looking only at the eight teams who have qualified for the conference tournament, and match-ups between those teams, the Huskies have played the toughest schedule of the top-eight. NSU, UMD and WSU have played, or will play, 10 games against the top-eight. Augie, CU, MSU, and SMSU have played or will play 11 games against the top-eight. SCSU, meanwhile, has 12 games on the schedule involving tournament qualifying teams. Also, the combined winning percentage of those 12 games for the Huskies is .700, more than six of the other seven teams. The only team higher is Concordia at .712, whose schedule is nearly identical but receives a bump by replacing their record with SCSU's. First place Southwest Minnesota has only the seventh most difficult schedule, with a combined winning percentage of .657.

**VS. RANKED OPPONENTS:** Against Winona State the Huskies will be playing their fifth ranked opponent of the season and will be looking for second win. SCSU beat the first - and highest -- ranked team they played in #9 MSU, but have since lost three straight to #16 NSU, #24 SMSU, and #17 MSU. Winona State is ranked #20 in the latest NABC Top-25 poll.

**TEAM CAPTAINS:** Senior forwards Brett Carmichael and Craig Coenen and junior center Matt Schneck will captain the Huskies in 2008-09.

4 THEO ROTHSTEIN: Scored five points in 10 minutes, against UMC. Averaging 4.6 ppg, and is fourth shooting 50% from the field. Has appeared in every game while playing 13.6 minutes per game.

10 BRETT PUTZ: Scored five points with one rebound and recorded first career block. Held to lowest point total since being inserted into the starting line-up. Fourth leading scorer at 8.6 ppg, and leads regulars at the free throw line hitting 86% of his attempts. 14th in the NSIC in three-pointers made.

12 SPENCER BARTZ: Scored a career high 21 points. Played a season high 25 minutes. Hit 4-of-7 threes and 1-of-1 free throws. Scored in double figures for the fourth time on the season. Has made a career high 22 three-pointers this season. 22 of his 33 field goals this season are threes. Averaging 4.8 ppg.

14 MICHAEL RILEY: Did not see any action.

20 TAYLOR WITT: Led the Huskies in scoring for the 13th time with 24 points. Dished out a career high nine assists for the fourth time, and tied a career high with for steals. Huskies leading scorer at 14.6 ppg, and assist leader with 131. 25 points shy of 500 for his career. 2nd in the NSIC in assists (5.56), 5th in minutes played (32.22), 7th in scoring (15.3), 7th in assist/turnover ratio (1.47), 12th in free throw percentage (.824), 14th in three-pointers made (1.61).

24 JOSH ORTMANN: Grabbed one rebound in three minutes of play. Fifth leading scorer at 6.3 ppg. Averages 1.9 rpg, and has 41 assists. Held scoreless for just the second time since Jan. 10.

30 MAHMOUD ABDELFAHATTAH: Scored four points in 2-of-2 shooting from the field. Averaging 2.9 ppg while playing 10.4 minutes per game.

32 ANDREW BERNSTETTER: Scored seven points and pulled down a game high nine rebounds. Has scored at least one point and grabbed at least one rebound in every game this season. Nine boards is highest since Jan. 17. Third in scoring at 10.2 ppg, and tied for team rebound lead at 6.7 rpg. 8th in rebounding (6.8), 27th in scoring (11.2).

34 BRETT CARMICHAEL: Chipped in four points with two assists and one rebound while playing a team high 35 minutes. Has scored in 13 straight games and has at least one rebound in every game this season. Will play in his 72nd and 73rd games as a Husky. 4th in the NSIC in steals (1.67), 11th in blocks (1.72), 26th in minutes played (27.72).

40 JESSE FISHER: Scored four points with two rebounds. Sixth in scoring at 5.9 points per game. Second in field goal percentage at 57%. Has scored in 18 straight games, third longest active streak on the team. Ninth in the NSIC in blocks (0.88).

42 CRAIG COENEN: Scored 10 points, pulled down seven rebounds, and had two assists. Went 2-for-2 at the free throw line. Hit double figures in scoring for the third time this season. Currently averaging 5.0 points per game and 3.5 redounds per game.

50 MATT SCHNECK: Did not see any action.

54 ROSS WINNEKINS: Will miss the remainder of the season due to injury.

OPPONENT INFO

ABOUT THE GOLDEN BEARS (10-8, 12-13): The Golden Bears have not lost to the Huskies in St. Paul since the 2001-02 season when the Huskies won 99-73. CU has won the last two in St. Paul, including a 61-57 win last season that was the Huskies third loss in four games. Led by third-year head coach Kelly Boe, CU enters the week as winners of six of their last nine, including a 99-92 OT win over MSU Moorhead on Feb. 21, that they had to come from behind to get. Craig Heiman pounded in a season-high 29 points while collecting a game-high nine rebounds to lead Concordia to the road victory. He played 44 out of a possible 45 minutes for CU and his free throw shooting was key in securing the victory, as one of the top free throw shooters in the league buried 12 of his 13 trips to the foul line. Heiman has now topped the 20-point plateau in three consecutive games, seven times on the season, and has failed to score at least 15 points only six times in 25 games. With 1,236 career points, he is sixth on CU's all-time scoring list. With 837 career points in league games, Heiman moved from 25th to 17th on the NSIC career scoring list with his 29-point effort, most recently surpassing Winona State's Jonte Flowers (04-08) and SMSU's Chad Koenen (98-02). With two league games remaining, he is within 45 points of climbing all the way to 11th (Tim Wahl, Mankato State, 78-81). Heiman is third in the NSIC in scoring this season, and 13th in rebounds. He has led the Golden Bears in scoring in 12 games. However in those games CU is just 4-8 this season, while they are 8-5 in games where he is not the leading scorer.

ABOUT THE WARRIORS (14-4, 21-6): Winona State is led by 11th year head coach Mike Leaf, and enters the week alone in second place in the league standings, just one game out of the top spot. If current number one Southwest Minnesota falters, and WSU wins out, they would win their fourth straight outright NSIC regular season title. Winona State continued in the hunt for another conference championship with a win over Bemidji State on Feb. 21. David Johnson paced the Warriors in their win with 29 points. Johnson hit for 17 points in the first half and then followed up with another 12 points in the final 20 minutes of play. For the game Johnson was 4-of-7 from three-point field goal range and 9-for-15 overall from the field. He added a career-high eight rebounds along with two assists and one steal. Since beginning the conference season 0-2, WSU has went 14-2 in conference play, including a winning streak of seven games. Of their last two conference losses, each came on the road, first to Augustana, and then to Northern State. Winona State's last road win over a top-eight team came on Jan. 10 when they beat Minnesota State in Mankato, 100-85. Since beating MSU however, Winona State has struggled on the road, going just 2-2 and having to come from behind in the second half to beat both Wayne State and Mary for their two wins. However, WSU enters the week on a four-game winning streak, and will look to make it five before meeting the Huskies as they play at Upper Iowa on Feb. 25. The last time Winona State played SCSU in St. Cloud was the 2005-06 season -- their first National Championship year -- and they left with an 80-79 loss.

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) begins his 12th season at the helm of the St. Cloud State men's basketball program in 2008-09. Schlagel enters the season with an all-time record of 215-103, and is just 16 wins away from becoming the winningest head coach in the history of the program.



Currently Schlagel trails only his predecessor Butch Raymond, whose 231 wins are the SCSU coaching standard. Just the third coach in team history to win 200 games, last season Schlagel passed the man who was first, when the Huskies beat North Dakota on Jan. 10, giving him 210 career wins to move past the legendary Red Severson (209).

Among those 215 wins, were 102 in North Central Conference games, and included a regular season championship in 2003. He also led his squads to NCC tournament titles in 2001 and 2003, and following the 2003 season was named NCC Coach of the year. Schlagel has also led SCSU into NCAA post-season play five times, and has compiled a 2-5 record in NCAA tournament games.

Last season he guided a program that sprinted out of the gates to a 9-0 record and landed among the top-10 teams in Division II with their #8 ranking on December 11. In all the Huskies spent eight weeks on the polls in the 2007-08 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons. He is assisted by Matt Reimer, Cory Schlagel and Andrew Cone.
