



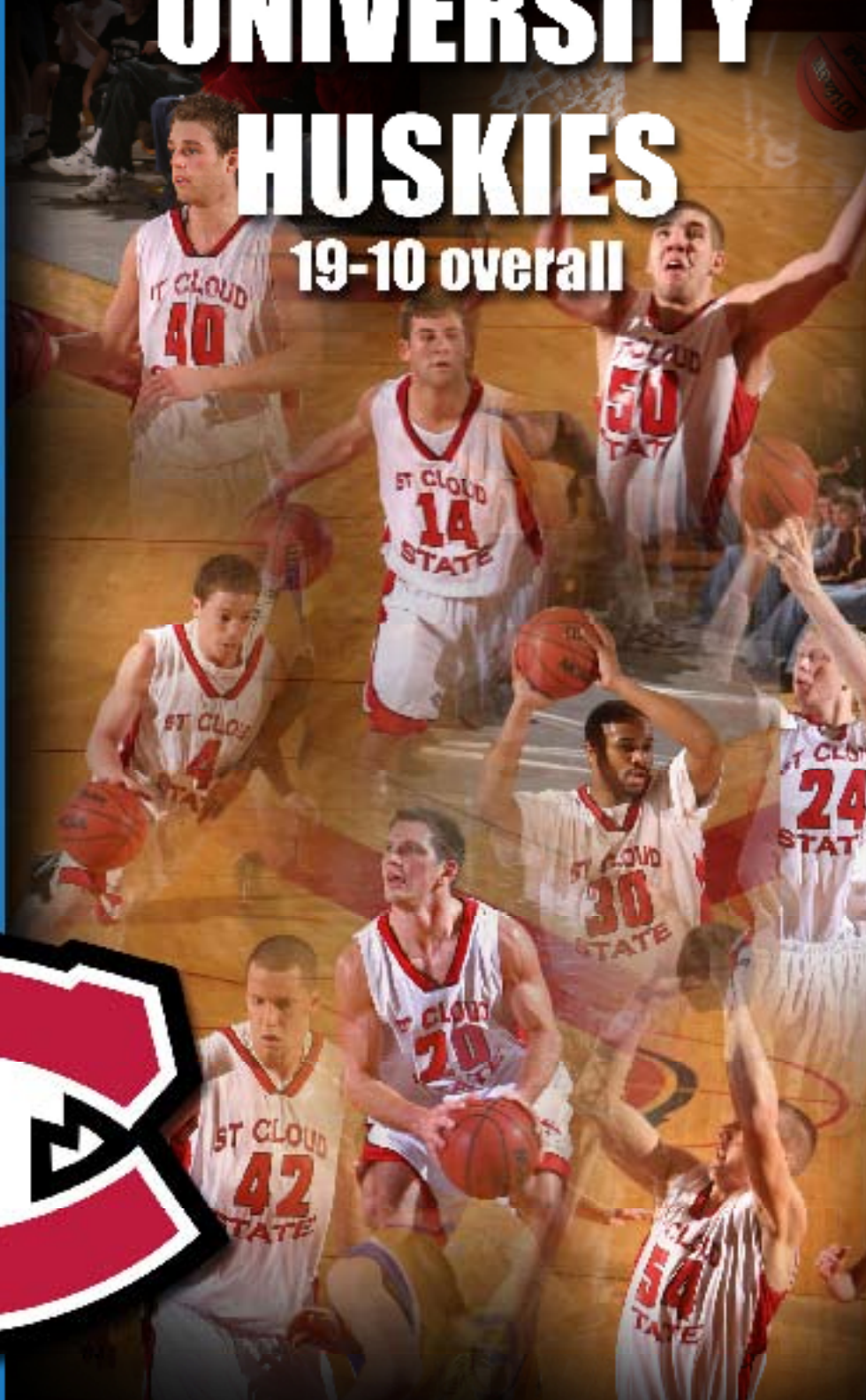

North Central Region Tournament: The St. Cloud State University men's basketball team has earned a bid to the 2007 NCAA Division II North Central Region Tournament to be played March 10, 11 and 13 in McCown Gymnasium on the campus of Winona State University. The Huskies, the #8 seed in the tournament will tip-off against the #1 seed, Winona State University at 6:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 10 in a quarterfinal game.

The Records: St. Cloud State enters the tournament with a 19-10 overall record. Winona State, a member of the Northern Sun Conference, brings a 30-0 record into the tournament. The Warriors are riding an NCAA Division II record tying 52-game winning streak.

Tickets: Single session ticket prices are \$9 for adults and \$4 for students. An all-tournament pass is available at \$27 for adults and \$12 for students. To reserve your tickets please call the Winona State University ticket office at 507-457-5210.

Tenth NCAA Playoff Appearance: This is the second straight NCAA Division II Tournament appearance and tenth overall for the Huskies. It is also the third appearance in the last five years for SCSU. St. Cloud State has a 7-10 record in NCAA region games. The Huskies won a North Central Region title in 1987 (under a different format), and advanced to the regional championship game in 2001, where SCSU lost to Southwest Minnesota State, 67-65 in Halenbeck Hall.

Huskies Third in the NCC: The Huskies finished in third place in the NCC standings with a 7-5 record. The third place NCC finish marks the sixth time in the last seven years that SCSU has finished in the top three of the league standings.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel (St. Cloud State, 1976) is in his tenth season as the head coach of the Huskies in 2006-07. **He has a current won/loss record of 198-90 as of March 5.** He has produced the third most wins all-time among SCSU men's basketball coaches, behind Butch Raymond (231) and Red Severson (209). Schlagel collected his 150th career win on Jan. 4, 2005 against Trinity College. He has also compiled a 90-54 record in NCC games, two Wells Fargo Finals Championships in 2001 and 2003, and a regular season NCC title in 2003. Schlagel was voted the 2003 NCC Coach of the Year. Four times he has led the Huskies to the NCAA tournament and is 2-4 in tournament games coached. Prior to becoming the head coach, Schlagel was the top SCSU assistant coach for 17 seasons.

SCSU in North Central Region Play

HUSKIES IN NCAA PLAY: This is the second straight NCAA Division II North Central Region appearance and tenth overall for the Huskies. The first Husky appearance in an NCAA regional was during the 1973-74 season. Last year, the Huskies entered the region tournament as the #7 seed. In 2003, the Huskies were the #2 seed and defeated the University of North Dakota 74-69 in the quarterfinals. SCSU fell to Metro State 75-63 in the semifinals. In 2001, the Huskies hosted the Regional tournament and advanced to the region finals where SCSU lost a heartbreaker, 67-65 to Southwest Minnesota State University.

The Huskies appeared in three straight regionals in 1985-86, 1986-87, and 1987-88, and advanced to the "Elite Eight" in 1986-87, where the Huskies lost to Delta State, 78-73 in overtime in an Elite Eight quarterfinal game played at Halenbeck Hall on the SCSU campus. St. Cloud State is 7-10 overall in NCAA Region Tournament Games, and 7-11 overall in NCAA playoff games, which includes the quarterfinal loss to Delta State in 1987.

Series Standing: SCSU and Winona State are old rivals dating back to the 1922-23 season. Both teams were once members of the Northern Inter-collegiate Conference, now called the Northern Sun Conference. This will be the 120th meeting between the two teams. SCSU has an 86-33 record against the Warriors. The last meeting between these two teams was on Nov. 25, 2006 at the UMD American Family Insurance Classic in Duluth, an 80-79 SCSU win.

Notes: The Warriors have been the number one ranked team in the country all season long. WSU won its second straight NSIC Tournament title on Sunday, a win that kept their winning streak alive and tied the all-time NCAA Division II record of 52 straight wins. In addition, the Warriors have won three straight NSIC regular season titles. To top it off, the Warriors are the reigning North Central Region and NCAA Division II National Champions. Their closest encounter this season was an 86-83 overtime victory against Concordia St. Paul on January 12. Four players average over 11 points per game, led by junior center John Smith with 16.8 points and a team leading 9.6 rebounds.

Player & Team Notes

#04 Dusty Wabiszewski: Junior guard Dusty Wabiszewski (Appleton, WI) tallied a career high ten assists at MSU, Mankato last Saturday. He leads the team with 138 assists this season, has moved into the top 20 on the all-time assist chart, and currently has 229 career assists. Twelve times this season, he has dished out six or more assists. He had a career high eight rebounds against Columbia Union on Dec. 21. He scored his career high 16 points twice this season.

#10 Brian Schellinger: Sophomore guard Brian Schellinger (Sartell) has played in 11 games this season. He had a season and career high two assists against Dakota State on Dec. 12.

#14 Team Captain David Dreas: Junior guard David Dreas (Winona) was named to the 2007 All-North Central Conference Men's Basketball team. It is the second straight season that Dreas has been so honored. A two-year starter for the Huskies, he has scored in double figures a team high 24 times this season. He scored a season high 31 points against MSU, Mankato last Saturday in Mankato. He leads the team in scoring, averaging 19.0 ppg. He has scored 30 or more points three times this season. He scored his 1,000th career point in SCSU's game against Northern Michigan on Dec. 31 and currently has 1,286 career points, which ranks him 18th all-time. He currently ranks in SCSU's career top 15 in assists (304) and steals (128) and the top ten in three-point field goals made (174). Dreas has averaged 26 points per game over the last three games for the Huskies. This is the second straight season that Dreas has led the Huskies in scoring.

#20 Eric Greene: Junior guard Eric Greene (Kingston, WI) has started four games this season. He scored a season high 14 points against Wayne State last December. He has notched a career high five assists three times this season.

#24 Team Captain Adam Sullivan: Senior guard Adam Sullivan (Green Bay, WI) is a 2007 All-North Central Conference Team selection and Academic All-North Central Conference team member. He was named to both teams for the second straight year. A three-year starter, he scored his career high 30 points against UMD on Jan. 20 of this season. He has made 69 three-point baskets this season and currently ranks sixth on the all-time three-point field goals made chart with 175.

#30 Brett Carmichael: Sophomore forward Brett Carmichael (Elk River) has started the last four games for the Huskies. He scored a career high 18 points against USD on Feb. 24 and sent the game into overtime with his three-point basket.

#32 Ben Novak: Senior post Ben Novak (Cloverdale, CA) has played in 18 games and made two starts for the Huskies.

#34 Bobby Morrow: Sophomore forward Bobby Morrow (St. Paul) has played in 22 games for the Huskies this season. He scored a season high nine points at Columbia Union on Dec. 21, 2006.

#40 Kelly Byrne: Senior forward Kelly Byrne (Ozark, MO) has recorded his career high in rebounds with ten and assists with seven, and equaled his career high in scoring with 19 points this season. He has scored in double figures ten times this season. He is a two-year starter for the Huskies.

#42 Craig Coenen: Sophomore forward Craig Coenen (Kaukauna, WI) has recorded career highs in scoring (14) and rebounds with nine this season.

#50 Matt Schneck: First year center Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, WI) has started 27 straight games for the Huskies. He recorded his team high fourth double double of the season against USD on Feb. 24, with 17 points and a career high 15 rebounds. He recorded a career high 22 points against MSU, Mankato on Jan. 11. Schneck has scored in double figures 15 times this season.

#52 Ross VerHeul: First year post Ross VerHeul (Viborg, SD) has played in nine games for the Huskies.

#54 Eric Bergstrom: Senior center Eric Bergstrom (Milaca) has started two games this season and has scored in double figures in 12 games. He collected 14 points against MSU, Mankato last Saturday. Bergstrom notched his first double-double as a Husky with 27 points and 11 rebounds against Concordia St. Paul on Nov. 24. Those totals were also career highs for Bergstrom.
