CONFERENCE PLAY: The No. 19 ranked St. Cloud State Men's Basketball team will start Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference play at home this week, as they host No. 24 Winona State and Upper Iowa. The Huskies will first take on Winona State at 8 p.m. on Friday night and will then play Upper Iowa at 6 p.m. Saturday night. Both games will be played in Halenbeck Hall.

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of Husky Basketball.

He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have been 20-game winners six times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 240-111 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

Game Notes

ITS BEEN AWHILE: St. Cloud State has not lost a regular season game to Winona State since the 1997-98 season when the Warriors won a 77-64 contest at in Winona, Minn.

READING THE DEFENSE: In three games against Winona State last season, junior captain Taylor Witt (Morris) scored a combined 65 points and improved each game.

He scored 14 points in the first game and added 22 in the second contest. He capped off the Huskies third win over the Warriors with 29 points.

Witt came into the NSIC Holiday Hoopsfest with 25 total point on the season. He more than doubled his season total with a season high 28 points against the University of Mary on Saturday night and then nearly did it again Sunday scoring 24 points against Augustana College.

MOVING UP THE LADDER: Senior captain Matt Schneck (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) moved himself further up the all-time St. Cloud State scoring list over the weekend.

On Saturday night he scored 11 points

to surpass Ken Novak (1947-51), Tony King (1987-89) and Tom Ditty (1964-68) who were ranked 31st, 30th and 29th on the all-time scoring list.

Schneck then scored 21 points on Sunday to bring his career total to 1,040 points. He is now 18 points behind Mark Stoeve (1970-74) to take over the 28th spot on the scoring list.

Schneck became the 33rd player in school history to score over 1,000 points in his career on November 21, 2009 against Michigan Tech.

Schneck is also in 15th place on the All-time rebounds list at St. Cloud State with 574 rebounds in his career. He is 61 rebounds from passing Al Anderstrom

(1970-74) for the No. 14 spot. He currently is the only player in the NSIC this season to average over 10 rebounds a game with 12.8.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE MACHINE: With the first four games of the 2009-10 season in the books, Schneck has recorded four straight double-doubles and now has recorded a double-double in his last eight games, dating back to last season.

He scored 15 points and grabbed 10 rebounds in the season opener against St. John's and followed it with a 14 point 11 rebound performance against Michigan Tech the next day. Most recently, he grabbed a career high 20 rebounds to go with 11 points in a win over the University of Mary and then scored 21 points and collected 10 boards against Augustana.

The last time Schneck did not record a double-double was on February 28, 2009 against Winona State at Halenbeck Hall.

Opponents Notes

WINONA STATE WARRIORS: St. Cloud State is 89-34 against the Warriors since the team's first met during the 1922-23 season. St. Cloud State beat Winona State three times last season, with the final meeting ending in a 91-77 St. Cloud State win in the semi-final round of the NSIC tournament on March 7, 2009. The Huskies also beat the Warriors 99-97 in overtime during the team's first meeting and 100-81 during the second contest.

Mike Leaf has just started his 12 season as the head coach of the Winona State program. He has the Warriors off to a 4-1 start in 2009 after going 24-9 last season. Leaf has helped Winona State put together two NCAA Championship seasons, with the most recent coming in 2008.



After starting the season 4-0, the Warriors dropped its last contest 81-74 to Minnesota State on the road Sunday. Winona State is second in the conference averaging 88.6 points a contest and has four players with double digit scoring averages. As a team the Warriors are shooting .425 from beyond the arc this season and average nearly 10 3-pointers a game, as senior David Johnson is shooting 18 of 33 from the three point line. They are also second in the NSIC with a +21.4 point scoring margin.

UPPER IOWA PEACOCKS: The Huskies are 8-1 against the Peacocks in a series that was started in 1951. St. Cloud State came out on top 75-73 in the last matchup on December 12, 2008 in Fayette, Iowa. Junior Taylor Witt (Morris) scored a game-high 19 points in a game that had 13 lead changes and nine ties. The Peacocks last traveled to St. Cloud in 2007, when the Huskies earned a 72-49 win in Halenbeck Hall.

Head coach Brian Dolan is now in his fourth season as the head coach at Upper Iowa, where he has put together an 18-63 record after starting the 2009-10 season 1-4. He posted a 4-16 record in the team's first season in the NSIC in 2008-09.



The Peacocks started the season 0-3 before getting its first win in a 74-54 victory over the University of Wisconsin- Parkside. Upper Iowa lost its last game 70-65 to Missouri-St. Louis at home on Saturday. The Peacocks will play the University of Concordia-St. Paul on Friday before traveling to St. Cloud. Upper Iowa is averaging 70.6 points a game, while giving up 71.8 to its opponents. The Peacocks have two players scoring over 10 points a game and are a deep squad with 10 players averaging over 11 minutes of playing time per game.
