SEASON OPENER: The No. 10 St. Cloud State Men's Basketball team kicks off the 2009-10 season by hosting the Radisson Suite St. Cloud Hoopster Classic on Friday and Saturday Nov. 20-21. The Huskies will open the season with a non-conference matchup with St. John's University at 8:00 p.m. following the first game of the evening in Halenbeck Hall. St. Cloud State will then play host to Michigan Tech at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday to cap the weekend off.

Head Coach Kevin Schlagel

Kevin Schlagel has been associated with the St. Cloud State basketball program for much of his adult life, first as a player, followed by 18 years as the top assistant, and then in 1997 being named the head coach of Husky Basketball.



He became the winningest head coach in St. Cloud State men's basketball on Feb. 21, 2009 when he captured his 232nd career win in an 80-74 win at Minnesota, Crookston. Schlagel's teams have won 17 or more games in 12 seasons during his tenure and have been 20-game winners six times.

Since Schlagel was named head coach at SCSU, the Huskies have compiled a 237-112 overall record. During the 2008-09 season, St. Cloud State's first as a member of the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference, Schlagel's squad finished third in the regular season and went on to claim the 2009 NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship and an automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

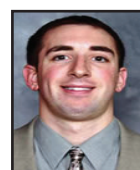
Assistant Coaches

Game Notes

PROGRAM HISTORY: Friday's game against St. John's kicks off the 86th season of men's basketball at St. Cloud State. Current head coach Kevin Schlagel is the 12th head coach in school history. All 12 coaches have a combined to put together a 1,190-757 all-time record. Current Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Commissioner Butch Raymond had the most wins in school history with 231 after 13 seasons of coaching, before the Huskies gave Schlagel his 232nd win in an 80-74 win over Minnesota, Crookston on Feb. 31, 2009. He currently owns a 237-112 record heading into the 2009-10 season.

ABOUT ST. CLOUD STATE: St. Cloud State posted a 22-9 overall record in 2008-09 and won the NSIC Sanford Health Tournament Championship in head coach Kevin Schlagel's 12th season. The Huskies then advanced to the NCAA Division II Central Region Tournament, where they lost on a last second shot to Augustana to end a successful campaign. St. Cloud State returns four starters and ten letterwinners from last year's squad.

The 2009-10 Huskies are led by co-captains senior center Matt Schneck

(Whitefish Bay, Wis.) and junior guard Taylor Witt (Morris). Both Schneck and Witt were named to The Sporting News Preseason Honorable Mention All-American team. The Huskies as a team have been picked to finish first in the NSIC in the annual coaches preseason poll.

Witt is coming off a 2008-09 season in which he averaged 15.0 points a game, which was second on the team, while recording a team-leading 82 assists per contest. He also played in a team-high 466 minutes of action last season to average 31.1 minutes a game.

Schneck led the Huskies with 15.7 points and eight rebounds a game, while blocking nine shots. He shot a stellar .657 from the field on 69-105 shooting in 2008-09.

Junior Andrew Bernstetter (St. Joseph) and sophomore Brett Putz (Forest City, Iowa) also recorded double digit scoring averages for the Huskies. Bernstetter average 10.3 points a game, while grabbing 6.1 rebounds per contest, while Putz averaged 10.0 points, while shooting a team-high .415 percentage from beyond the arc during the 2008-09 season.

NCAA ATTENDANCE LEADERS: The NCAA released its men's basketball attendance figures for the 2008-09 season and the Huskies were ranked second in NCAA Division II behind conference member Northern State University.

The Huskies averaged 3,316 fans per game, and were behind only Northern State who led the nation for a second straight season, averaging 4,735 fans per game. The Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference was well represented among the National leaders with four teams in the top-10. Augustana was seventh at 2,641 fans per game, and Southwest Minnesota was ninth at 2,435 per game.

As a league, the NSIC finished second in the country in average attendance, with 1,700 fans per game throughout the conference. The NSIC was behind only the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association, who narrowly claimed the top spot at 1,707 fans per game.

Opponents Notes

RECORD WITH THE JOHNNIES: The Huskies are 60-44 all-time against the St. John's University Johnnies since the series began in the 1924-25 season. The last game between both teams was last season, as the Huskies won its third straight contest against the Johnnies in an 85-59 win on Nov. 22.

The Johnnies are led by the winningest collegiate basketball coach on any level in Minnesota, as head coach Jim Smith enters his 46th season as a collegiate head coach. In those 46 seasons, he has now posted a 699-488 career record, while going 0-1 to start the 2009-10 season.



The Johnnies are coming off a season opening 81-57 loss to the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point on Sunday. St. John's shot 36.5 percent from the field on 19 of 52 shooting. Sophomore Andrew Latzke led all Johnnies with 13 points on 5-of-10 shooting, while junior Aaron Burtzel was close to recording the team's first double-double of the season scoring eight points while grabbing 10 rebounds.

The Johnnies have not beaten the Huskies since the 2005-06 season, when St. Cloud lost 72-67 in Halenbeck Hall.

RECORD WITH THE HUSKIES: St. Cloud State leads the all-time series with Michigan Tech (36-16) that dates back to the 1954-55 season. Most recently, Michigan Tech beat St. Cloud State in Duluth 63-56 during the 2005-06 season. St. Cloud has lost its last three contests with Michigan Tech and have not beaten the Huskies since the 1990-91 season, in which St. Cloud State won 106-87.

Head coach Kevin Luke has been with Michigan Tech longer than any coach before him. After one game in his 15th season as the Huskies head coach, Luke has put together a 260-146 overall record, including a 159-95 mark in the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. He owns the highest winning percentage at Michigan Tech.



Michigan Tech lost its season opener 70-68 to NSIC rival Minnesota Duluth on final second shot by the Bulldogs. The Huskies had three players score in double figures, as junior Tyler Molesworth scored 17 points, sophomore Kime Hojnacki put in 12 and junior Don Fowler posted 10. The Huskies shot nearly 50 percent in the game, going 27 of 55 from the field.

St. Paul, Minn. - The St. Cloud State University Huskies were picked as the 2009-10 NSIC Men's Basketball Preseason favorites, as chosen by the league coaches. The Huskies received four first place votes but tallied 171 points to edge Winona State by two. The Warriors were picked to finish first by six coaches, but only amassed 169 points. That was five points ahead of Minnesota State (164) and 16 ahead of defending NSIC Champions of SMSU (143). Augustana College (136), Concordia-St. Paul (117) and Northern State (113) round out the top half of the teams in the poll.

St. Cloud State, which finished 22-9 a year ago and won the NSIC Tournament and advanced to NCAA Division II tournament, has already been ranked No. 10 in NCAA Division II by The Sporting News Preseason Poll. The Huskies return four starters in 2009-10 led by Matt Schneck (C, Sr., Whitefish Bay, Wis.). Schneck was recently named to The Sporting News Preseason Honorable Mention All-American team. Minnesota State's Travis Nelson was picked by the league coaches as the NSIC Pre-Season Player of the Year.
